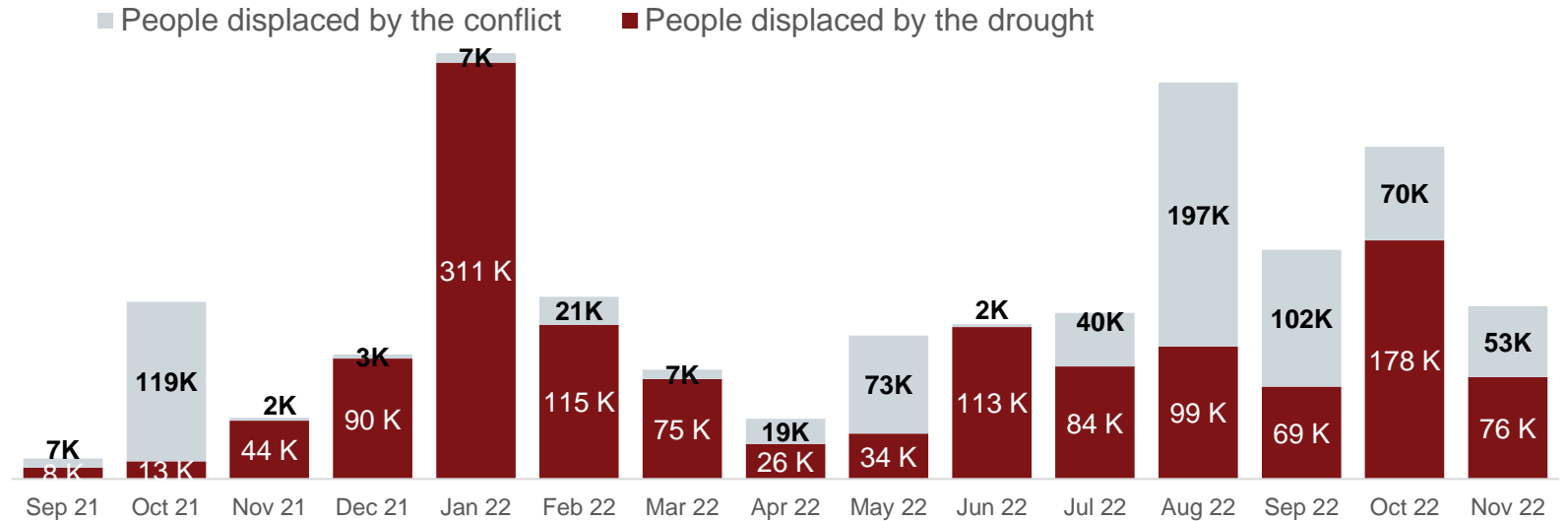

Somalia is facing a **Drought** and a **displacement Crisis**.



