

Displacement updates in North-West Syria

As of August 2023, there are approximately 2.74 million IDPs living in North-West Syria, with 1.99 million residing in IDP sites registered in ISIMM.

This brings the total population in North-West Syria to close to 4.6 million. According to the CCCM Cluster, their database includes 1,527 IDP sites that currently house 1,986,040 IDPs or 376,379 families. Of these, 80% are women and children, and 88,104 IDPs are reported to be persons with disabilities.

In August, **no new sites** were added, while **5 sites were inactivated**. The top three sub-district of IDP arrival were Dana (990K IDP), Maaret Tamsrin (248K IDP) and Azaz (189K IDP).

Monthly response

Shelter/NFI Cluster members are actively responding to the needs of both newly displaced persons and protracted IDPs in North-West Syria.

In August 2023, NFI assistance was provided to over **29,776** individuals in the form of NFI kits, kitchen sets and cash.

Additionally, the shelter needs of over **92,152** individuals were met in August. This included infrastructure improvements in IDP sites, dignified shelters, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters

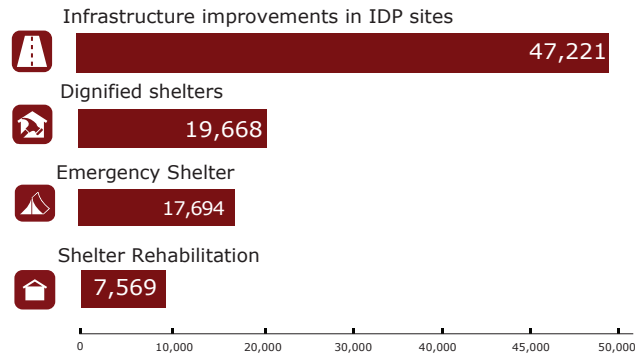

People reached in August by shelter activity



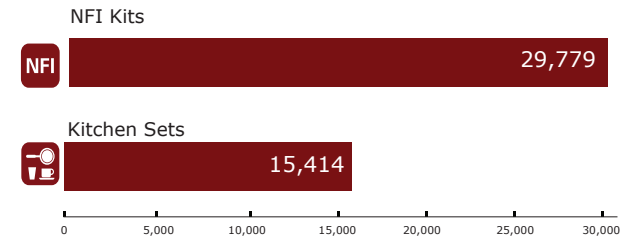
NFI response



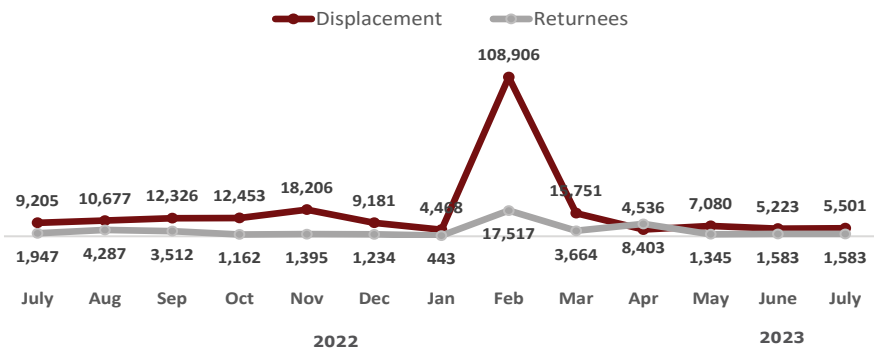

People reached in August by NFI in-Kind items assistance

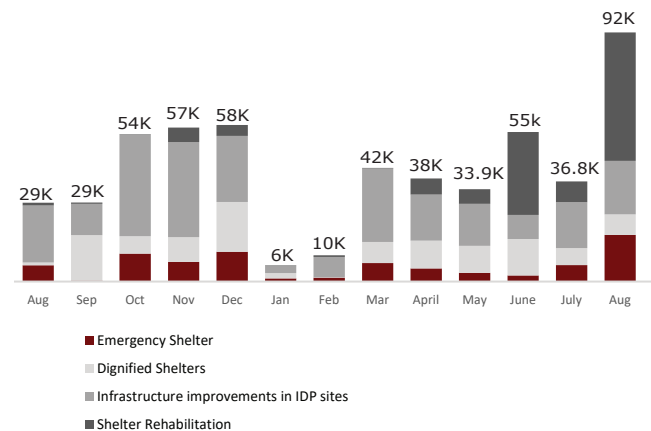
