Response update

- **263.879** persons assisted by the Shelter and NFI cluster partners since 25 of February
- **109.231** assisted people with NFI kits in collective centers
- **109.680** assisted people with NFI kits at household level
- **27.692** assisted people with shelter kits
- **6.539** received winterization support (approx.)
- **20K** assisted persons/week as reported
- Reduced by 10k from last week and by 40K from April