1,826,000 People displaced during the last 12 months



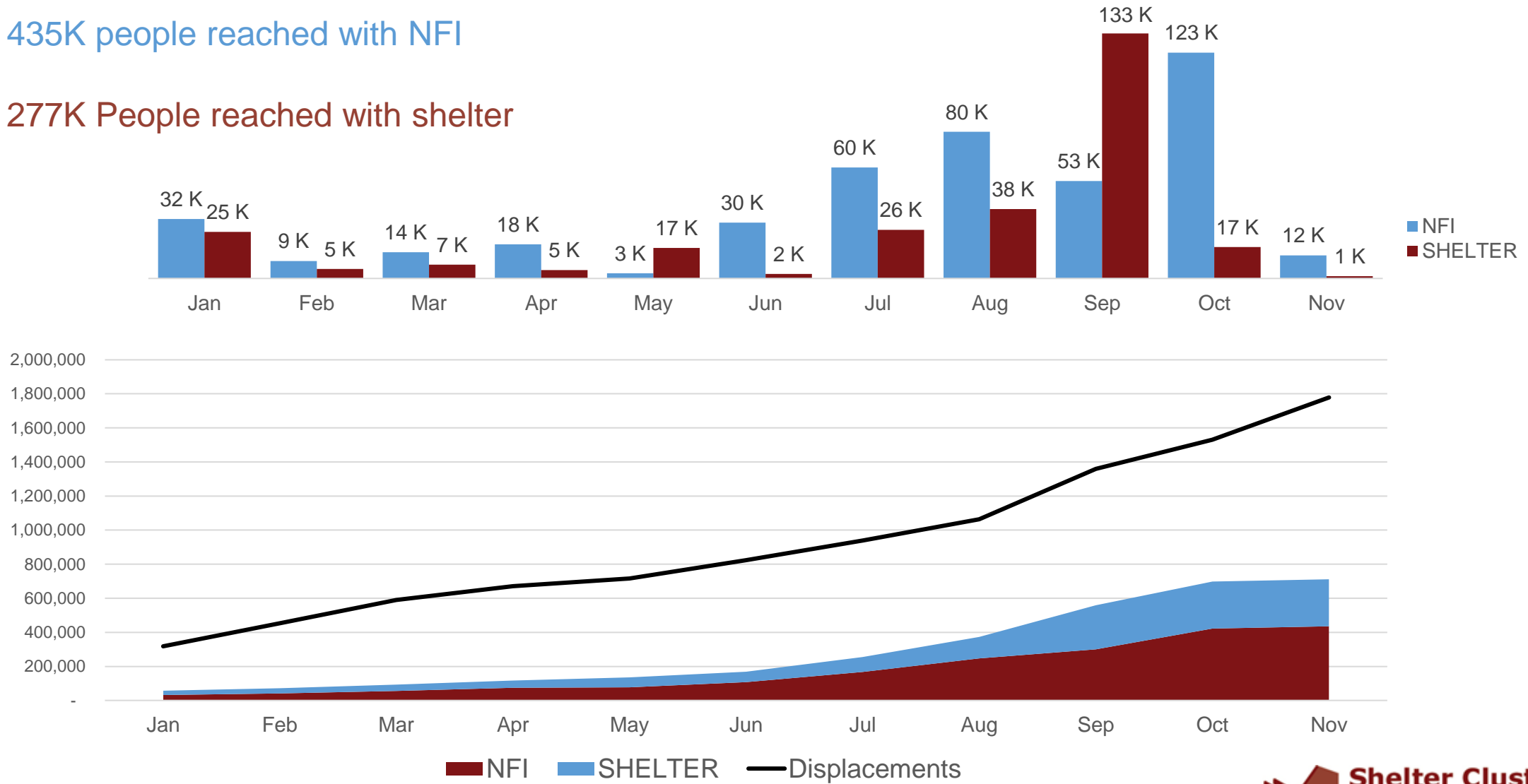
Together with **Food and WASH**, **Shelter** is one of the top three priorities for displaced people.

Newly internally displaced people do not have access to proper shelter construction materials resulting in lack of privacy, space, security, protection against the elements.

