

Displacement updates in North-West Syria

Some **2.74 million IDPs** are living in North-West Syria, out of them **1.9 million** are living in IDP sites registered in ISIMM. That brings the total population in North-West Syria close to **4.6 million**.

According to CCCM Cluster, as of May 2023, the CCCM database includes **1,525 IDP** sites that host **1,954,642** IDPs or **374,107** families. Of these, **80% are women and children**, and 82,610 IDPs are reported to be persons with disabilities. In May, 57 sites were added, and four sites were inactivated.

The top three sub-district of arrival were **Dana** (975,474 IDP), **Maaret Tamsrin** (244,122 IDP), and **Azaz** (184,841 IDP) sub-district.

Response

Shelter/NFI Cluster members continue to actively respond to the needs of the newly displaced persons, as well as protracted IDPs in North-West Syria.

In May 2023, more than 82,000 individuals received NFI assistance, in the form of NFI kits, winter clothes kits and kitchen sets.

Shelter needs of over 33,900 individuals were responded to in May, including infrastructure improvements in IDP sites, the transitional shelters, provision of emergency shelter, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

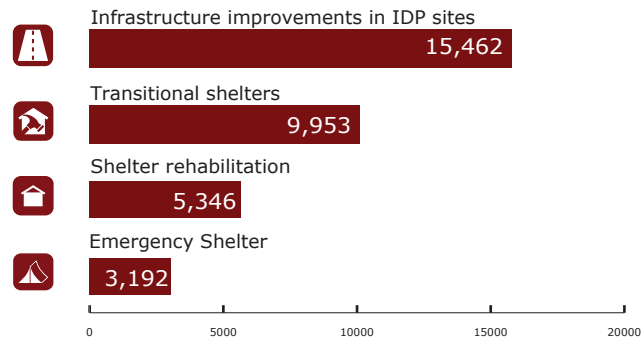

People reached in May by shelter activity



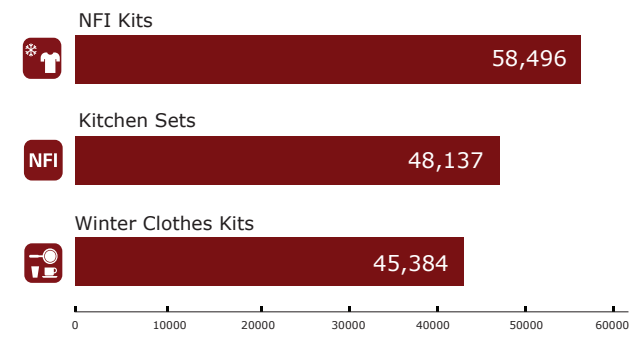

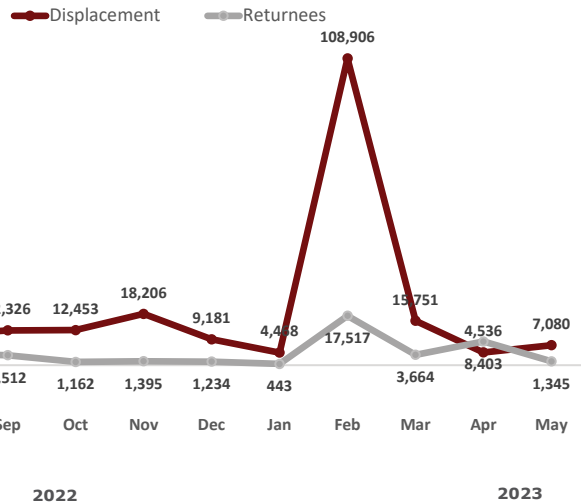
In total in 2023, some 390K people have been reached with NFI assistance (including both core and seasonal NFIs).

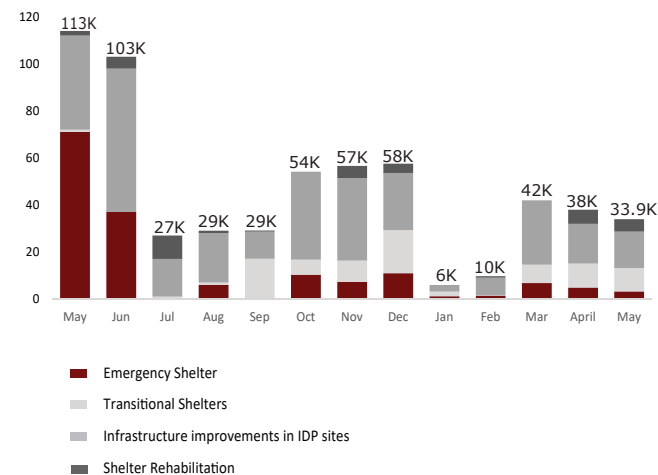
