Key highlights

Context

- **Surge in Daily Strikes:** Shelter Cluster partners across various regions in the East, North and South, notably Dnipropetrovsk, Kharkivska and Zaporizka, are grappling with an increase in daily strikes. The East Hub's [dashboard](#) aids in tracking emergency responses to these attacks.
- **Call for Additional Support:** In the east with one organization bearing the brunt of emergency response efforts, there's an urgent need for more partners to join in supporting affected areas. To streamline coordination, Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) have been established.
- **Evacuation Planning:** Authorities in Sumska and Chernihivska Oblasts are crafting contingency plans for evacuating vulnerable populations from high-risk zones and ensuring their essential needs, including Non-Food Items, are met.
- **Infrastructure Targeted:** Russian attacks have resulted in significant restrictions on electricity supply, exacerbating challenges for communities in the East and South.

Shelter Cluster's East, North, South, and West Hubs have been actively engaged in responding to escalating conflicts and attacks in various regions of Ukraine. East Hub conducted monitoring missions in [Kharkivska](#) and [Zaporizka](#) oblasts focusing on the distribution of solid fuel, repairs, and emergency response. Furthermore [technical guidelines](#) were provided to partners to distinguish between first response emergency shelter which closes the building envelope, and repairs to close the thermal envelope. The North Hub focuses on developing contingency plans to safeguard communities in Sumska and Chernihivska Oblasts, partners provided ESK support and planned interventions on light and medium repairs. The number of IDPs coming from eastern Ukraine to the North is rising. In the South and East, infrastructure damages from Russian attacks have led to shortages in electricity, water, and gas, while rapid response initiatives in the Mykolaiv and Odesa regions address immediate needs. Conversely, the West Hub shifts its attention towards prioritizing NFI assistance for new arrivals and addressing emergency repair needs resulting from heightened attacks. Shelter Cluster's coordinated efforts aim to mitigate the immediate impact of the Russian attacks while strategizing for [long-term support](#) and resilience within affected communities.

