# SHELTER CLUSTER YEMEN

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# FOREWORD

The prolonged conflict and socio-economic collapse continued to have a devastating effect on the shelter and housing sector in Yemen. In 2022, an estimated 7.4 million people required shelter and non-food items (Basic household items) assistance. However, only 3.1 million individuals were targeted with an investment of \$225 million due to funding challenges coupled with new displacement, and housing land and property (HLP) issues. However, only 43% of total funding received allowing shelter assistance to 1.5 million people (50%) of the targets. As a result, emergency lifesaving shelter/NFI responses and pre-positioning of stocks in key governorates were prioritized which, facilitated timely response to 1.1 M. Of the assistance provided, 176K people assisted with durable solution kind of assistance helping the Cluster achieve the following target for 2022 HRP target: 5% of transitional shelter, 27% of shelter maintenance and upgrade, and 6% of house rehabilitation and reconstruction. Key partners who implemented Shelter / NFI response in 2022 are: UNHCR, KSRELIEF, IOM, QRCS, NRC, DRC, YRCS, SI, YFCA, YGUSSWP, BCFHD, Pure Hands, AOBWC, ACTED and Altwasul.

This funding shortfall unfortunately, leaves most of the internally displaced population (IDPs) and returnees in sub-standard shelter conditions exposing them to protection risks including the elements. According to Shelter Cluster monitoring reports, 29% IDPs continues to live in makeshift shelters made of worn-out clothes while

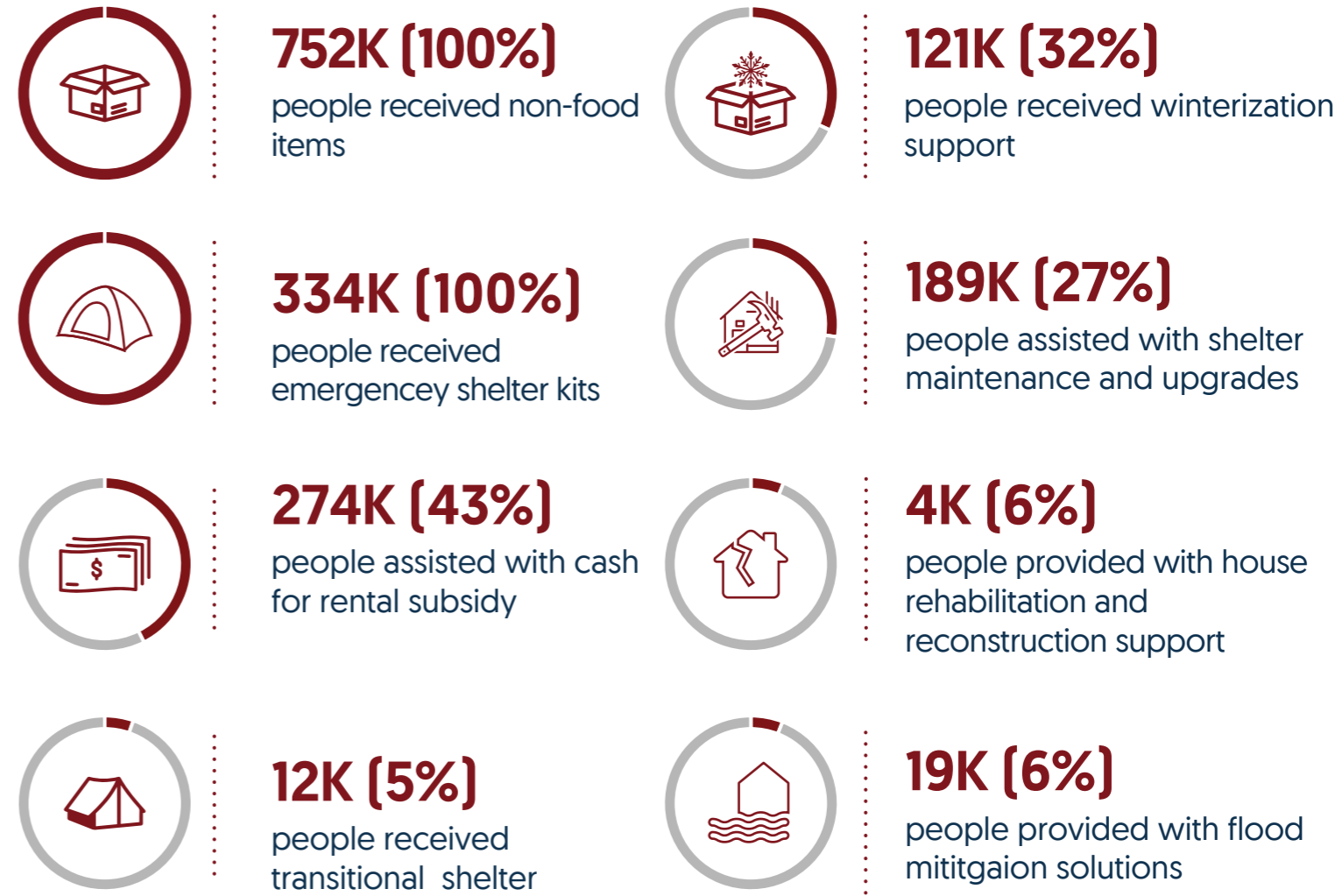
In 2022, more than 200 partners mainly national non-governmental organizations, were registered with the cluster, 55 of these were active members reaching 1.5 million beneficiaries with shelter & NFI assistance in 226 districts across 22 Governorates.

