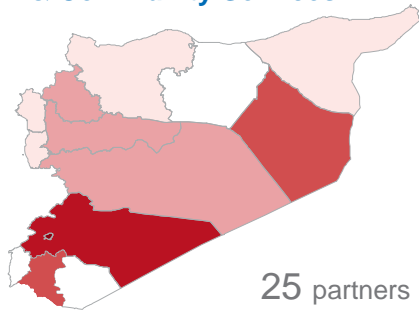
Number of partners by governorate and by sector



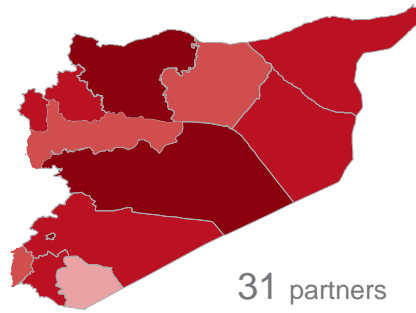
Number of partners by governorate



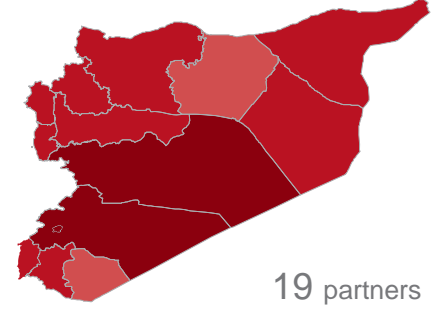
