Summary Shelter and NFI Response

Tartous & Lattakia:

- Local authorities in Lattakia identified 7 locations to install 1,000 prefabricated housing units funded by UAE, within the next 8 months. Site level improvement/infrastructure are ongoing at 3 locations. Local authorities have requested UN agencies to support with laying of roads and street lighting at these sites.
- In coordination with local authorities and Ministry of Public Works, construction companies started the construction of 8 buildings [10 floors each]. A total of 320 apartments each with a living space of 80 sq.m are expected to be built within the next 8 months to accommodate families who can't return to their homes which were completely damaged, this is part of the permanent housing solution for affected population by local authorities.
- As of May 10th, NFI sector partners³ (AAKH, AAHS, NRC, SIF, SSSD, UNHCR and UNRWA) were able to reach 5,771 families [28,628 indiv.] in Lattakia and 1,292 families [5,945 indiv.] in Tartous with various emergency NFIs.

Aleppo:

- Relocation of families residing in emergency period collective centres [CCs] to mid-term CCs is ongoing. To date 4 CCs designated as mid-term CCs have been occupied.
- As of May 10th, NFI partners¹ (ACT/FCA, ACF, AKAH, DRC, EPDC, GVC, MEDAIR, NRC, SIF, UNHCR, UNRWA and ZOA) were able to reach 44,033 families [222,207 indiv.] in different C.Cs and in hosting arrangements.

Homs/ Hama:

- Local authorities in Hama evacuated 4 emergency period CCs where majority of the families returned to their houses, as they were cleared as structurally safe by the Rapid Structural Assessment [RSA]. Remaining families whose homes are declared as unsafe by RSA are being moved the nearby CCs which are still operational.
- Presently, 195 families/878 individuals are being sheltered in CCs across Hama.
- As of May 10th, NFI sector partners¹ (ADRA, NRC and UNHCR) were able to reach 1,111 families [6,806 indiv.] in Hama and 14 families [69 indiv.] in Homs with emergency NFIs.

Idleb:

- Currently, 2 CCs are hosting 47 families and there is a need to accommodate another 40 families. Local authorities are contemplating to adapt/rehabilitate 2 schools as CCs to host these families.