Shelter Cluster partners scaled up the response

■ 435K people reached with NFI

■ 277K People reached with shelter

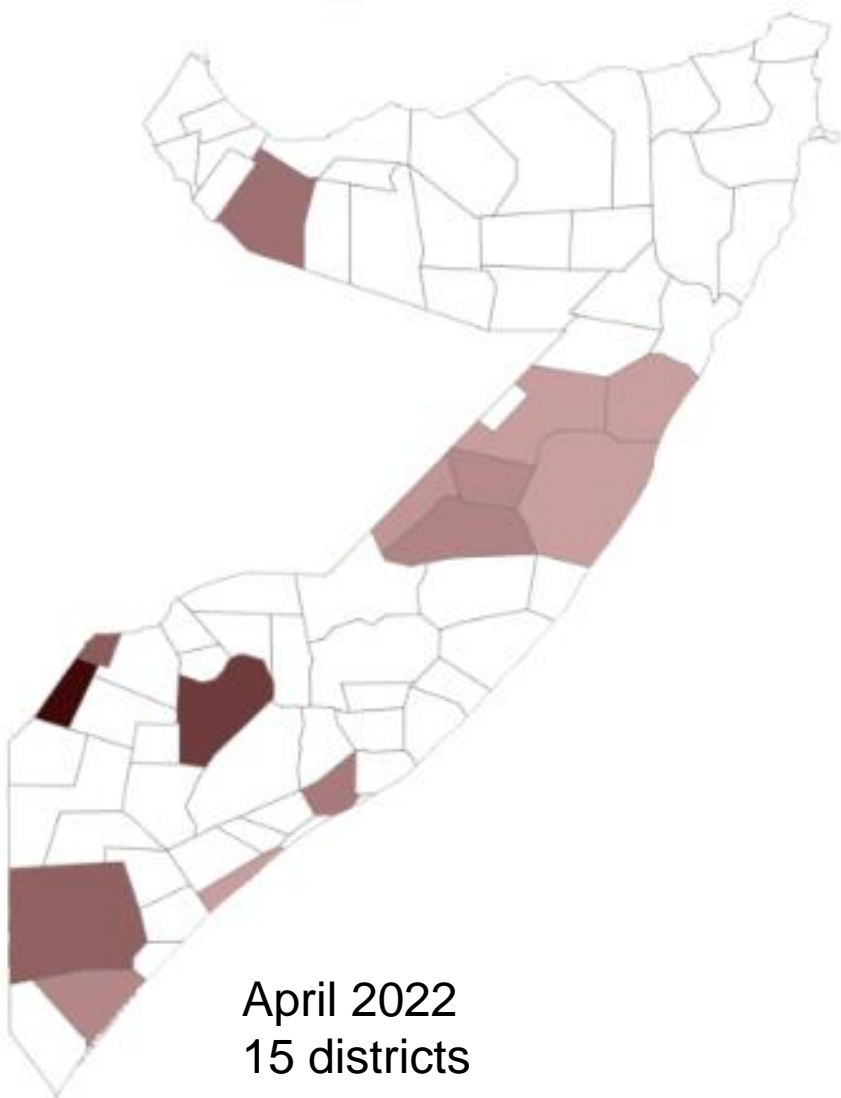


Shelter Cluster partners scaled up the response

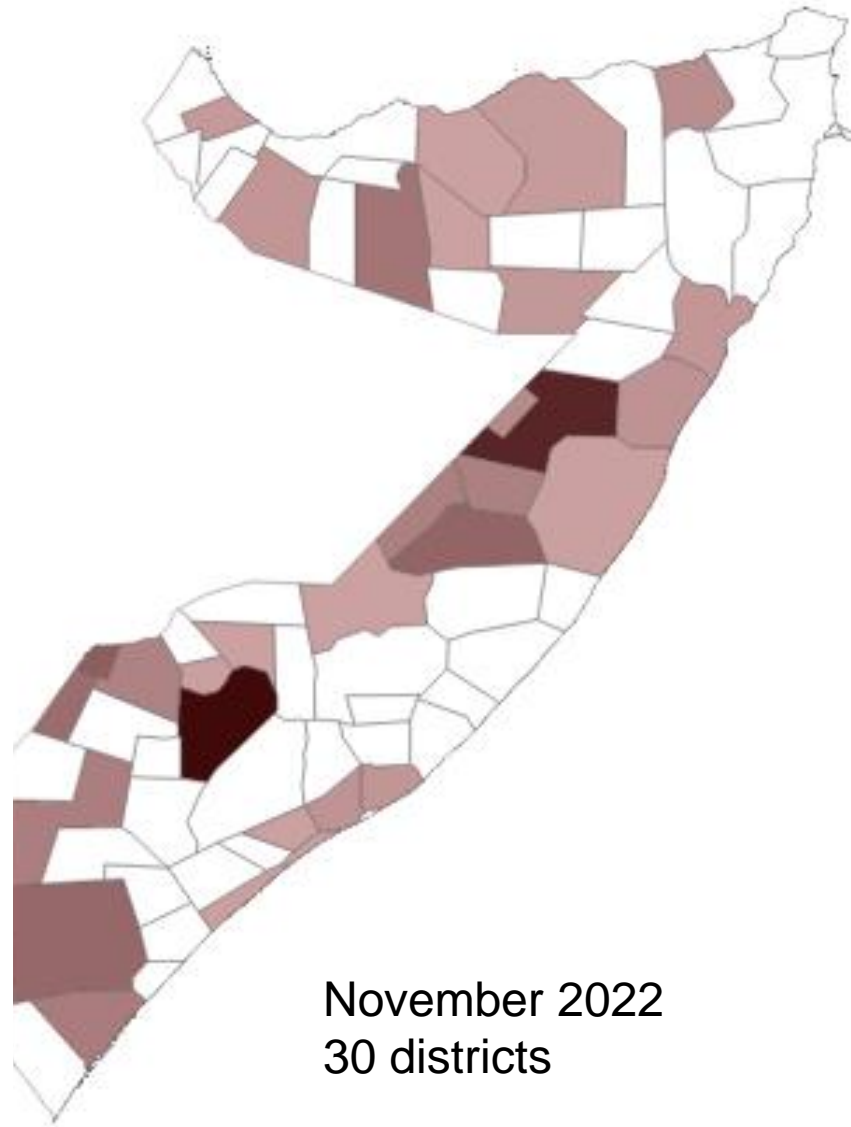
Scale up in terms of Geographical coverage.

