

## Monthly Achievements

Shelter/NFI Cluster members are actively responding to the needs of both newly internally displaced persons and protracted IDPs in north-west Syria.

In January 2025 alone, NFI assistance was provided to over 64,637 individuals in the form of core and Winter NFI kits including cash assistance.

Additionally, the shelter needs of over 12,786 individuals were met in January including infrastructure improvements in IDP sites, dignified shelters, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

## CCCM Cluster Latest Updates

### Return Movements from IDP sites

- Total number of departures from IDP sites has reached to 10,714 HHs/57,337 individuals since 6 of December 2024. Majority of IDPs have returned permanently while 10-20 % have returned temporarily.

### IDP Site integrated Monitoring Matrix (ISIMM)

- 1,504 IDP sites are listed in the IDP Site Integrated Monitoring Matrix, that host 1,954,072 IDPs (366,073 families).
- In December, 15 sites were decommissioned due to site mergers and closures resulting from IDPs returning to their areas of origin following recent developments. This movement resulted in a reduction of 41,000 IDPs across the sites.

### Intention Survey

- Data collection phase is ongoing. REACH and CCCM partners have been collecting data across 500 IDP sites through HH survey.
- Data collection will be finalized by 18 of February and initial findings will be shared in next CCCM Sector meeting.

## Shelter repair and rehabilitation Update

Due to changes in Syria's governance and potential IDP returns, the SNFI cluster and its members are shifting their focus toward repairing and rehabilitating shelters for returning families.

As of January, seven cluster members have redesigned their projects to provide shelter repair and rehabilitation support in newly assessed areas.

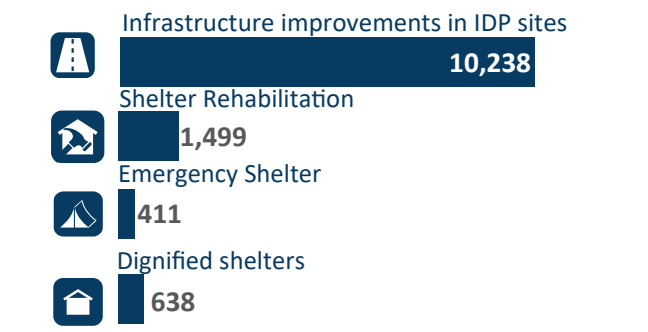

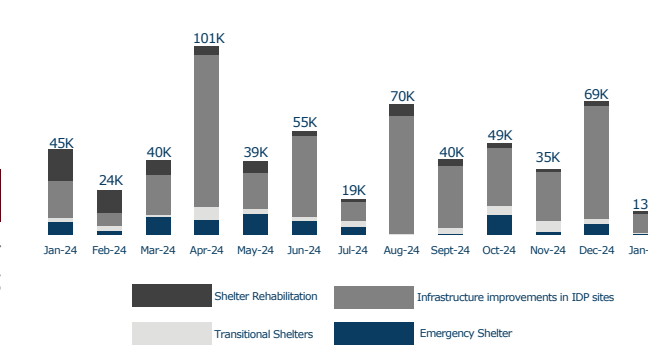
Approximately 12K individuals have been reached with Shelter assistance between January 2025.