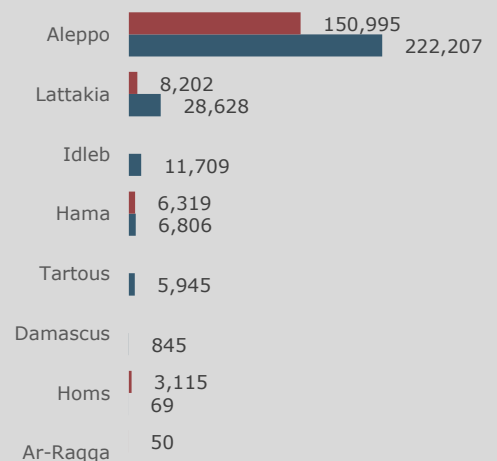

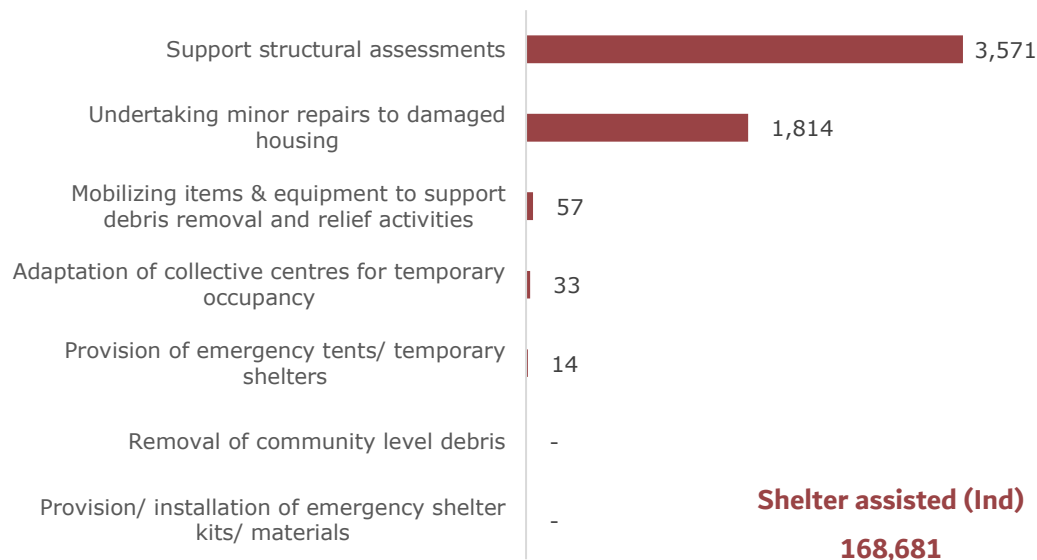

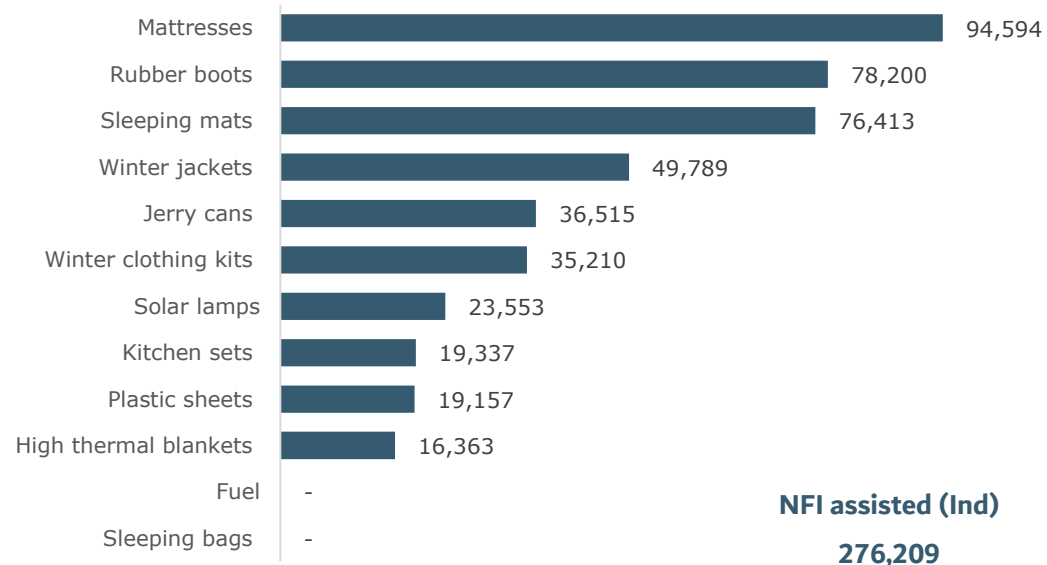

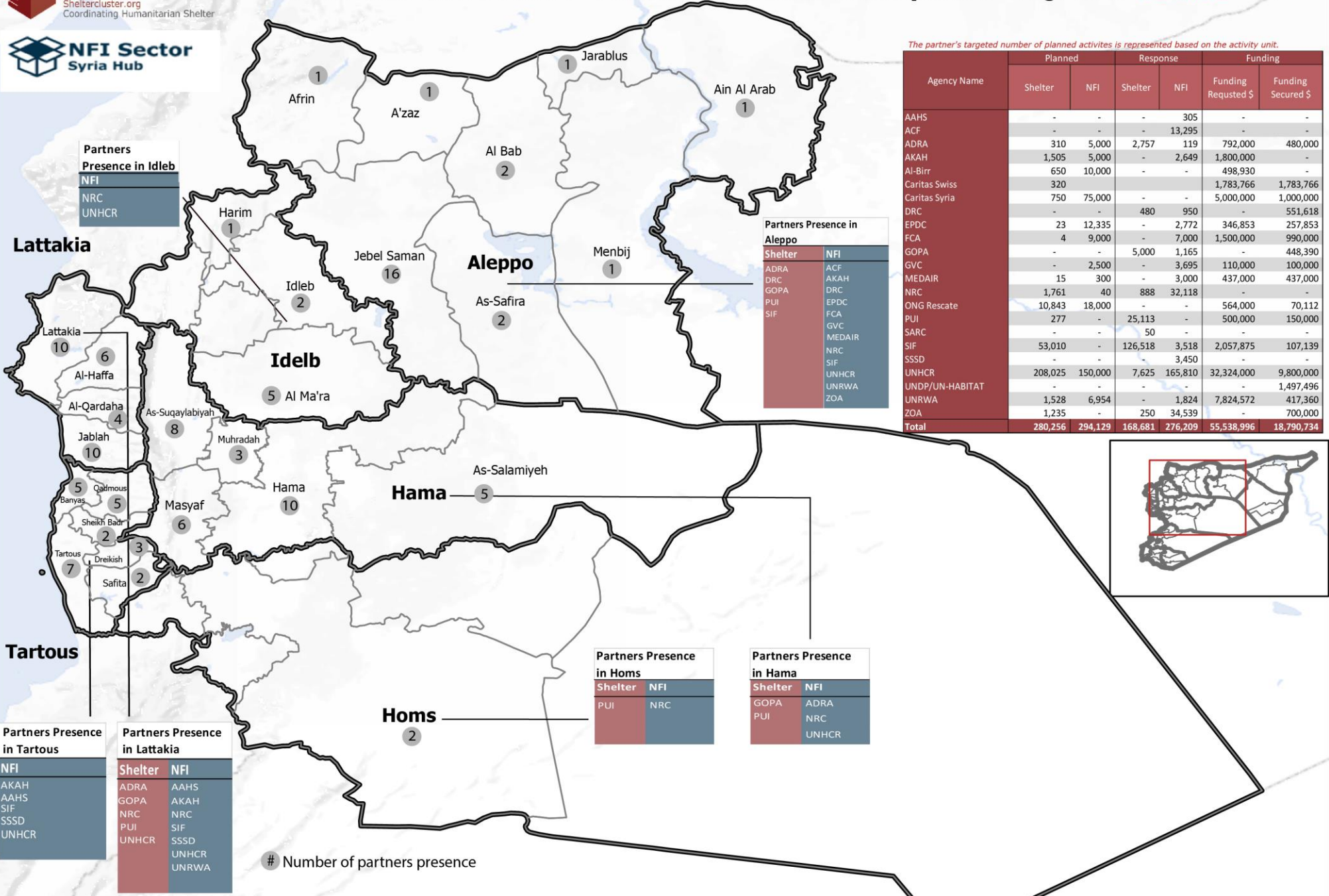
