Call for abstracts

Background

The **Shelter Projects** is a bi-annual publication of the Global Shelter Cluster, which compiles case studies and overviews of **shelter and settlement responses in support of disaster- and conflict-affected populations**, implemented by national and international organizations, UN agencies, NGOs and host governments.

Shelter Projects started 13 years ago and contains a total repository of nearly **300 project case studies** and response overviews, from programs implemented by over 60 organizations in over 70 countries.

Call for abstracts

We are currently looking for **new shelter and settlements case studies** that took/are taking place during 2020-2022 to be included in the **Shelter Projects 9th edition**.

The abstracts can be submitted in **ARABIC, ENGLISH, FRENCH and SPANISH**, but note that case studies will be developed **predominantly in English**. (Efforts will be made to accommodate requests and support the development of case studies in other languages)

Criteria for inclusion:

- The project has to be **directly related to the Shelter and Settlements sector**, including beyond shelter: NFI distributions, Cash for Shelter, HLP, Site Planning, Settlements Approach, IEC materials, market based programmes, etc.
- The shelter project must be **wholly completed**, or **solid learnings can be gained** from the project implementation to date.
- Given the scale of emergency shelter need every year, **case studies must have had large-scale impacts**. Discontinued trials or design concepts will not be included.
- The majority of the project must be implemented within the first year following a natural disaster, or over longer time frames for recovery processes. For conflict, chronic emergencies and return processes, longer time scales will be considered.
- **Accurate project information is available** from staff involved in the project implementation.
- The case studies should **illustrate a diversity of approaches** to meet shelter need.
