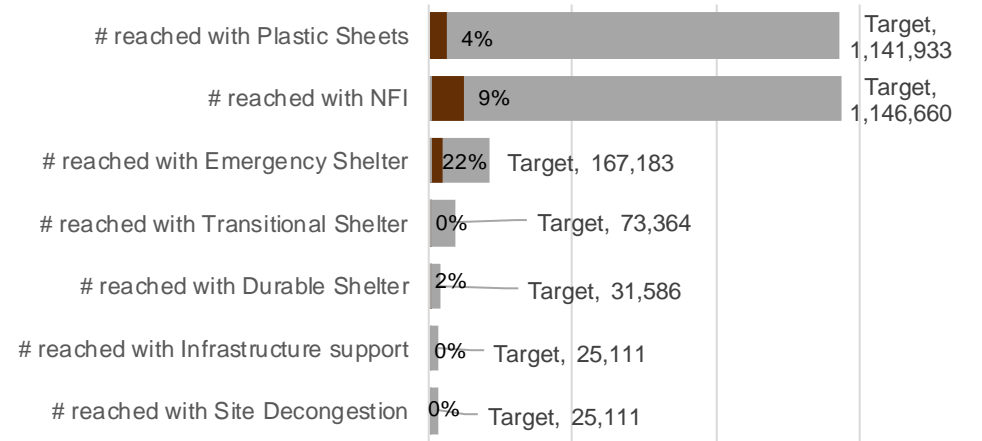

2023 SHELTER AND NFI TARGETS VS RESPONSE

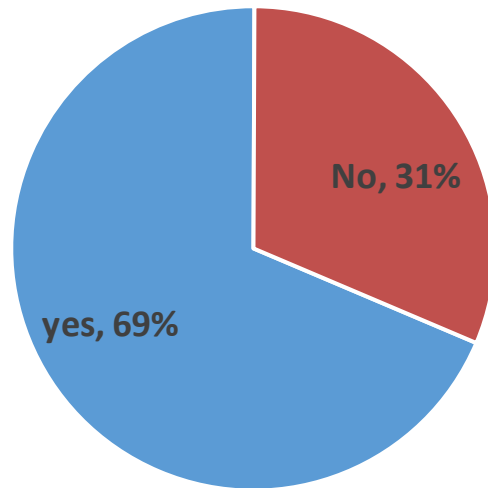


2023 HRP INDICATORS PERFORMANCE

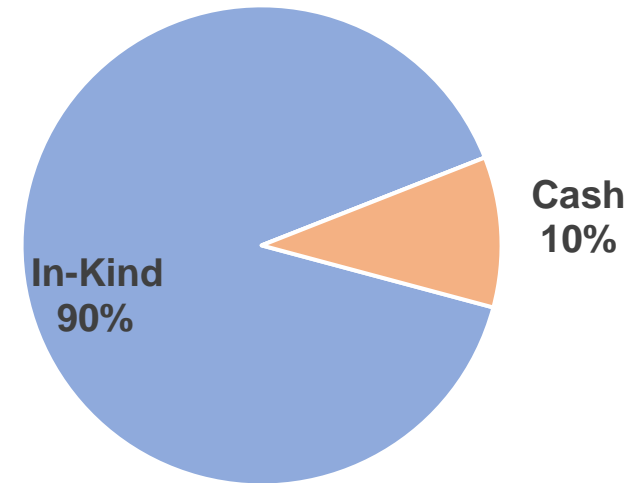

BRIEFING ON LAAS CAANOOD

SITUATION OVERVIEW

Current

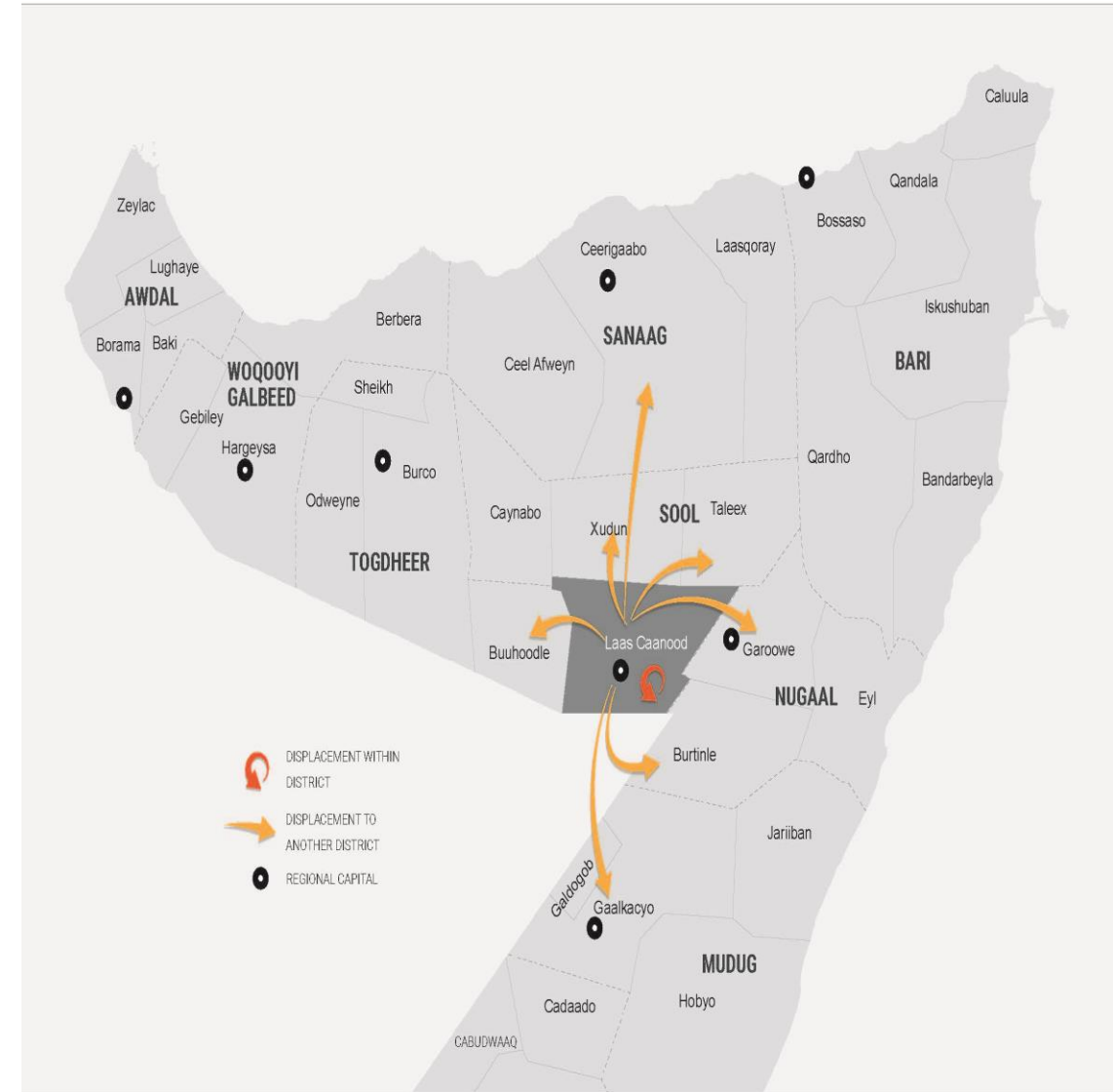
- About 15,500 newly displaced people have joined the host communities
- At least 80 people killed and 451 injured

Displacement

- B\W 154,000 to 203,000 people have been displaced by the fighting since late December 2022
- Displacement to five regions (Sool, Togdheer, Bari, Nugaal and Mudug)
- Some persons crossed the borders to Ethiopia (around 60.000)

Access

- Access to all IDP sites through Puntland is accessible and not to all through Somaliland.

RESPONSE



SHELTER

- Non-food items (NFI) kits distributed to 1,450 families (about 8.700 people) in Kalabeyd and Gumeys Sool region
- **500 NFI kits from Somaliland and distributed to IDPS in Gumays , Sool region. (3297 people in, including 2636 (80%) children, 328 (10%) women, and 333 (10%) who were recently displaced in the Laas Caanood conflict**
- **ACTED and NRC registered 600 HHs (approximately 36,000 individuals) in six sites in Sool region to receive cash for NFIs and Emergency Shelter Kits**
- **ACTED provides cash assistance to 1800HHs in Ade adeye, Tuulo samakab, Yagoori.**
- **Care International provide cash assistance to 2400HHs in Ceerigaabo, Fiqifuliye**

IDENTIFIED NEEDS BY S-ICCG



SHELTER

- Emergency shelter and NFIs are needed for Boocame, God Qaboobe and Kalabeydh villages in Sool region, where people have been affected by stormy rains that caused severe havoc to their shelters
- Some IDPs, including women, children and elderly are sheltered in schools and open spaces
- **Shelter materials are needed to all displaced community.**

ONGOING ACTIVITIES

