

Displacement updates in north-west Syria

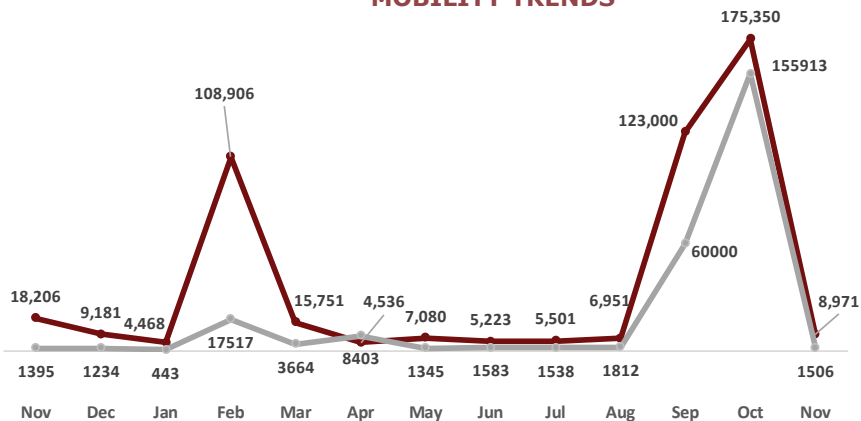
During the period from 1 November to 30 November 2023, more than 8,000 individuals were displaced in north-west Syria. This displacement was primarily caused by factors such as loss of income, escalation of aerial bombardment, anticipation of future conflict escalation, and ground-based conflict in areas like Dana, Jarablus, Maaret Tamsrin, Idleb, and Jisr-Ash-Shugur sub-districts.

The majority of the affected population relocated to Dana, Salqin, Armanaz, and Afrin sub-districts. Additionally, over 1,500 internally displaced persons (IDPs) returned to their homes or habitual residents during the same period.

The reasons for movement to these locations included the security situation, availability of safe passages, family ties or host community relationships, and access to humanitarian assistance. The identified needs in the displacement areas are food, shelter, safety, winterization, and non-food items.

Monthly response

Shelter/NFI Cluster members are actively responding to the needs of both newly displaced persons and protracted IDPs in north-west Syria.

In November 2023, NFI assistance was provided to over **227,763** individuals in the form of NFI kits, kitchen sets and cash.

Additionally, the shelter needs of over **65,159** individuals were met in November. with activities that included infrastructure improvements in IDP sites, dignified shelters, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

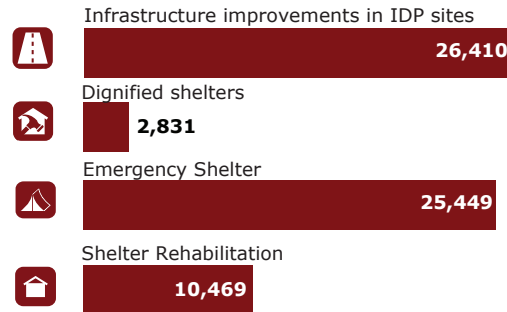

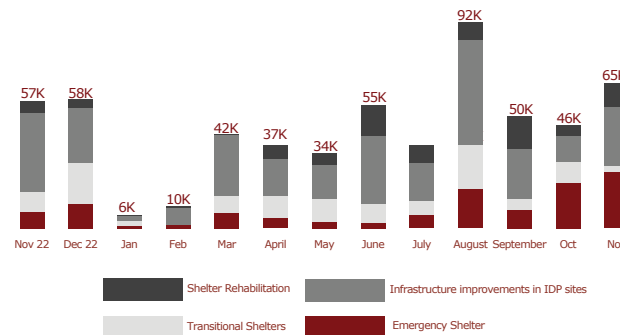
Approximately **473K** individuals have been reached with Shelter assistance since January 2023.

People reached by shelter activity per month



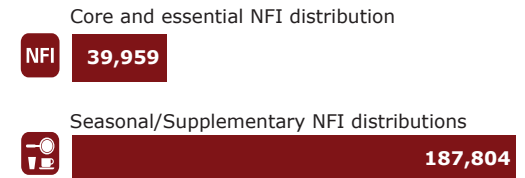
