

## Monthly Achievements

In March 2025, partners provided NFI assistance to over **48,346** individuals with core and winter NFI kits, including cash assistance.

Cluster partners also met the shelter needs of over **10,456** individuals in March-through IDP site infrastructure improvements, dignified shelter construction, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

## Transition Status

Following a major change in Syria's situation on December 8, 2024, the humanitarian community began adapting the Whole of Syria (WoS) coordination structure to align with a unified IASC country framework. The Shelter/NFI Sector/Cluster in Syria is unifying operations across Northeast Syria (NES), Northwest Syria (NWS), and the Humanitarian Country Team (HCT) hubs.

This transition will streamline coordination, improve efficiency, and enhance service delivery to affected populations.

The transition involves three key phases:

- Phase 1 (Jan–Feb 2025):** Completed foundational assessments, transition strategy development, and stakeholder mapping.
- Phase 2 (Mar–Apr 2025):** Early integration in progress, including:
  - Operational joint Technical Working Groups (NFI & Shelter Rehabilitation).
  - Consolidated Information Management (IM) systems.
- Phase 3 (May–Jun 2025):** Full operational merger, featuring unified meetings, Activity Info reporting, and capacity-building initiatives.

## Key Achievements:

- Established Joint Strategic Advisory Group (SAG)
- Launched Technical Working Groups (TWGs) for NFI and Shelter/Housing Rehabilitation driving harmonization efforts.
- Unified communication (email/Teams) and IM systems launching in May
- Aleppo hub operational with global cluster support; Qamishli hub integration in progress

From **1 May 2025**, the cluster will operate under a single structure, including:-

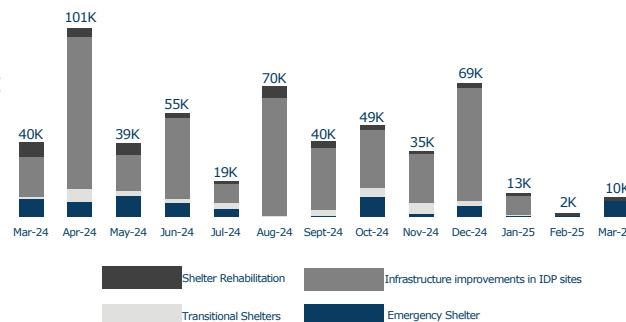
