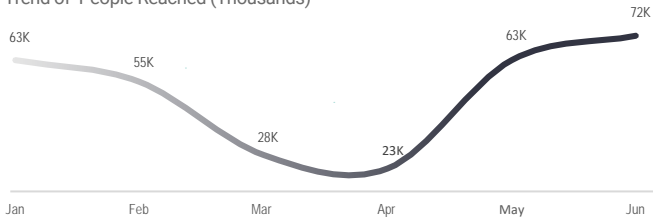

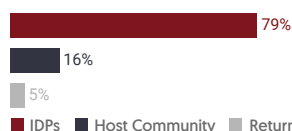

Trend of People Reached (Thousands)



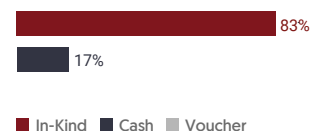

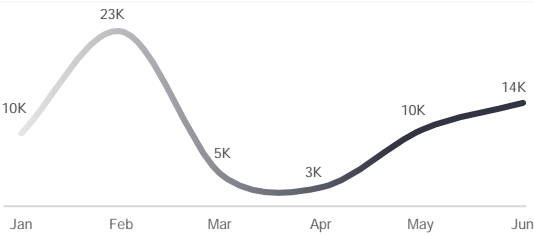

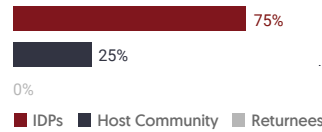

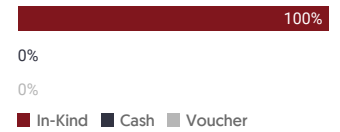
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

