**Context**

- During a quick technical working group, the [rental market assistance SOP](#) was updated with the latest reference prices, recommendations, and lessons learned from last year.
- The TWIG winterization meeting concluded with the latest [Winterization guideline document](#), incorporating updated prices and lessons learned.
- The collection of the response plan from partners was initiated.
- Meetings were held with Mykolaivska and Khersonska oblasts, designated by the Ministry of Reintegration as critical regions in need of winter energy support.
- In the North Hub, partners actively responded to the escalation of conflicts and attacks.
- The Shelter Cluster Standard Operating Procedure for emergencies was published in both English and Ukrainian after endorsement by the Strategic Advisory Group.

**Summary:**

In June, the Shelter Cluster **East Hub** held meetings for Donetsk, Zaporizka, and Kharkivska oblasts. Two monitoring missions were conducted with partners, focusing on light and medium repairs. These missions reviewed beneficiary selection and the implementation of in-kind and cash programming. They also highlighted the status of e-vidnovlennya within the oblasts and emphasized the need to raise program awareness among the population.

The Shelter Cluster's emergency SOP was published in [English](#) and [Ukrainian](#), endorsed by the Strategic Advisory Group. This allowed more partners to join the ESK response, supporting UNHCR, Proliska, and Angels of Salvation. Winterization preparations continued, with needs data reviewed by Oblast administrations.

**West Hub:** June saw an unusually high number of missile and UAV attacks, causing varying levels of damage across most oblasts. SNFI Cluster Partners, alongside the State Emergency Service of Ukraine and the Red Cross, were among the first responders. UNHCR partner Rokada played a major role, distributing ESKs and other materials to meet immediate shelter needs. The overall trend in the hub remains the scaling down of SNFI activities and the finalization of ongoing projects.

**North Hub:** Partners in the North Hub actively responded to escalating conflicts and attacks in Sumy, Chernihiv, Kyiv, and Poltava regions by providing Emergency Shelter Kits (ESKs). A Shelter and NFI Cluster Sub-national meeting was held in Chernihiv region on June 18 with partners and local authorities.

**South Hub:** The SNFI Cluster South Hub maintained robust coordination, holding meetings with Mykolaivska and Khersonska oblasts, which were designated by the Ministry of Reintegration as critical regions in need of support with winter energy. An early mapping exercise with partners and authorities assessed the capacity to meet the upcoming winter season's demands.

