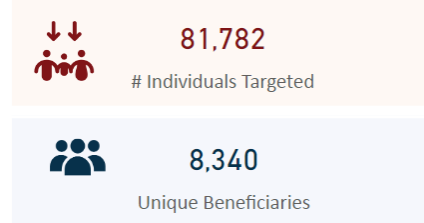

Monitoring mission to Chernihiv oblast (ACTED, NRC, PIN, ZOA, District 1)

Key findings:

- no-harm approach (eRestoration programme)
- asbestos materials
- construction materials delivered in 22 are in place and not installed
- HLP issues especially for completely-destroyed houses

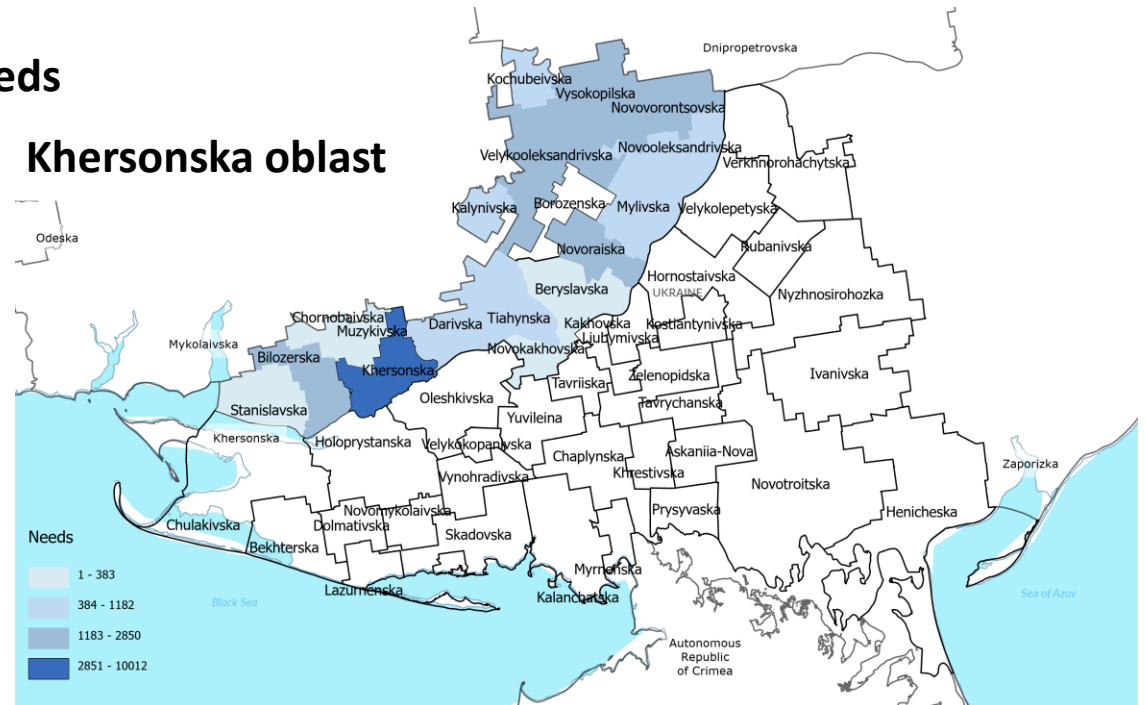
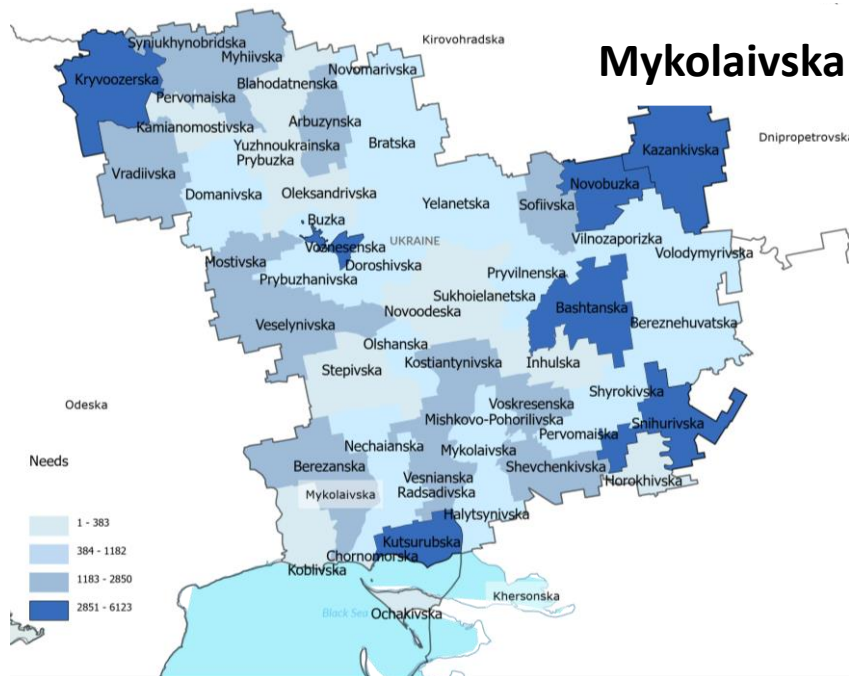