- Negotiation on humanitarian access from Somaliland is going on, especially to the areas which are not yet accessible by Garowe or Somaliland teams. The locations, include (Yagoori, Gumays, Adhe adeye). Somaliland team organized two missions but all of them were blocked at Oog town because of insecurity
- Somaliland planning assessment to Yagoori, Gumays, and Adhe adeye, if security permits
- 11-13 March: Interagency mission to Buhoodle
- 12 – 16 OCHA: Access Unit mission to Puntland and Somaliland
- OCHA IM unit is developing Laas Caanood Operational Presence Map
- OCHA, IOM DTM and CCCM to streamline/verify the number of IDPs and villages/districts with the displaced population from Laas Caanood
- Response is ongoing and partners are updating the response matrix – OCHA IM has developed online format to support real-time reporting
- Coordination with the Government authorities is ongoing – Requests submitted by the LAAS CAANOOD Local Government authority

CHALLENGES

- **Limited humanitarian access to the IDPs sites from Somaliland sides because of insecurity, especially for Gumays, Adhe adeye and Yagoori areas.**
- **Clan dynamics prevents people from other clans in Somaliland working with the humanitarian partners to access Laas Caanood**
- **Internal influence from Laas Caanood asking IDPs not to accept assistance from Somaliland side affect rapid deployment of supplies**

ASKS

- Response to be scaled up to meet the increasing/current needs of the displaced people across all the clusters
- Due to the active conflict in Lass Cannood town, the people affected might remain displaced for a long time. Therefore, the ICCG should sustain its resource mobilization efforts
- **Increase advocacy for humanitarian access for partners from Somaliland**
- **Peace negotiations/ ceasefire to allow smooth humanitarian response**
- **Air assets from Somaliland/Puntland to IDP towns/sites to allow timely assessment/delivery assistance when road access become challenging**