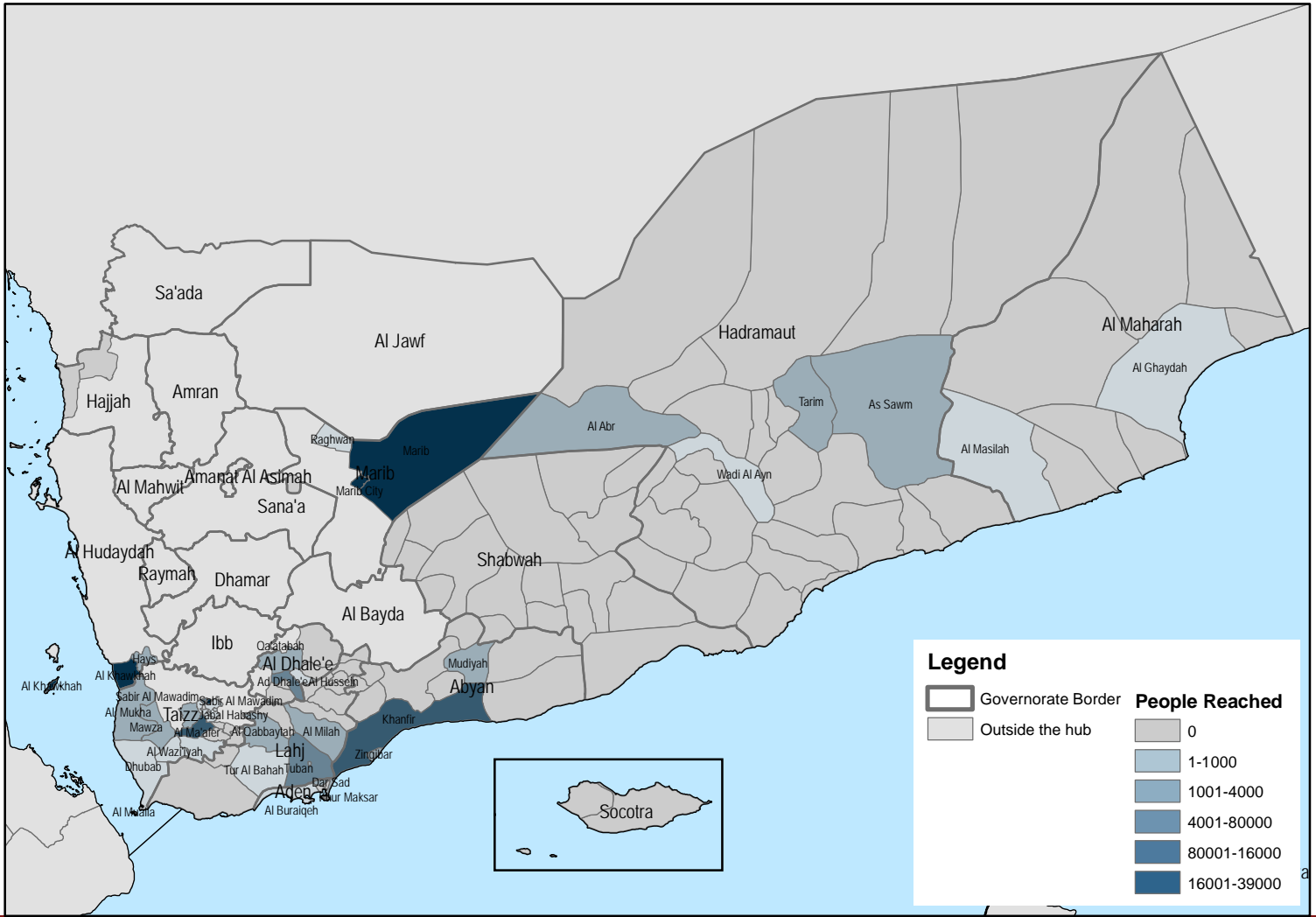

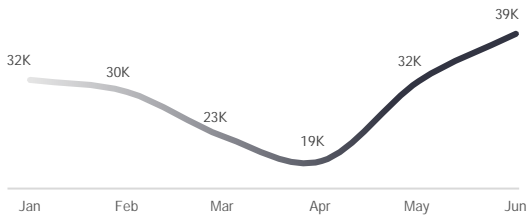

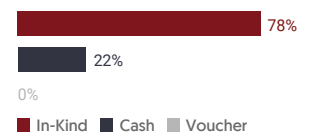
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