2. Sub-national level cluster coordination highlights: Southern region general update

Tetiana Kurinska

- The SNFI Cluster South Hub has maintained regular robust coordination with Odeska, Mykolaivska and Khersonska oblasts
- An early mapping exercise was performed with partners and authorities in two oblasts (intensions to provide Winterization support have expressed 12 partners in Mykolaivska oblast, 13 partners in Khersonska oblast)
- The exercise assessed the capacities of all stakeholders to meet the upcoming winter season's demands
- The SNFI Cluster South Hub has participated in offline meeting with Vice Prime Minister on early Winterization preparedness for Mykolaivska and Khersonska oblasts

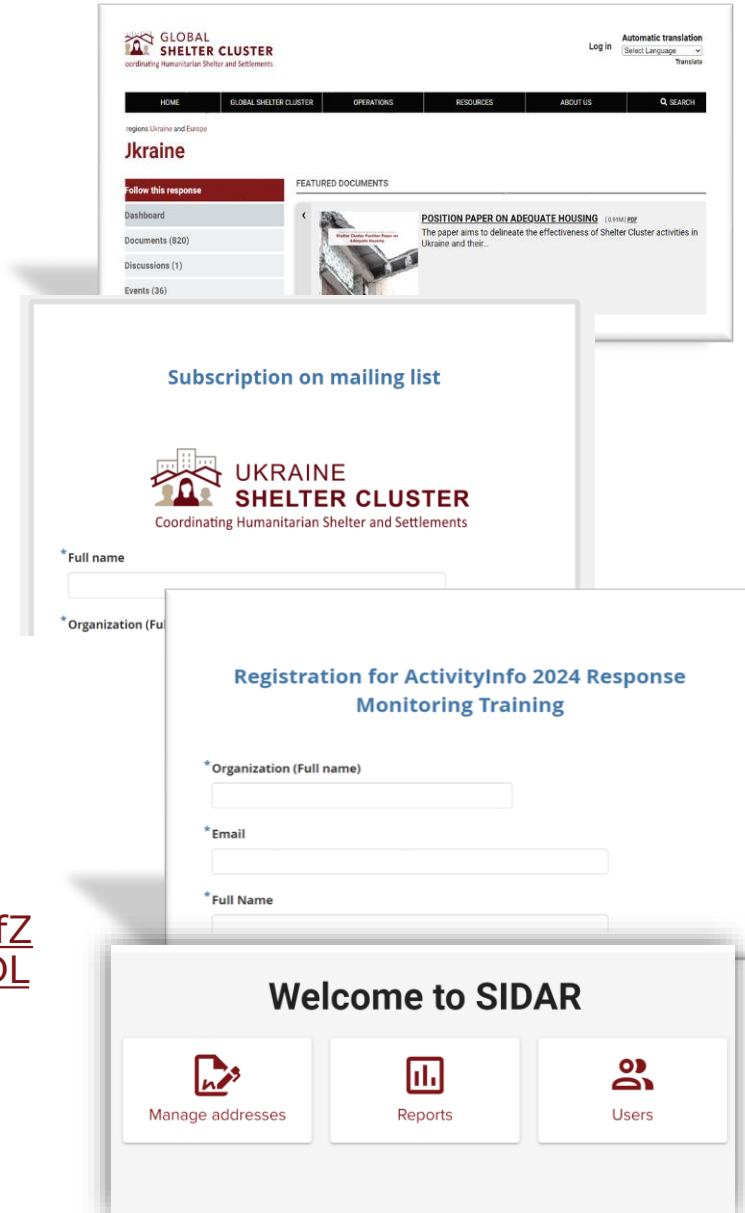

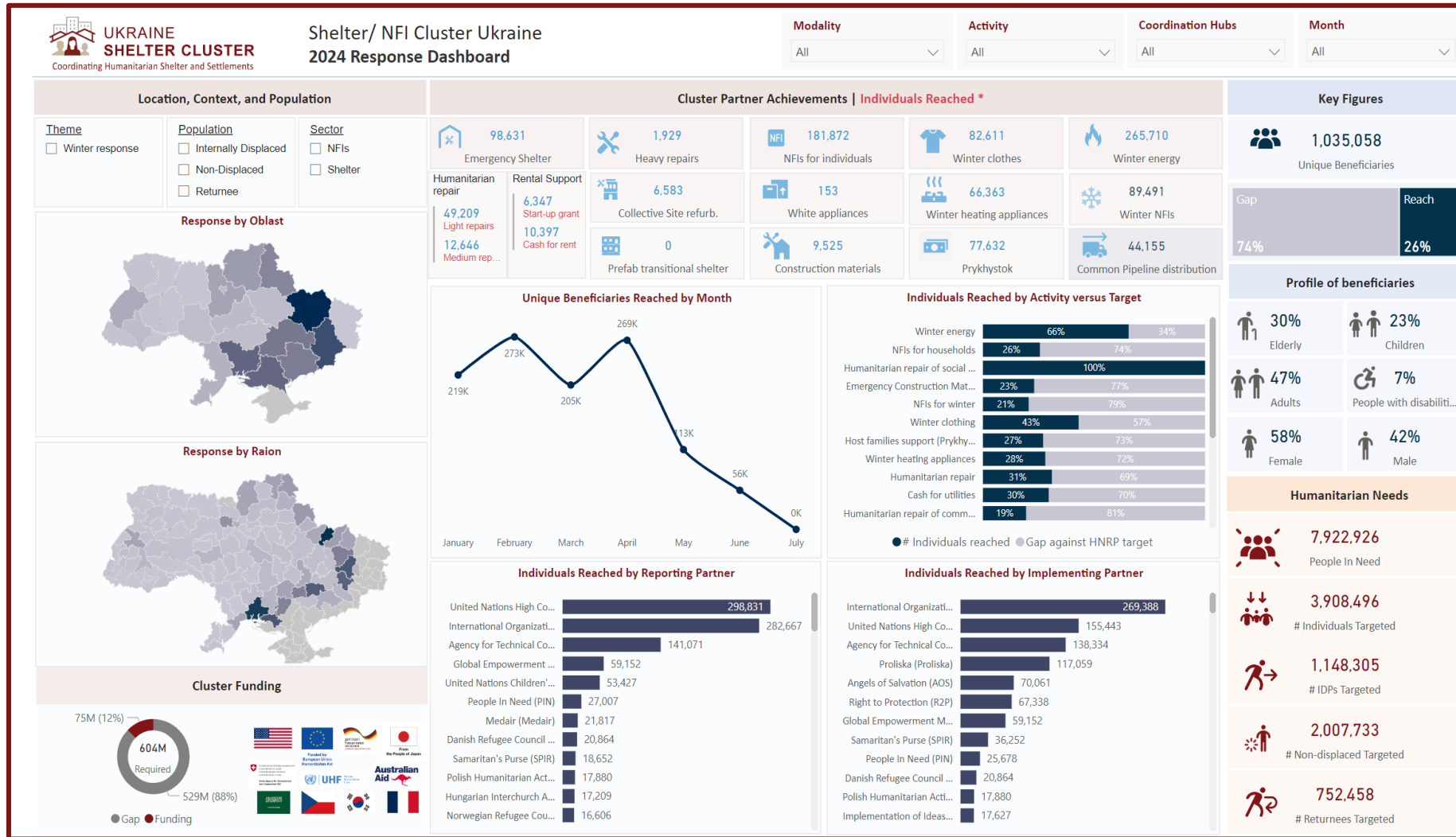

Introduction

The following is a specific guide to **SNFI Cluster ActivityInfo planning for winter 2024 – 2025**. [Training materials for regular reporting](#) along with [guidance on Cluster activities](#) and Cluster [Winterization recommendation](#) should be used to supplement this document. This is a living document which will be updated based on additional relevant information or feedback.

ActivityInfo

ActivityInfo was endorsed by the Information Management Working Group (IMWG) and the inter-cluster Coordination Group (ICCG) in 2023 as the common platform for Ukraine response monitoring. This platform will continue to be the entry point for planning and response for winter 2024 – 2025. Additional tools for field level coordination and deduplication are not dealt with in this document.

Winter planning through ActivityInfo

The process for planning for the 2024 – 2025 winterization response builds on the process and lessons learned during 2023 – 2024 winterization. That means **planning early**, at a high level that provides indicative information to the Cluster on funding availability, geographic scope of intervention and key activities. These **plans should be continually refined** as project funding and details become more concrete.

