John Wain

1. Indicative targets and requirements submitted for Ukraine winter response plan (UWRP) based on HNRP data (target approx. 1.8m people)
2. SNFI cluster working with UHF team on priorities for first winter reserve allocation (estimated \$50m) - priorities, activities, locations and beneficiaries – possible launch 05 July, submissions 19 July (TBC).
3. Energy coordination group (ECG) – UNDP – tech. workshop last week – significant shortage in energy as impact to Russian attacks on infrastructure (>60% of total capacity lost).
4. SNFI mid-year retreat on 11/12 July – request for attendees sent closing 27/06 – agenda (Activities/Emergency SOP, eVidnovlennia, MY strategy / transition, capacity building, AAP, Winterization)
5. eVidnovlennia follow up meeting tomorrow
6. Asbestos refresher as requested ad-hoc next week (UNDP) TBC & UNEP stakeholder meeting on 04 July

1. Shelter Cluster HNRP 2024 Activities Handbook v.1.2 was published. The main changes - "Targeting, Prioritization & Vulnerabilities" Chapter.

Outcomes from Shelter Cluster Meetings in Donetsk, Kharkivska, and Zaporizka:

1. Mapping of ESK partners to better manage emergency shelter resources until the end of the year
2. Review of winterization needs per Oblast
3. Technical Recommendations of how to report distribution of construction materials in SIDAR
4. Challenges with making real time data available for coordination available for emergencies, SIDAR, planning for de-duplication, and winterization
5. Occurrence of twice or three-time damaged addresses in Donetsk and Zaporizka Oblasts – targeting for ESK vs repair interventions
6. Status of e-vidnovlennya implementation in various oblasts and coordination with light, medium, and common area repair interventions

Zaporizhzhia monitoring visits 12th and 18th

1. Low understanding of e-vidnovlennya amidst population
2. Importance of guidelines and flexibility in modalities selected

2. Improved coordination communication on ESK in emergencies (next slide)



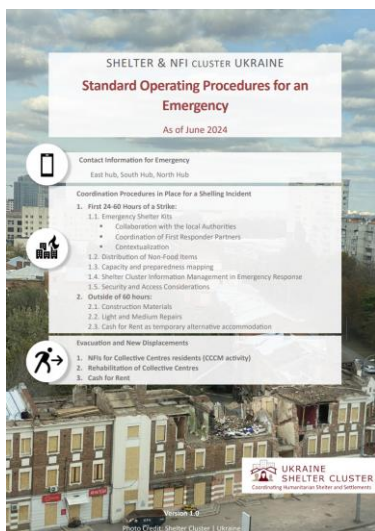

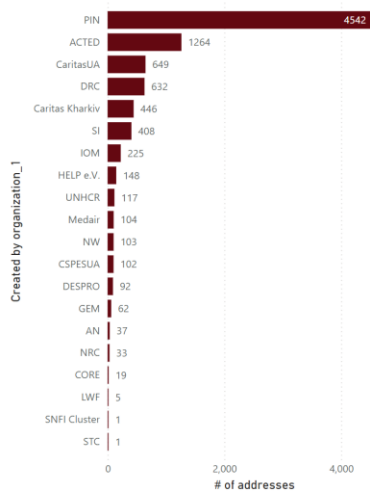

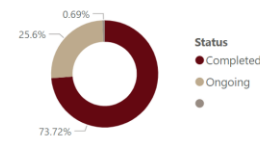
Modality of Intervention



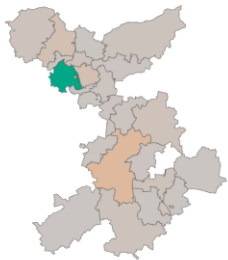
Number of Addresses by Organization



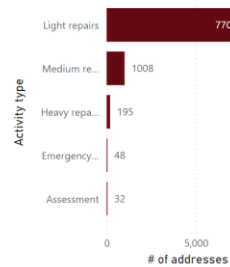
Status of Interventions



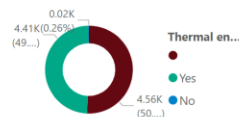
Number of Unique Addresses per Hromada



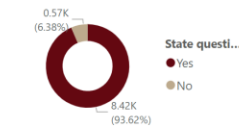
Type of Activity



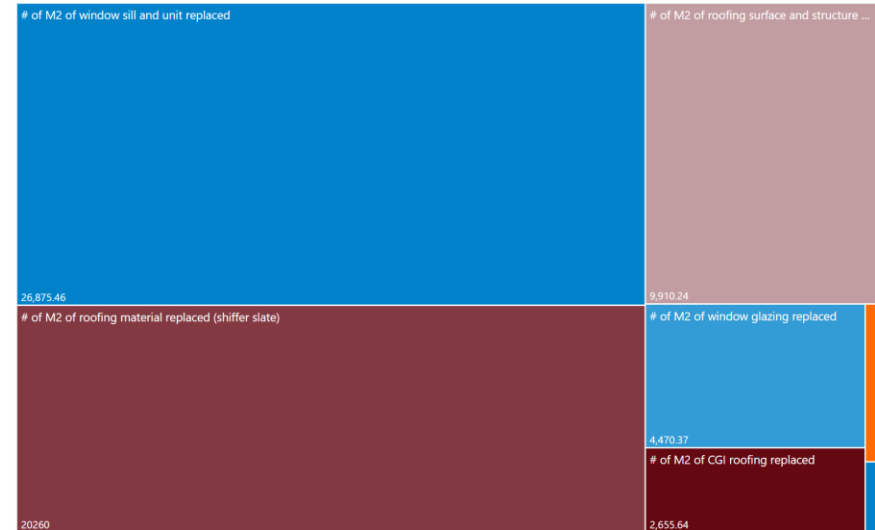
Thermal Envelope

- Emergency response whatsapp group for Ivano-Frankivsk
- Partners in the region continue providing NFI assistance with focus on new arrivals and IDP organizations.
- The general tendency in the Hub is scale down of SNFI activities and shift to durable solutions and development.
- Increased number of attacks is reported in the region, especially in Vinnytska and Khmelnytska oblasts
