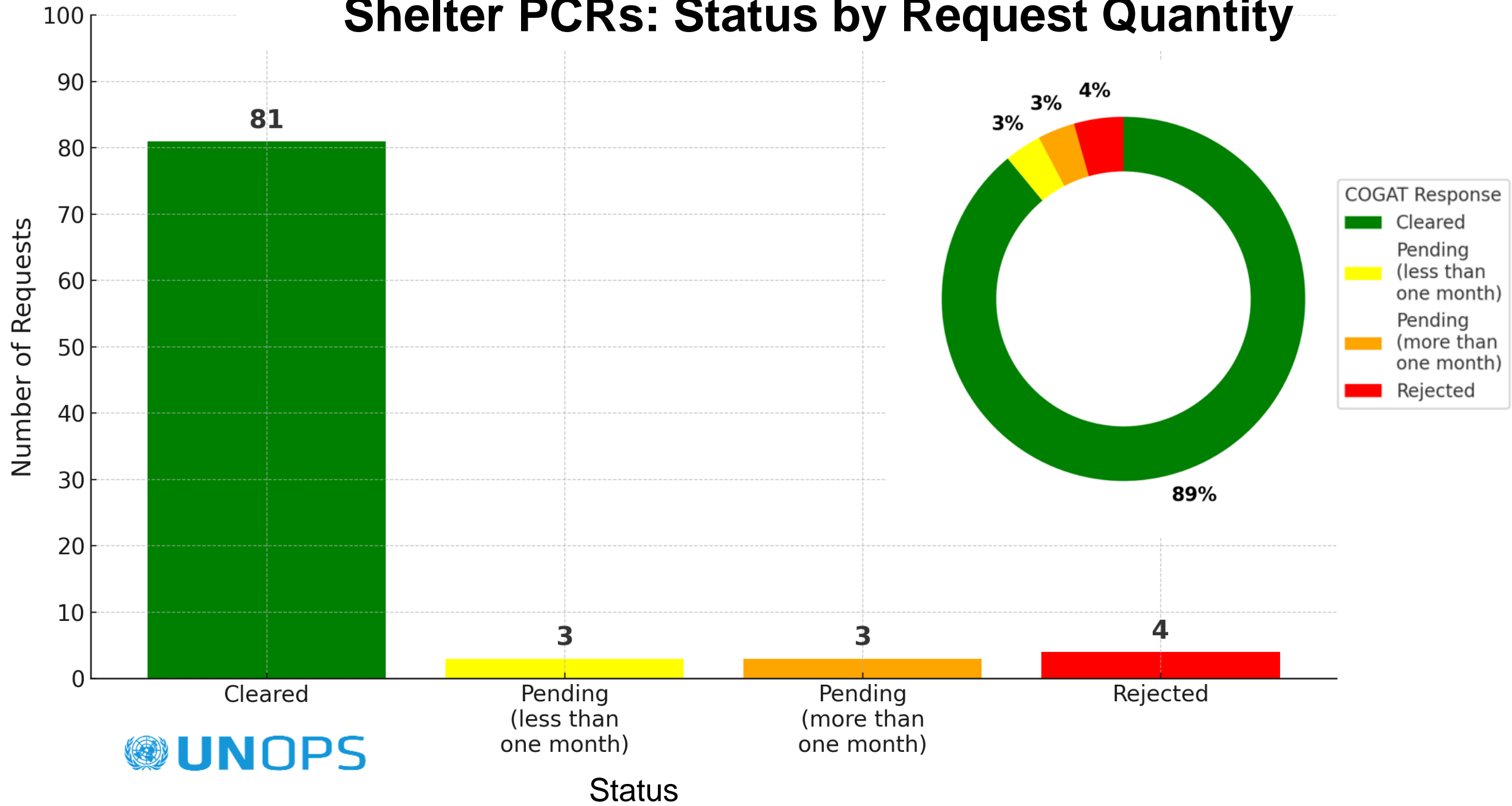

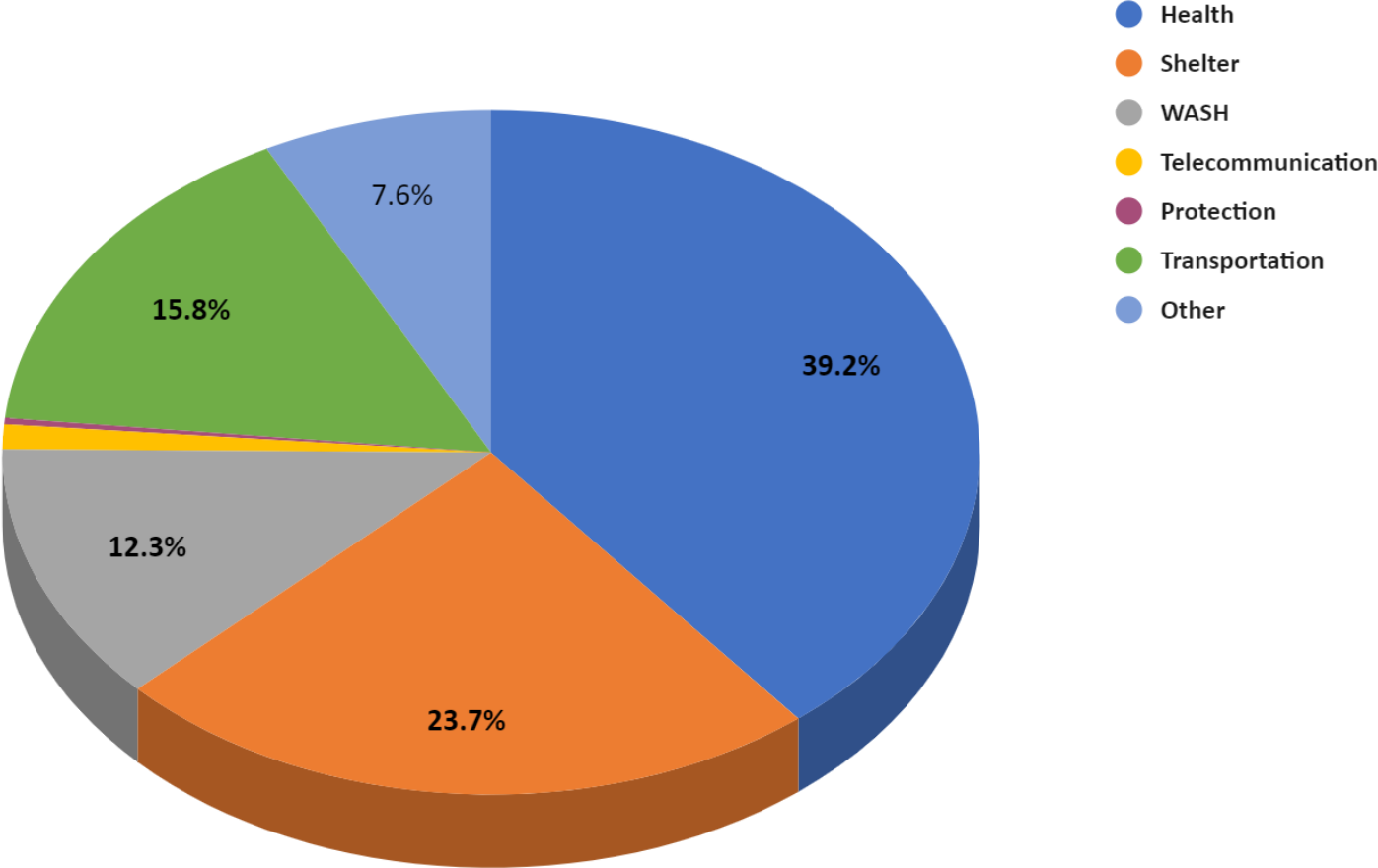

Shelter PCRs: Status by Request Quantity

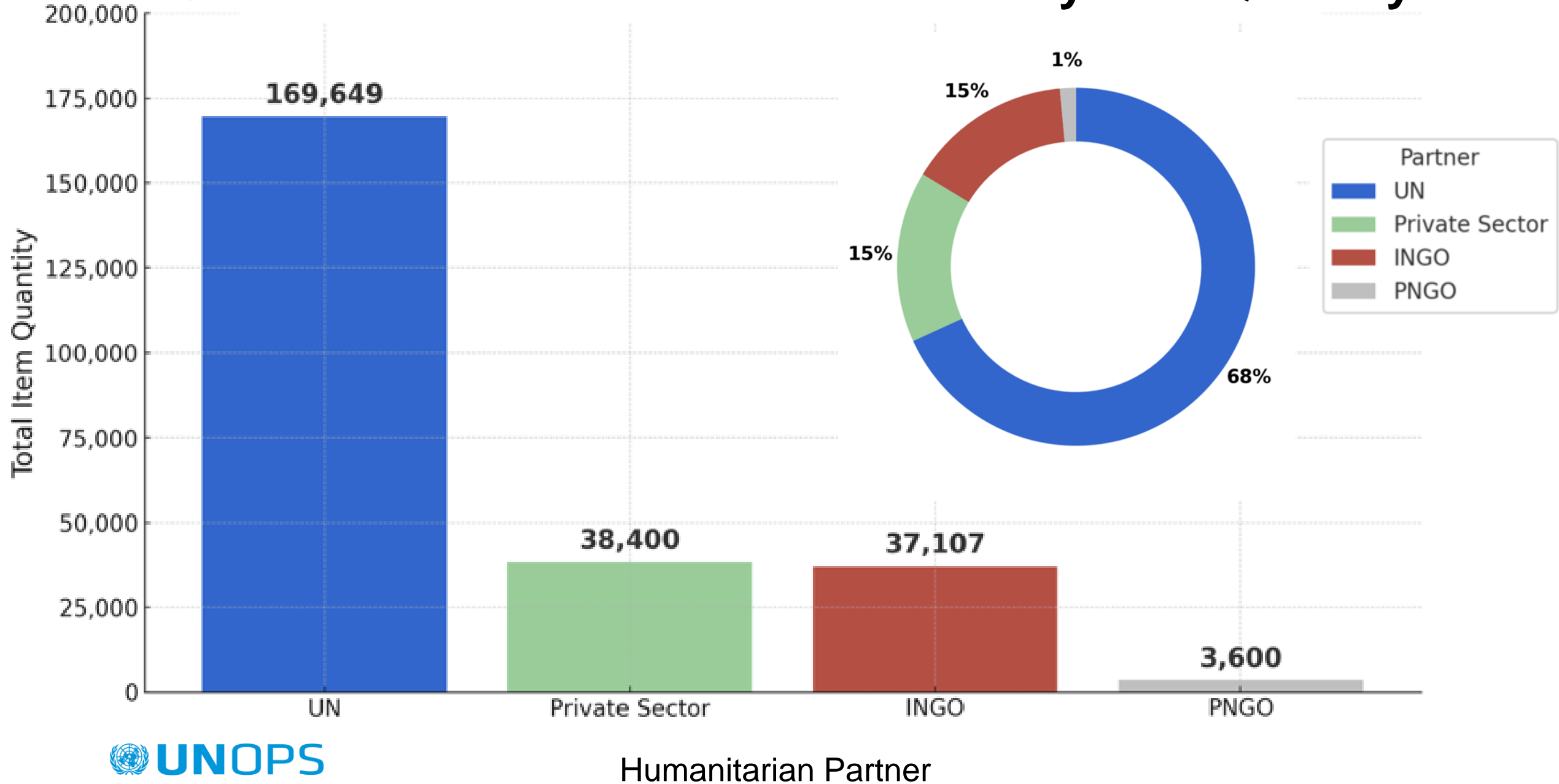


Cleared items per category from the total submitted items

Shelter PCRs: Humanitarian Partner by Item Quantity



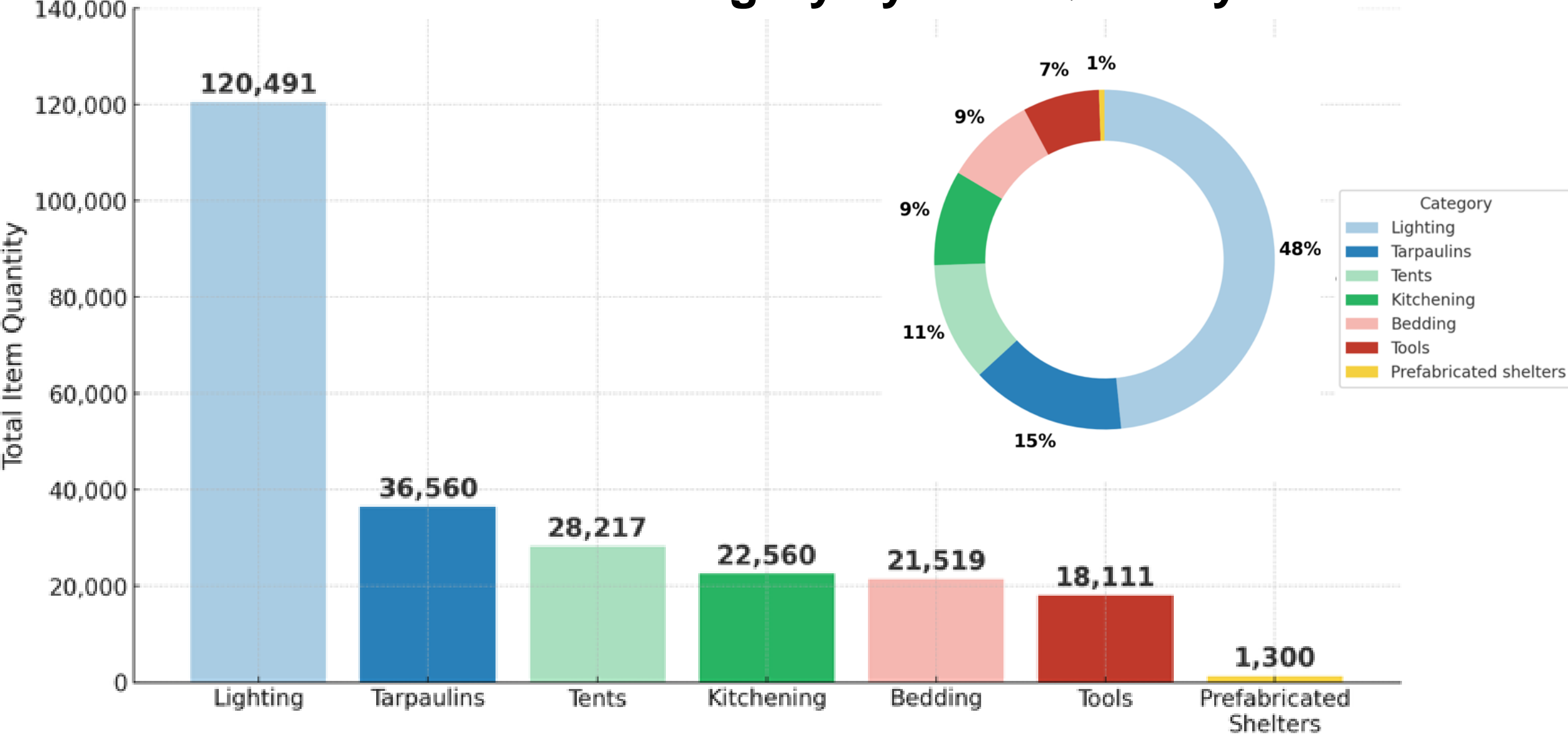
Approved Items

- Tent, multipurpose, Family tent
- Tarpaulins
- Rechargeable lamp, Solar flashlight
- Kitchen Set, Cooking Stove, Gas Cylinder
- Blanket, Mattresses, Camp bed, Sleeping bag
- Hygiene Kit, Dignity Kits
- Larine Blocks
- Self-help Construction tools kit

Rejected Items

- Prefabricated Shelter Tents
- Mobile Kitchen Set
- Hygiene items (Household Bleach and Dishwashing Liquid)

What improve the opportunities for approving Preclearance Requests

Submit all data requested in the ASU CHIs online form (clear photo for the item, clear technical specifications, specific distribution location)

Avoid camouflage colors of the sheets

Provide catalogs if applicable

ASU comments

There is no such thing as a blanket approval for a type of item. Each request is on a case-by-case basis. COGAT looks at the components, the supply chain and the final destination of usage when considering a pre-clearance request.

Low-tech items can be cleared quickly within a week

High-tech items can take up to six weeks, with no guarantee of clearance
