##### Partner Updates

##### DRC

Planned /Completed activities:

- Household level – population at Qasir Bin Ghasher area – (Two Families) (10 Individuals)
- Shelter Materials Assistance: Distribution completed.
- GFFO project: Target to reach is 285 affected individuals for access to safe and appropriate shelter
- Location identification has been completed for shelter material support (Qasir Bin Ghasher area)
- Beneficiaries' identification and assessment phase is ongoing.
- Assessment conducted for shelter materials support to 150 IND (26 families)
- Non-Libyan beneficiaries' assessment is ongoing in the Al Kraimia sites.
- Launching procurement process - FWA for shelter materials and NFIs.

##### NRC

- **Projects in partnership with UNHCR:**

##### **1. HHs level rehab:**

- a. Benghazi: target is 50 housing units- implementation work is completed, and all housing units have been handed over to beneficiaries.
- b. Tripoli: target is 50 housing units- Technical package including BoQs and SoWs is completed, Shared with UNHCR, contracting on the progress to start implementation by mid of September as further expectation.

##### **2. Rehab and upgrade of community infrastructures:**

- a. Benghazi: target is 1 project: “Lifting sewage substation tender had lunched, No eligible contractor found, re-advertise again.

- b. Tripoli: target is 1 project, confirmed and agreed about the **(Hey Alzour water pump station rehab in Abouslaim municipality)**, and the technical package is completed, shared with UNHCR, tender lunched.
- **Other shelter projects:**
  - 1. **Other 28 HHs rehab housing units project in Tripoli:** V.assessment is completed. Starting the technical assessment by mid of September/2022.
  - 2. **Other 128 HHs rehab housing units project in Benghazi project, divided as following:**
    - 50Hhs sub-standard housing units rehabilitation in Benina are on going – completion 90%.
    - 50Hhs sub-standard housing units rehabilitation in Sidi Khalifa, in technical package completed and implementation expecting to be started by beginning of October 2022.
    - 28Hhs Sub-standard rehab housing unit in AlSabrie Neighborhood – V.assessment completed.
  - 3. **Shelter rehab for HHs level in Tawergha with a total of 246 housing units:** vulnerability assessments completed and start working on the preparation of technical package for the 1<sup>st</sup> batch of 50 housing units, implementation for the 1<sup>st</sup> batch just started on September2022.

### IRC

**The total number of individuals reached with NFIs assistance during August 2022 is 3,128, and the total number of distributed items is 7,470**

- Libyan Red Crescent Shelter, the team reached 14 clients and distributed a total of 45 items. (Abaya 8, Baby Kit 3, Blanket 1, Baby Diapers 6, Female HK 8, Kitchen set 8, Mattress 1, Male HK 2, Scarf 8)
- WPE: at the WGSS and other urban areas, the WPE team reached 192 clients and distributed a total of 584 Items. (Baby Kit 48, Baby Diapers 39, Blanket 8, Dignity Kit 59, Female HK 36, Male HK 34, Kitchen Set 33, Mattress 98, Soap Bar 196, Solar Lamp 33)
- Child Protection: The CP team reached 90 clients and distributed a total of 90 PSS Kits.
- Disembarkation Points: The protection team reached 831 survivors and distributed a total of 1,042 items. (Refreshment Kit 831, Male HK 202, Female HK 9)
- CDC: At the Community Day Center, the NFIs team reached 164 clients and distributed a total of 216 items (Baby Diapers 78, Female HK 62, Male HK 76)
- DCs: Tarik Al-matar, Tarik Sikka, and Ain Zara DCs, the protection team reached 1,837 detainees and distributed a total of 5,493 items, (Baby Diapers 36, Track Suit 1819, Female HK 195, Male HK 1624, Slippers 1819).

