### Agenda 1: Introduction

The National Cluster Coordinator in his opening remarks welcomed all partners to the meeting. He then requested meeting attendees (physical and virtual) to introduce themselves

### Agenda 2: Cluster Progress and Updates

- Cluster established a shelter and settlement TWiG with experts to support the shelter and NFI Cluster on the shelter construction component. The TWiG is led by IOM deputized by NRC. Thanks to NRC for deploying an expert from its global team.
- HRP process is ongoing, and the first part of data collection is done. SNFI Cluster IMO team is going well with process.
- There is going to be a breakdown of the National Cluster Coordination team. Sherrie is going for leave, Makeen for TDY support to the Ukraine mission and Philip to Germany for the training. Nonetheless, we'll continue to provide support remotely. Keep the team in copy and after this month, the situation will return to normalcy.
- SSHF Grant to support to Renk, Unity and Upper Nile States: The Cluster received some funds - to cover cluster specific urgent needs. The SNFI Cluster intends to concentrate on Malakal as a priority location.

#### b) Pipeline and IM Updates:

- 5 W's reporting for this month of August 2023: 38 entries were recorded in the system. However, 10 were removed because they have issues. Partners are urged to submit their data in the system by the end of this week.
- Overdue reports: A new window was created for partners with pending/overdue reports. IMO team elaborated on how the reporting of such data is supposed to be entered into the system.
- Pipeline team prepositioned SNFI supplies to Renk, Wau, Rumbek and Malakal- barge currently loading for Malakal
- Partners are requested to submit distribution reports urgently. There is need to have all partners' distribution reports for the last two years submitted by September 2023. CP will contact partners with pending reports individually.

#### C) RRF Updates:

- The limited available resources are committed to counties with acute needs and prioritizing NNGO as a commitment to the localization agenda.
- RRF has received EOIs from most of organizations and are under the review process
- RRF is going to have several trainings for all sectors including SNFI partners.



### **Agenda 3: Cluster Partners' Updates**

#### **Abyei Administrative area:**

- CCOSS is responding to 1515 most vulnerable returnees and host community members. IOM is responding to 546 returnees.
- In Abyei- in areas of Nyinakuach and Nunchok , CCOSS and IOM responded to 982 returnees with cash. Each HHs received 350 USD.
- NRC deployed a mobile emergency team to conduct a multi-sectoral assessment with the help of Abyei SNFI SFP on field-level arrangement.

#### **Lake State:**

- State government is planning to allocate land to returnees coming from Sudan but no exact details on the number of the plots to be allocated to the HHs members.

#### **Northern Bar el gazal State:**

- IRNA planned by the local authority and partners to be conducted in 5 locations where IDPs have settled.
- NCA conducted a rapid need assessment in Awiel North, Gogmachar and Awiel East and the report will be shared soon.

#### **Warap state:**

- TGCDA-IRNA conducted last month in 6 payams with 7 clusters in participation. Partners were informed in the state ICCG meeting that any partner interested in the response to the identified needs of affected population can use the report shared.
- On 23/08/2023, an incident of fighting between Kuach North and Gogrial East in Kuanymonjong displaced over 400 HHs, killing and burning animals.

#### **Jonglei State:**

- NRC participated in an IRNA that was conducted and the report is being compiled and soon will be shared with the SFPs.
- Action point: Follow up on the IRNA report conducted in Akobo for both Gambella refugee camps and Sudan returnees, which has not been shared by OCHA. The preliminary findings estimated 2267 households to have been affected in four payams of Bilkay, Dengjock, Gakdong and Nyandit.
- DRC completed a multi-sectoral assessment in Nyirol County in two payams of Tool and Pulturuk with 400 HHs and 300 HHs respectively total to 700 HHs approved by Cluster.
- PAH distributed SNFIs to 450 HHs to Kurwai of Canal Pigi (Atam and Canal Centre payams) and the report is to be shared with SFP.
- In Pibor, PAH deployed CVA team for project implementation and the process is ongoing with vendors to deliver the NFI materials.
- ADA completed distribution of cash in Pibor, Verteth and Lekuanglei
- ADA is planning for cash distribution in Fangak targeting 900 HHs next week.



- PAH requested for a No Eost extension for the SSHF project supposed to be completed on 10/10/2023. The project is multi-sectoral and all clusters approved the NCE.

**Upper Nile state:**

- NRC deployed team for multi-sectoral assessment in Ulang, Nasir, and Langochuek counties.
- NRC ongoing shelter construction in Renk
- IOM conducted rapid needs assessments in Kuajok and Gogrial towns.

**Unity state:**

- No updates reported.

**Central Equatoria state:**

- HDC reported returnees from Sudan that arrived in April 2023 and settled in Mangateen and Don Bosco. They reported lack of NFIs.

**Eastern Equatoria state:**

- No updates

**Western Equatoria:**

- WVI is ongoing with PDM for SNFI and cash distribution in both Tambura and Enzo counties
