Escalation – October 2023

Update #1: 13 October 2023

Overview:

Since Saturday, October 7th, the Gaza Strip has endured severe and ongoing Israeli bombardment. Approximately **480,000** individuals are internally displaced within the governorates, with an estimated **300,000** IDPs migrating massively from the northern parts of Gaza to the south of Wadi Gaza after Israel issued warnings to the people in this area. The total number of IDPs is now **780,000**. According to the Gaza Ministry of Public Works and Housing, **5,540** housing units (HUs) were destroyed, **3,743** HUs severely damaged and rendered uninhabitable, and **55,000** HUs suffered minor to moderate damage. In total, **64,283** HUs have been destroyed or damaged, constituting approximately **15%** of residential housing units in Gaza.