### CEFA

- **Distribution activities of Food and Hygiene kits in Zawiya:** on September 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup>, the ninth ordinary monthly distribution of Hygiene and FI kits took place in 4 different districts of the Municipality of Zawiya (Juddaim, Arewie, Khartoum/Bu Ghalasha and Terfas) for the benefit of 292 beneficiaries among migrants, refugees and asylum seekers in urban settings. The distribution has been organised and carried out by CEFA. 103 Hygiene and 103 FI Kits (individual/family kits) have been distributed to the beneficiaries.
- **Distribution activities of Food and Hygiene kits in Tripoli:** on September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup>, the third monthly distribution of Hygiene and FI kits took place in 4 different districts of Tripoli (Alswani, Ghout Al Shaal, Hay Alandalus and Tripoli Centre) for the benefit of migrants, refugees and asylum seekers in urban settings. The distribution has been organised and carried out by CEFA

in collaboration with CEFA's local partner, IOCS. 179 Hygiene and 199 FI Kits (individual/family kits) have been distributed for the benefit of 321 beneficiaries.

### **IOM**

#### **IOM SNFI Assistance: August 2022 DAU Outreach UPDATE**

- In this month DAU covered 3199 migrants in 7 mantikas which are Aljabal Alakhdar, Aljabal AlGarbi, Ejdabia, Tripoli, Wadi Alshaati, Azzawiya and Misurata.
- In detention center DAU covered 561 migrants with 1677 kits of NFIs.
- In Urban settings DAU covered 1364 migrants with 5130 kits of NFIs.
- Total NFIs Provided: 6807 (generally HKs, Mattresses, Blankets, Kitchen sets, Jerrycans, Solar lamps, and Clothing Kits).

#### **IOM SNFI Assistance: August 2022 MRRM Outreach UPDATE**

- The total number of migrants reached with NFIs assistance during August 2022 is 3523 among them 721 boys, 658 girls, 1127 men, 790 women, 150 elderly men, 77 elderly women. The Assistance provided where 2830 generally Clothing kits, Hygiene kits, Mattresses, Summer blankets, Diapers, and Solar lamps.

IOM also assisted 356 individuals with NFIs in Zwara in August.

### **UNHCR**

#### **NFIs:**

- 28 HH (164 Individuals) PoC in the CDC;
- 98 Evacuees to Rwanda;
- 42 individuals in Women's Rehabilitation Center;
- 2,421 individuals in Kufra, Shahat, Tolmith, Sikka, Ainzara and Tarik-Matar detention centers have received CRIs and HKs assistance; and,
- 105 HH (510 individuals) from Tawergha IDPs in Surman/and Zawia received NFIs.

#### **Shelter:**

##### **NRC projects:**

- Rehab and upgrade of 50 Housing units in AISabrie.
- Completed 100% on end of July.

##### **ACTED projects:**

- Rehabilitation and Renovation: 17 FEB PHC, Ajdabiya 11th Aug. 22.
- Rehabilitation Arab: Al-Sahra School- Alfjaj, Bent Baya municipality 30th Aug. 22

### **REACH**

#### **Capacity development of MoSA staff**

- Training of 100-150 MoSA staff on data collection in Tripoli
- Additional training in Benghazi expected in September 2022

#### **Data collection**

- REACH completed its share of data collection in August
- Given the delays in data collection by the part of the MoSA, REACH scaled up data collection to cover additional surveys – in total, REACH will cover 15 baladiyas (representative sample)
- Timeline: data collection is extended until the end of September; data published in mid-October  
-> timeline agreed with OCHA and compatible with the HNO

**Activating Emergency Plan**

- According to DTM-IOM, 65 HHs have been displaced: 50 HHs moved to Bani Walid (needs covered by LRC), and 15 HHs are staying with relatives inside Tripoli.
- MoSA conducted an assessment and confirmed two major needs: PSS support for women and children, and urgent rehabilitation of damaged homes in Abusalim and Central Tripoli.
- At the moment, there is no need to activate the response plan.

**Assistance requests**

- Outstanding requests from last year
  - 1- Murzuq IDPs in Greater Tripoli – UNHCR distributed to 622 HHs on Sep 13<sup>th</sup>.
  - 2- Ghiriyān (Host Community: 700 HH) – Still seeking partners to step in and
  - 3- Zawiya (Host Community: 254HH) – CEFA assisted 81 families, 173 remain seeking assistance.
  - 4- Zawiya (210HH) – UNHCR distributed to part of the population, only Wershefana and Tawergha IDPs remain.
  - 5- Aljalaa Hospital and Benghazi Medical Center (in Benghazi) – Requesting medical supplies post the Bent Baya explosion incident.
