

SNFI - Earthquake Response Factsheet - Syria Hub

Summary Shelter & NFI Response

Tartous & Lattakia:

- SARC [supported by UNHCR] provided emergency NFI assistance in 2 collective centres in Lattakia - Jaafar Nasif School and Hettin School.
- SARC [supported by UNHCR] provided emergency NFI assistance to 24 families in Taishoor and 2 families in old Basira, all within hosting arrangements.
- NRC distributed emergency NFIs to children in four collective centres.
- SARC is assessing the NFI needs of displaced people in Mintar, Lattakia.
- Partners are doing a feasibility study of providing NFI assistance through provision of CASH and the Cash Working Group [CWG] will soon be activated to provide required guidance.

Aleppo: The rapid structural assessment undertaken by the Syndicate of Engineers, supported by the shelter sector partners is ongoing. So far, 1,803 [approx.] buildings were assessed in 11 neighborhoods with the following key findings; a. 88 buildings were categorized as ‘high risk of collapse’; b. 285 buildings as ‘medium risk of collapse’ and c. 1,430 buildings are classified as safe to continue habitation.

Buildings assessed for damage will be plotted on GIS to provide spatial reference and to permit better targeting of rehabilitation of damaged housing. UNDP, UN-Habitat and UNHCR are supporting the Syndicate of Engineers in this exercise.

UNICEF is providing cash for children’s winter clothing to displaced families in Aleppo and Hama.

SNFI sectors released the **Earthquake Response Strategy** to sector partners on February 13th, with an aim to provide guidance to partners on SNFI sector objectives, needs framework, and priority activities.

SNFI sector coordinators met with the **Swiss Development Corporation** [SDC] to brief on the ongoing SNFI response in key areas and discuss priority areas where SDC may be in a position to support.

Flash Appeal for emergency earthquake assistance is released on February 14th by UN Secretary General.

SNFI sectors updated the Global Shelter Cluster [GSC] and shelter partners on the ongoing response, needs, gaps and challenges.

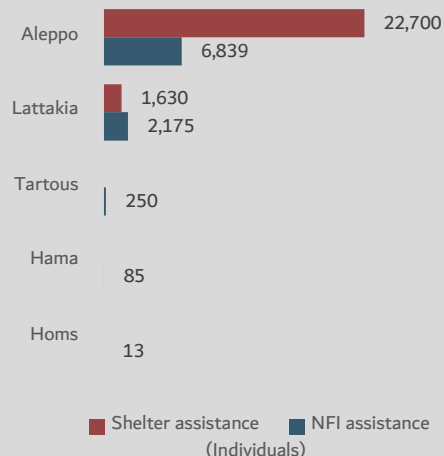

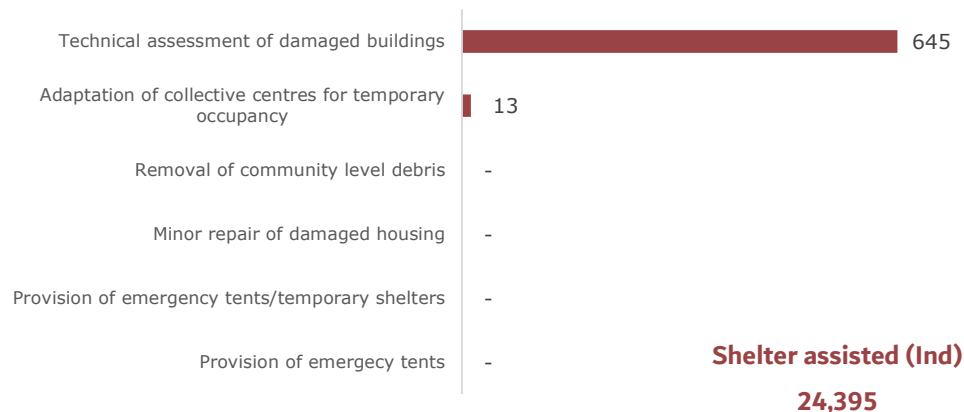

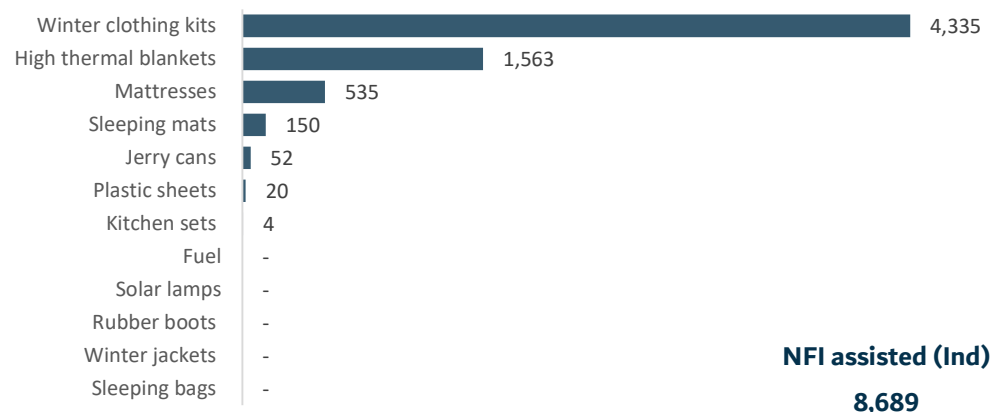
