### 1. Introduction

NICCO (Japanese NGO) introduced themselves and said they are planning to implement a shelter project in Capoocan Municipality.

### 2. Updates from DSWD/CSWD/Tacloban Shelter TWG

- The Focal Point introduced several TWGs that are currently operating in Tacloban and encourage interested partners to be in their mailing list.

- The Focal Point also informed that there has been increased human capacity of DSWD for the Region VIII and allocation of these personnel are under discussion with the Shelter Cluster in Tacloban.
- CSWD informed the Cluster that there are three bunk houses sites in Ormoc City as a part of temporary relocation in the Ormoc City. Those are Barangay Concepcion, Canuntog, Liano. They are in different stage of construction (90% in Concepcion, 50% in Canuntog and not yet started in Liano). While the target households were already listed and CSWD conducted two meetings with them, they are not sure when the target households are going to move into the bunk houses.
- UNHCR raised a concern over the selection process and reinforced the importance of informed/consulted decision-making for those households. CSWD promised to share the list of target households with the Focal Point.
- The Focal Point requested CSWD to clarify the issue of “no build zone”. CSWD said the target households are those informally living around the City Hall and also those living close to the coast line.
- OCHA explained that the issue of the relocation project especially standards of these structures are being discussed in Manila HC and will come out with an advisory document. Based on the advisory, relevant Cluster Coordinators in Ormoc will meet with the City Government early next week.
- CSWD appreciated the support from UNDP for disaster mapping and they will request the Regional DSWD

### 3. Information Management

- UNCHR is currently distributing tarpaulins and NFIs in the municipalities where the biggest gap exist.
- IOM has distributed 5,000 emergency shelter kits in NW municipalities and will distribute another 5,000 by the end of this year. Save the Children will distribute 2,000 in partnership with IOM.
- The Focal Point requested partners to report their activities to the Shelter Cluster.
- UNHCR raised their concern over how some of the municipalities are selecting beneficiaries (i.e. raffle draw). They also raised the issue of indigenous population that has not being assisted and they require special attention.

- The meeting agreed that engagement of municipality government prior to the distribution planning is crucial to get the latest information on who have provided what and where.

#### 4. Recovery Shelter

- IOM Shelter Officer gave a presentation of his trips to most of the municipalities in Western Leyte, and Biliran Province. One of the crucial issues is securing sufficient coco lumbers to the beneficiaries.
- He suggested to form a small group to discuss longer term shelter in Western Leyte and encouraged interested agencies to attend.

#### 5. CCCM

- Due to the time constraints and the issue of bunk houses were already discussed earlier, CCCM updates will be given at the next meeting.

#### 6. AOB

- The next meeting scheduled for 27<sup>th</sup> December will be postponed to 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2014.