Document target audience

The target audience for this guide are reporting focal points for SNFI programming/ reporting partners. User access is granted only to reporting/ programming organisations. **Partners implementing on behalf of another organisation should not report through ActivityInfo to avoid duplication**. Implementing partners should contact their programming organisation to ensure they report on behalf of implementing partners.

Joint Market Monitoring Initiative (JMMI)

Purpose

Aims to inform and enhance understanding of market dynamics in Ukraine.

Serves as a reference for costs and availability in assessed areas.

Implementation

Field teams assess marketplaces across Ukraine.

Record prices and other indicators through interviews with retailers and customers.

REACH conducts online price monitoring nationwide.

SNFI Market Monitoring

SNFI aims to enhance its market monitoring capabilities by providing timely and accurate information on item prices and availability.

Methodology

1

Data Collectors:

SNFI partners are invited to volunteer in the collection of data for JMMI.

2

Frequency:

Once every three months.

3

REACH Questionnaire:

REACH would develop a Kobo tool targeted to retailers to collect the prices and availability of NFI and heating appliances that would be used by data collectors.

4

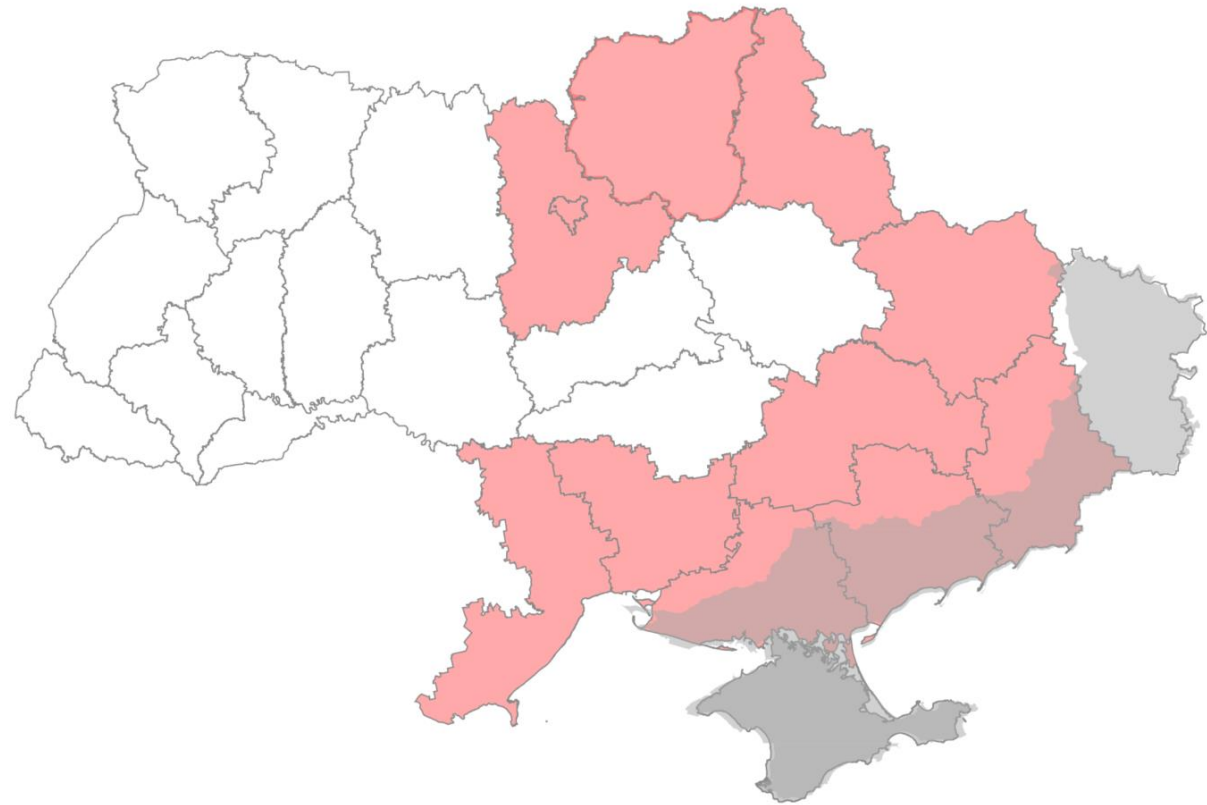
Data Collection:

Field teams are tasked with collecting a minimum of 2-3 prices per item for 3 different locations, if available, per assessed oblast.
