

Monthly Achievements

Shelter/NFI Cluster members are actively responding to the needs of both newly internally displaced persons and protracted IDPs in north-west Syria.

In October 2024 alone, NFI assistance was provided to over 10,323 individuals in the form of core and Winter NFI kits including cash assistance.

Additionally, the shelter needs of over 48,953 individuals were met in October including infrastructure improvements in IDP sites, dignified shelters, emergency shelter provision, and rehabilitation of damaged or unfinished shelters.

Incidents Affecting IDP Camps

In October, the CCCM Cluster reported a concerning increase in fire incidents across Idleb and Aleppo, with 37 cases affecting 44 IDP sites. Clashes in Aleppo further exacerbated the situation, causing significant damage and disruption.

The incidents had a substantial impact, affecting approximately 331 households and destroying or damaging over 45 sites across 12 sub-districts, including Dana, Maaret Tamsrin, Azaz, Armanaz, Sharan, and others.

Unfortunately, three fatalities were reported. Additionally, six injuries were documented in Azaz, Sharan, and Suran (Aleppo) sub-districts.

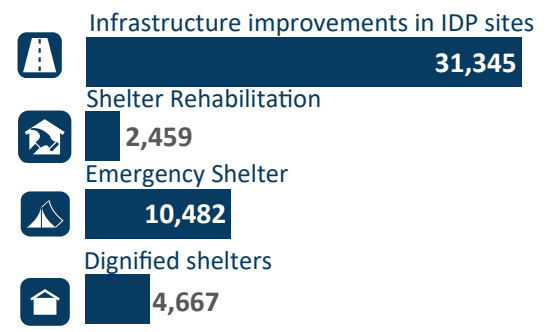

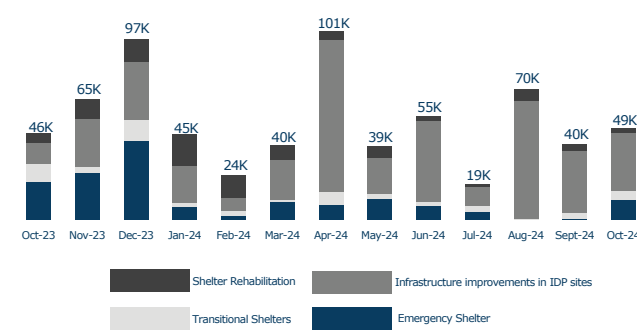
Approximately 415K individuals have been reached with Shelter assistance since January 2024.