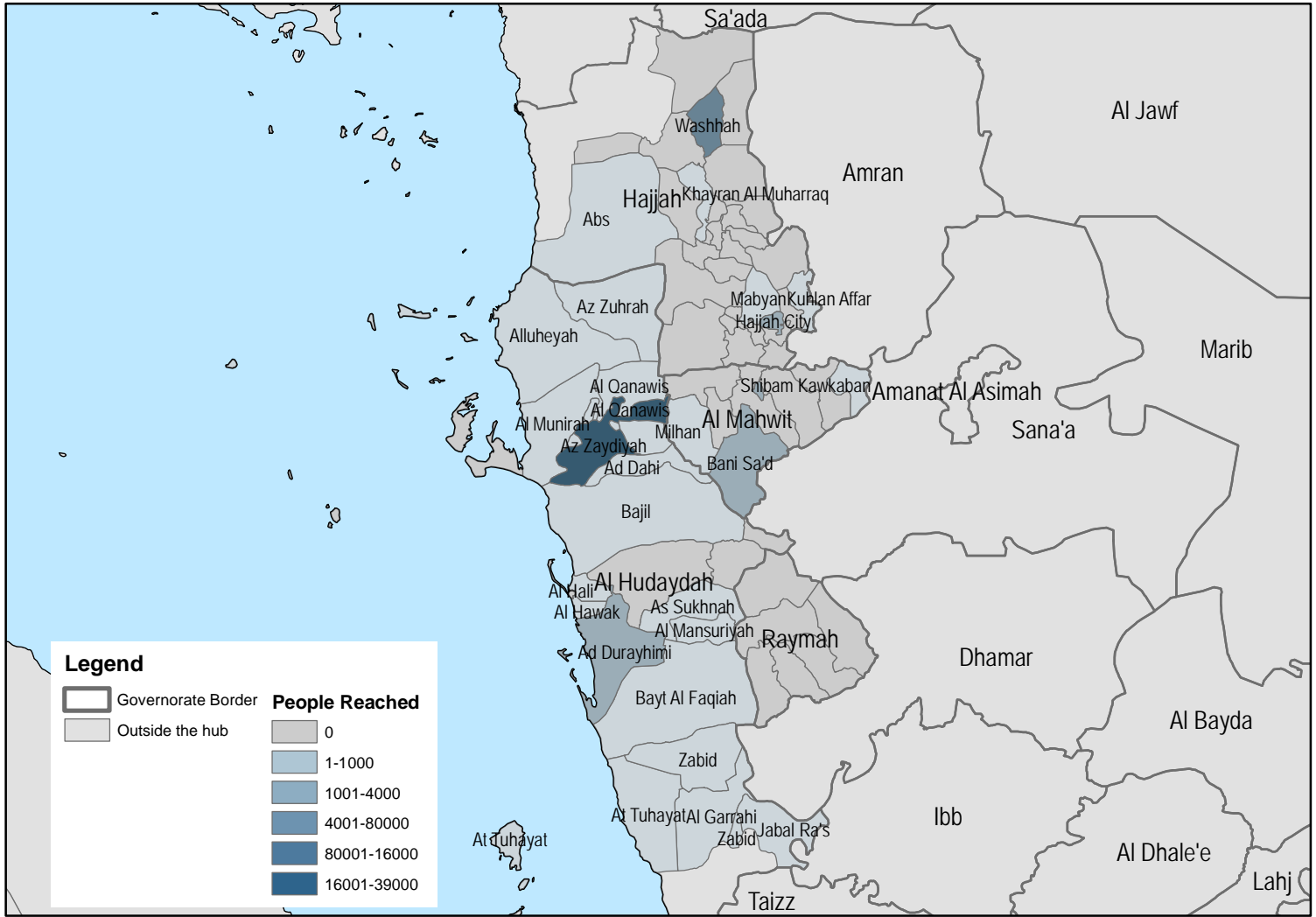

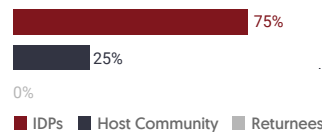

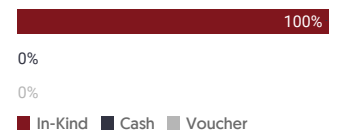
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

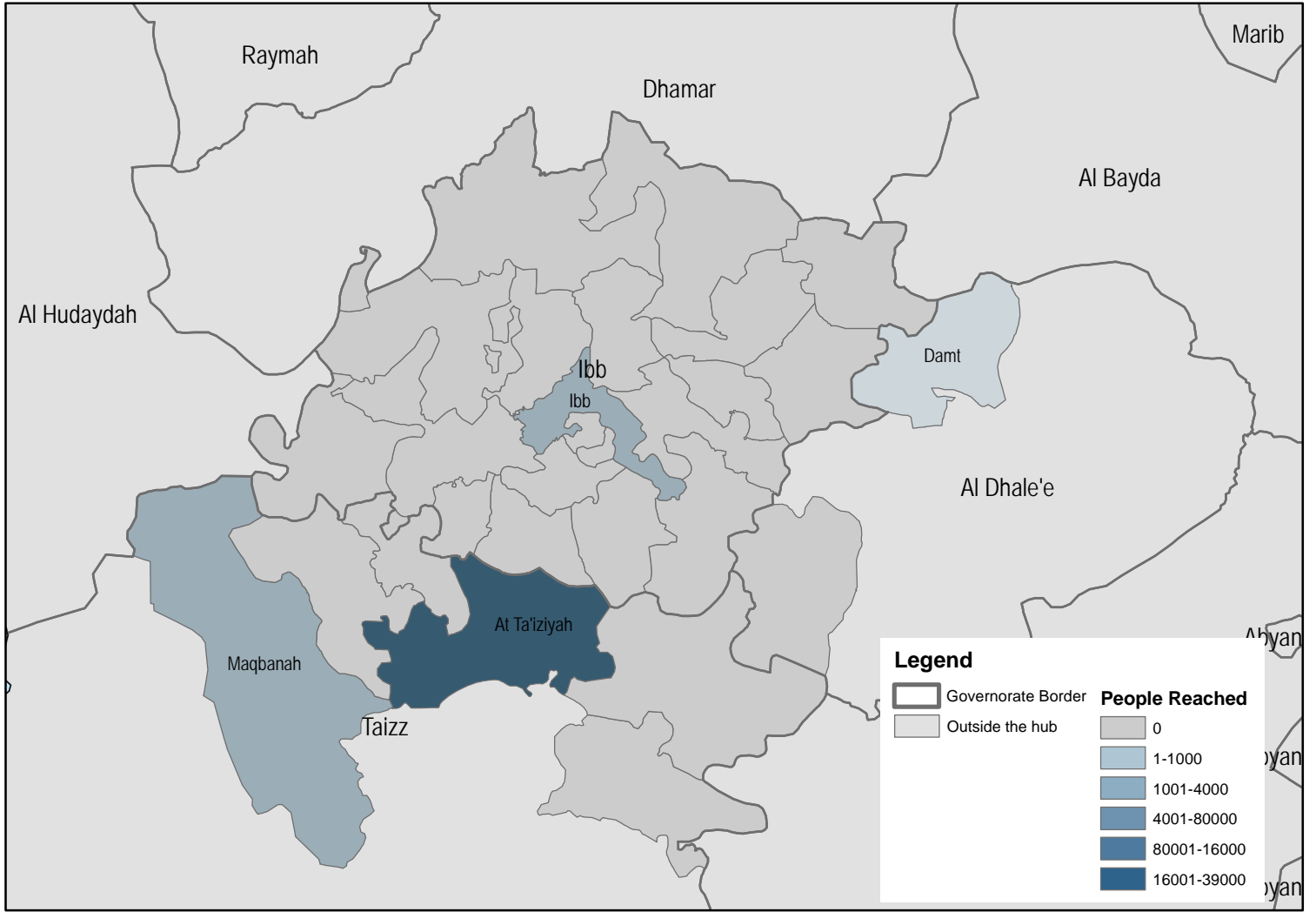

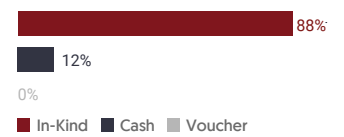
Trend of People Reached (Thousands)