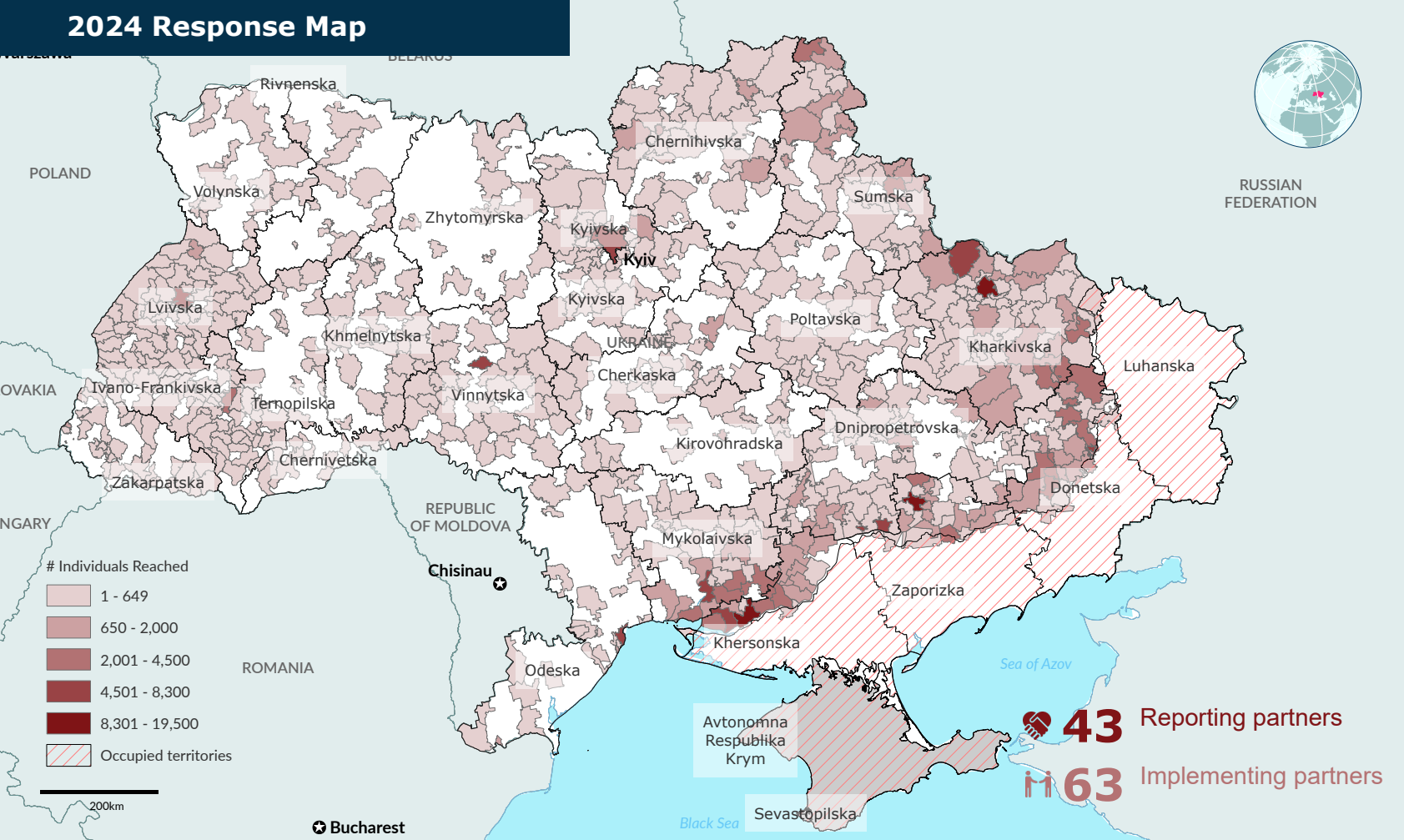

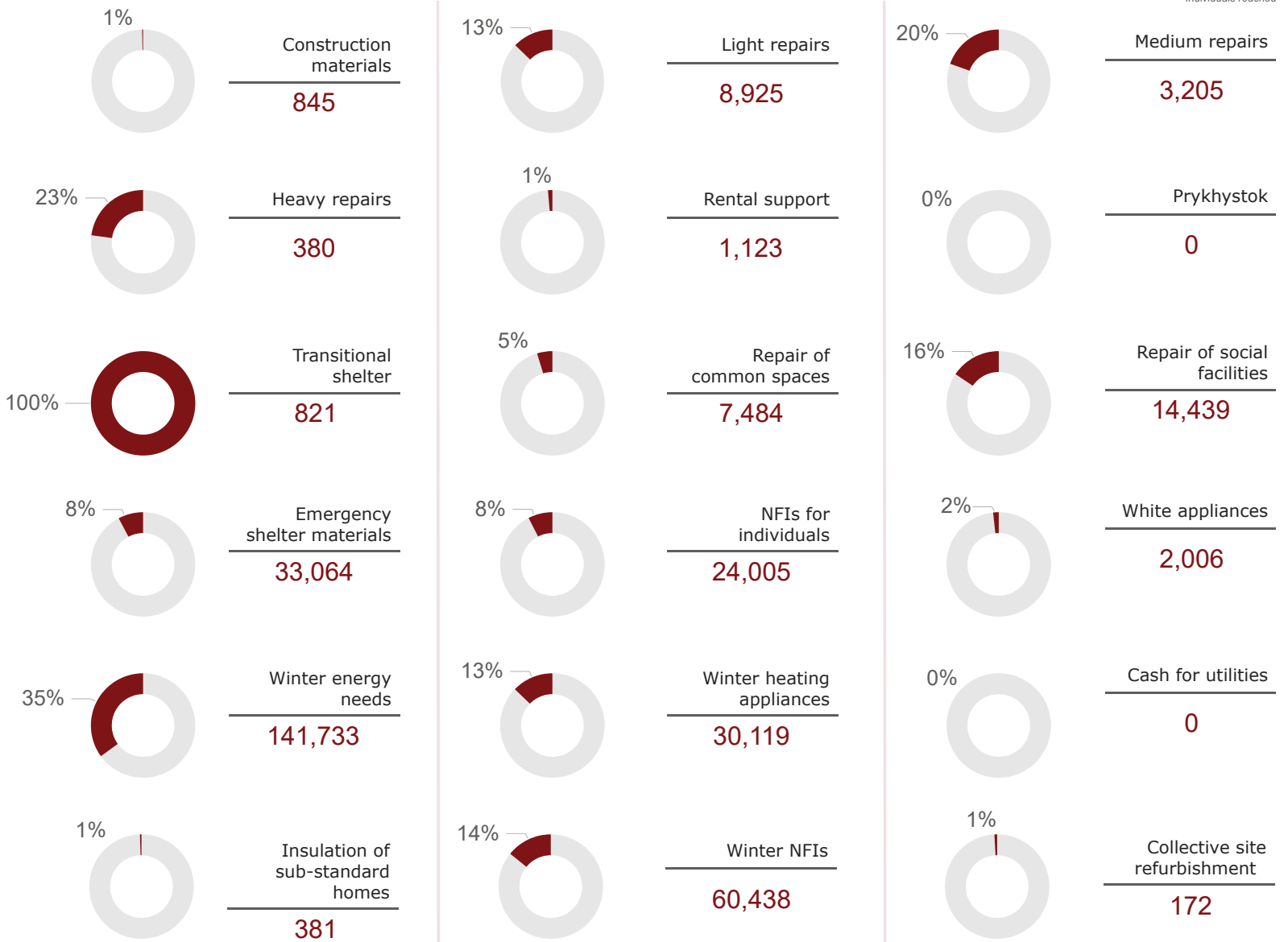