approximately 32% of the return population live in there partially damaged houses and some faced challenges in restituting their properties due to the lack of documentation. All these factors expose mainly the most vulnerable families without support to heightened protection risks and do not protect them from the elements.

Aiding for durable solutions is one of the key Shelter Cluster objectives for 2023 in line with the Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) Strategic Objectives (SO2) supported by substantial HLP interventions to address the impediments. Therefore, depending on the availability of funds, the Cluster will scale up durable approaches to break the cycle of continual emergency response and deliver sustainable solutions in a more environmentally friendly manner.

This dashboard presents an overview of the key achievements in 2022 using a series of maps and infographics categorized by types of interventions, targeted populations, and Hubs. Building upon these remarkable accomplishments, the Shelter Cluster's partners will continue to work directly and indirectly with Yemenis affected by conflict and natural disasters to provide both emergency and long-term solutions. Moving forward, the emphasis will be on expanding durable approaches with the aim of breaking the cycle of recurring emergency responses and offering sustainable solutions in a more eco-friendly manner.

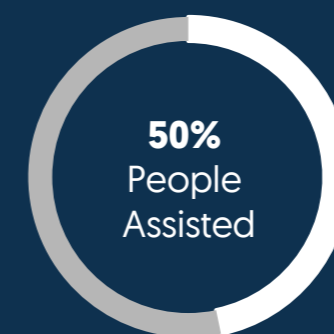

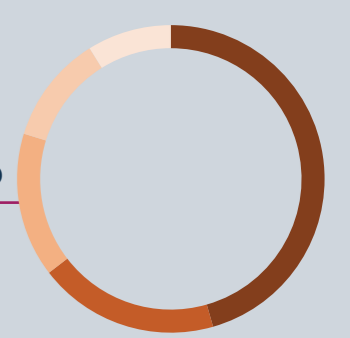

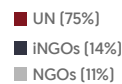

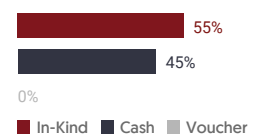
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

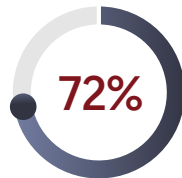

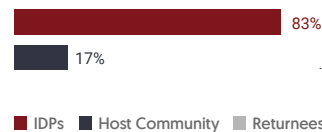

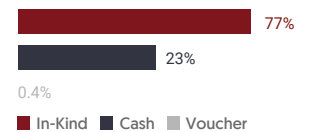
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

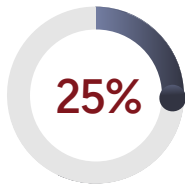

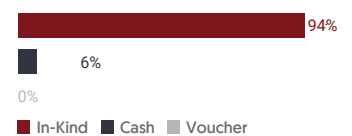
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