Key affected districts have been prioritized but many districts have not received any Shelter/NFI assistance.

Most of the shelter cluster partners have already implemented their project and are looking for funding in 2023



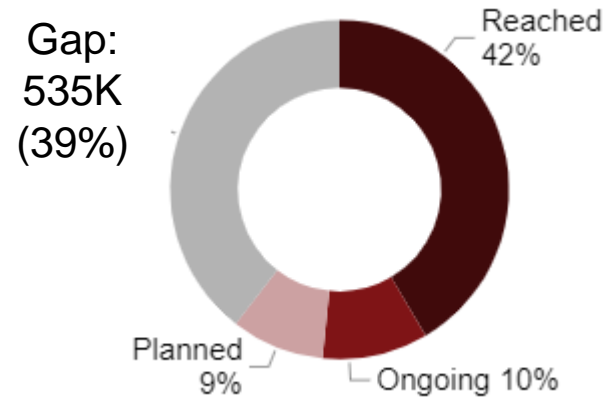
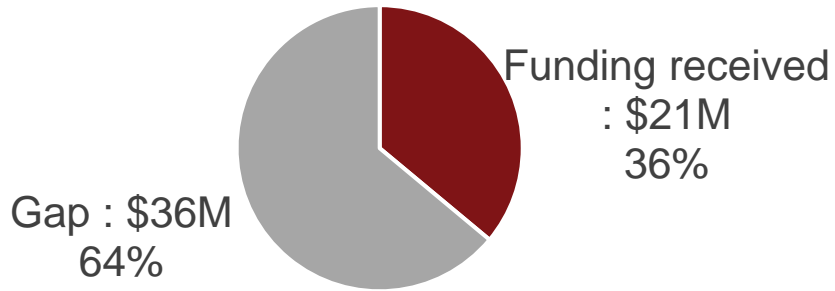

Barriers

Funding Gap



- Most donors prefer to fund emergency shelter (6-12 months durability).
- Low funding for transitional/durable shelter
- No access to land for IDPs in Banadir.
- 143.000 IDPs have been evicted and lost their shelter in Banadir in 2022

What can we do differently ?

BETTER TARGETTING Improve coordination between CCCM, Protection and Shelter & NFI Clusters to better target marginalized groups and minorities at IDP site level using harmonized list of settlements and IDP sites.

EMERGENCY Rethinking the emergency shelter and NFI to increase its durability, cultural appropriateness and value for money in order to reach more people (HRP 2023).

New Pipeline for Plastic sheeting to improve the timeliness of the emergency response

2ND LINE RESPONSE Area Based Approach :

- Provision of land by HLP Partners
- Site planning by shelter partners
- Production of local materials through livelihood projects
- Construction of transitional/upgradable
- Construction of WASH infrastructures
- Community services



Shelter has a **high impact on health** including improved physical and mental health, particularly for children.

- People, especially **women are safer** and feel safer when given shelter assistance.
- Good shelter and settlement design can **reduce gender-based risk** and vulnerability.
- NFI kits includes very important items
 - Solar lamps (including USB to charge phones)
 - Mosquito nets
 - Kitchen sets
 - Mats
 - Blankets
- In 2023, partners will distribute 2 plastic sheets per household instead of one in 2022