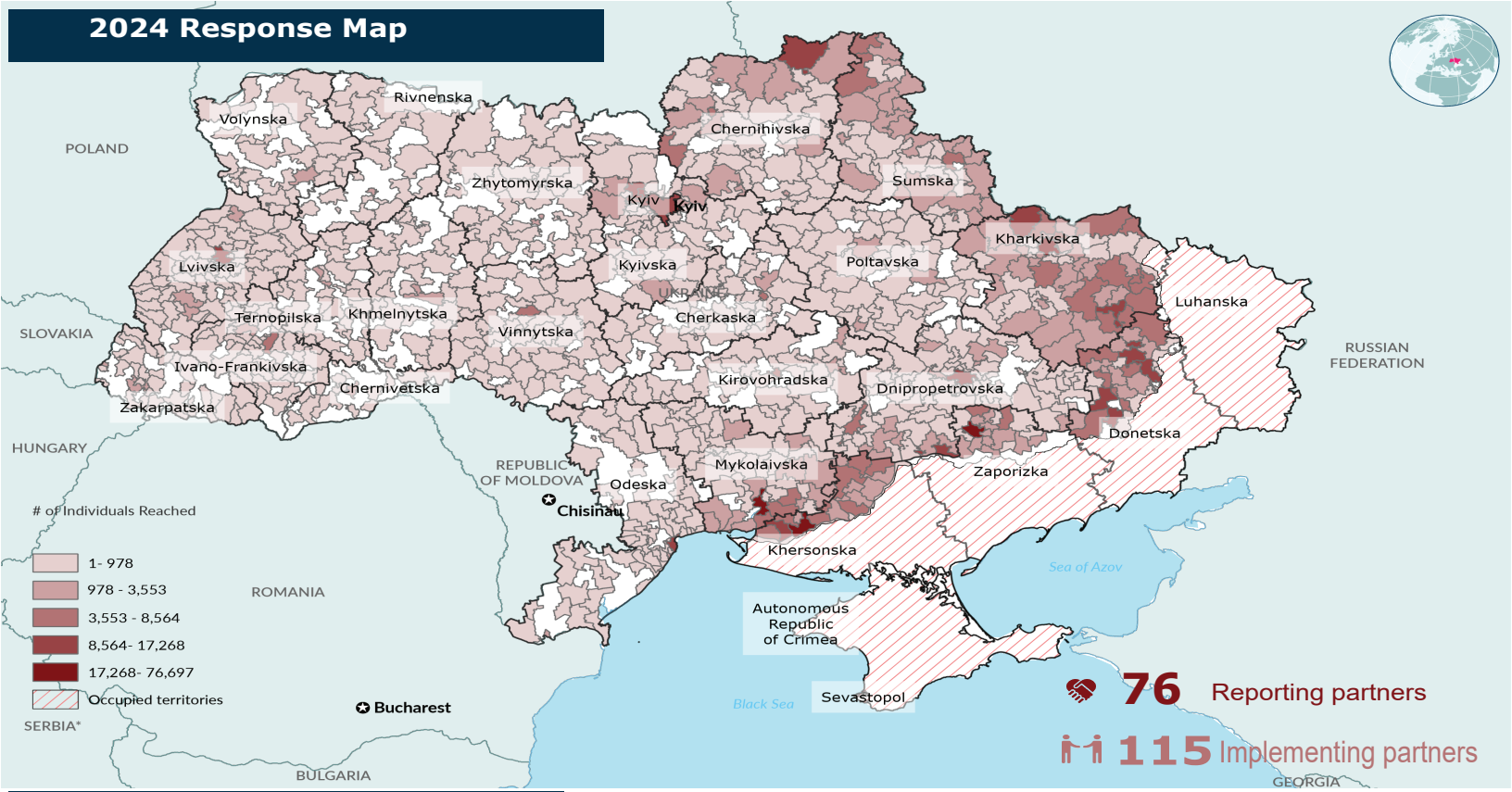

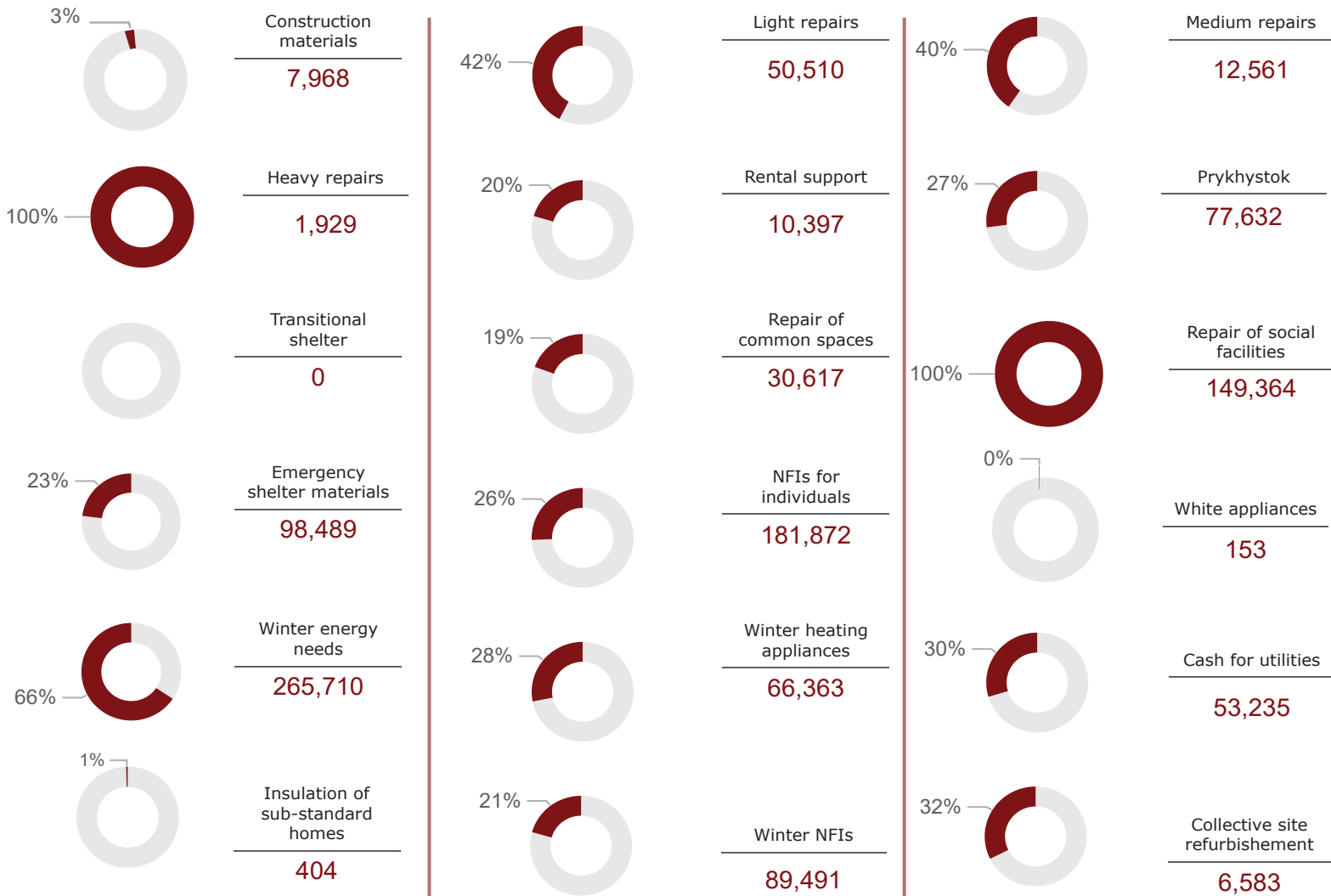