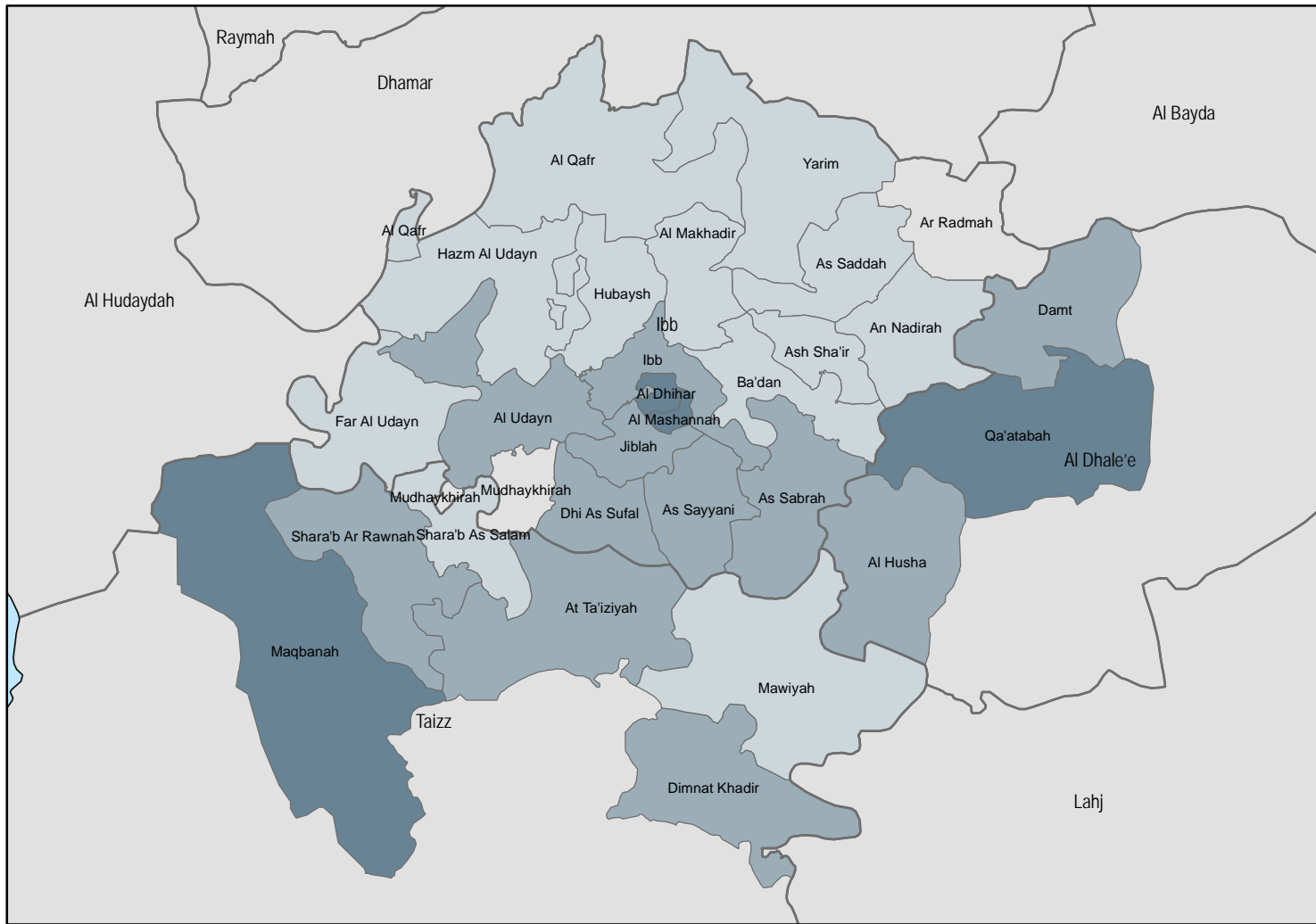

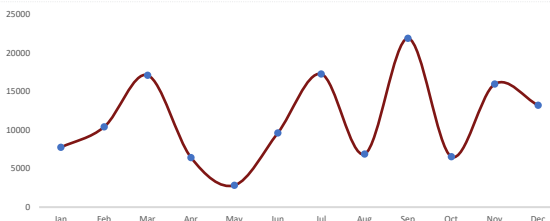

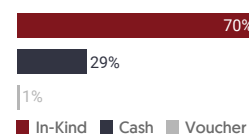
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

