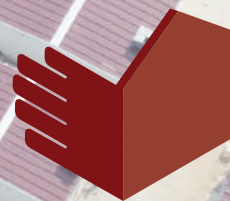

## Winterization updates 2023-24

So far a total of 26 cluster members registered winter plans for the winterization season, resulting in a combined total appeal of approximately **\$102M** of which **\$30M** has already been secured leaving a funding gap of approximately **\$72M**. From the secured fund approximately **937K** individuals (**187K** HHS) will be reached.

Between October 2023 up to Jan 2024 more than **687K** individuals have received winter assistance. The main winterization activities are cash and voucher for fuel or stoves, winter clothing kit, full NFI kits, in kind fuel, stove, and winter clothing distribution.

The main challenges for this season are:-

- Decreased funding that isn't commensurate with the needs will result in approximately **1.16m** people not being reached.
- Climate change has disrupted the winter cycle resulting in delayed and or prolonged winter conditions.
- Delayed response resulting from inability of partners to secure funding on time.
- This is also increasing the risks of fire incidents in IDP sites.

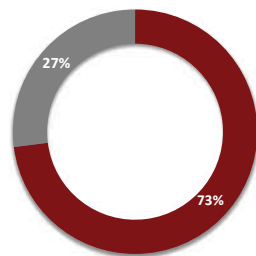

## Monthly response

Shelter/NFI Cluster members are actively responding to the needs of both newly internally displaced persons and protracted IDPs in north-west Syria.

In January 2024 alone, NFI assistance was provided to over **123,251** individuals in the form of core NFI kits and seasonal/supplementary NFI Kits.

Additionally, the shelter needs of over **45,625** individuals were met in January with activities that included infrastructure improvements in IDP sites, dignified shelters, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

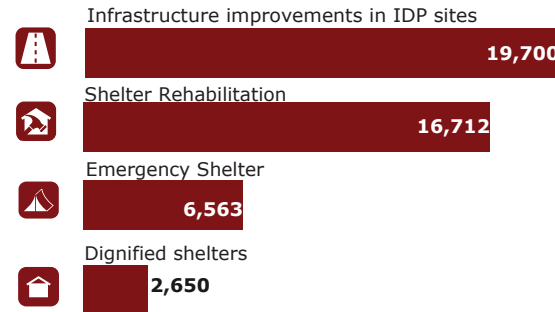

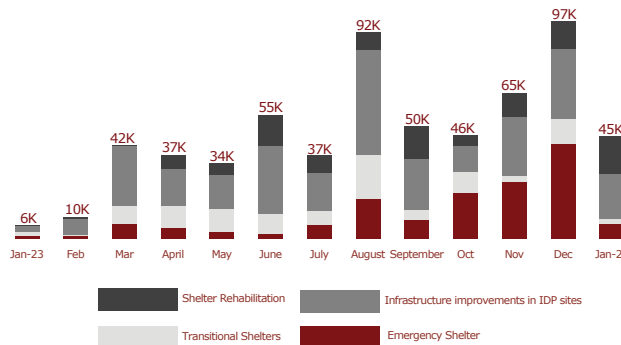
Approximately **45K** individuals have been reached with Shelter assistance in January 2024.