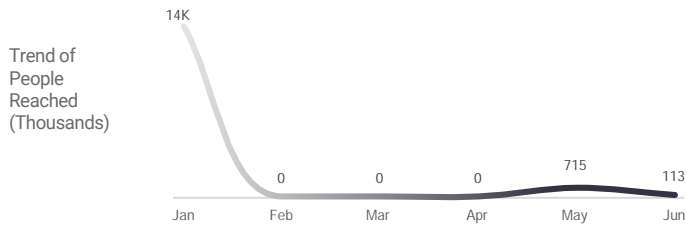

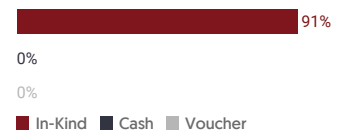

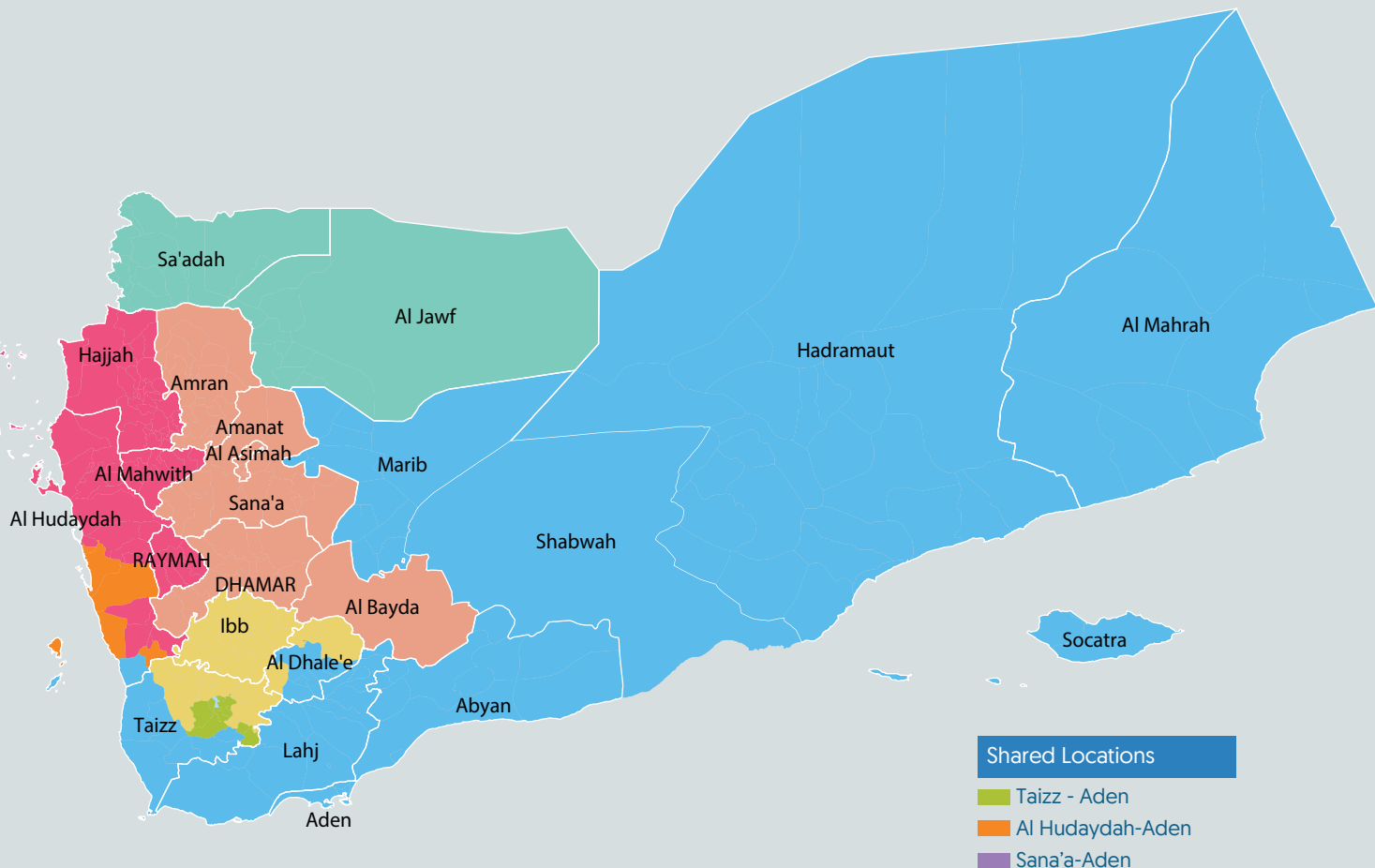