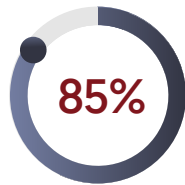

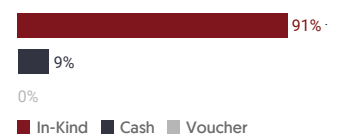
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

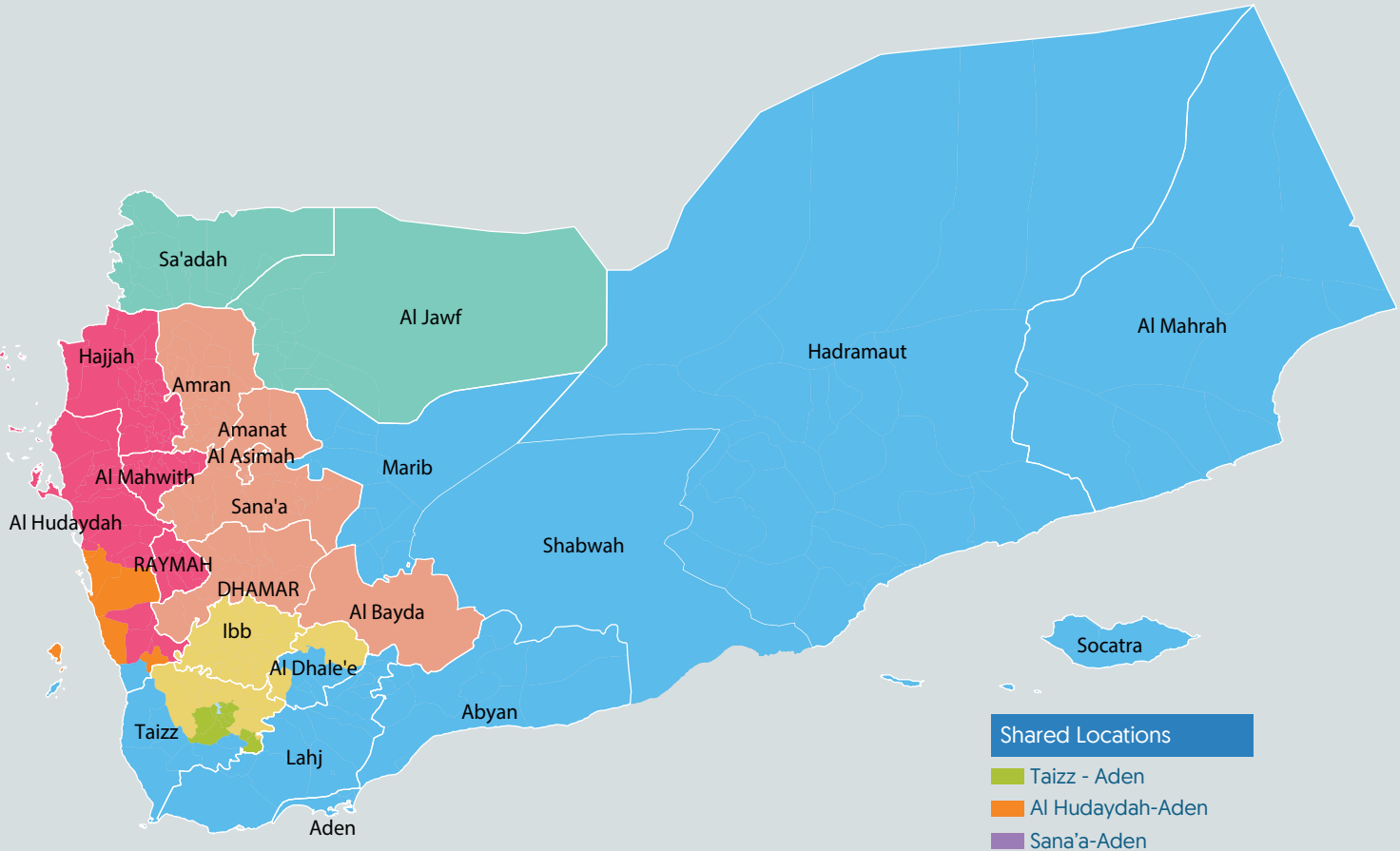
