Influx from Lebanon Emergency

- **Shelter Typology:** Due to the recent escalations in Lebanon, several households, including both Syrian returnees and Lebanese refugees, have arrived in Syria through various border crossing points. Most are staying with relatives in host communities, while others are being accommodated in hosting centers established across different governorates.
- **Needs:** While the needs of those in hosting centers can be identified, it's more challenging to define the needs of the other population groups. The shelter sector, along with other sectors contributing to the SYNAT initiative, which aims to capture, quantify, and map sectoral needs across the country.
- **Resource Mobilization:** Inter-Agency 'flash appeal' was launched on the 6th of October with a total request of \$60 million for both shelter and NFI over 6 months.

Coordination

- **2025 HNO/HRP:** The sector has adopted the 'Delphi Methodology' and established 'expert panels' at the sub-national level. These panels are tasked with revisiting the severity scores and the PiNs of their respective sub-districts and make necessary amendments.
- **SHF 1st Standard Allocation:** Six shelter projects successfully passed the vetting process and were awarded a total of \$1.5 million. Notably, NGOs played a crucial role in this allocation, achieving a 100% contribution rate.

Program

- **Official Projects' Approval:** The official approval from the line authority was received at the end of July, granting clearance for over 200 projects nationwide. These projects include both in-kind and cash-based initiatives.

GAPS / CHALLENGES

- The severe economic decline and fluctuating prices have led to a reduced scope and target for shelter projects. Additionally, the decreasing coping capacities of both internally displaced persons (IDPs) and host communities, combined with limited financial resources from the government and sector partners, are contributing to a rising demand for shelter assistance.

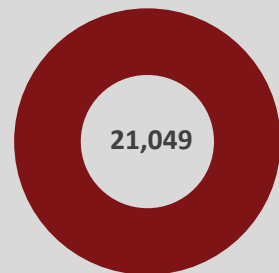

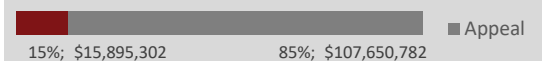
Total Individuals Reached by HH-based Activities

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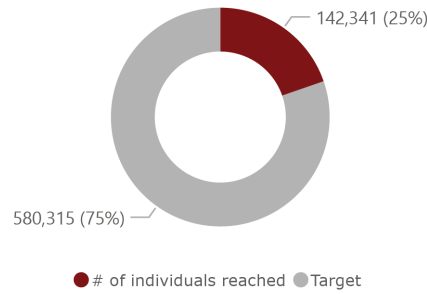

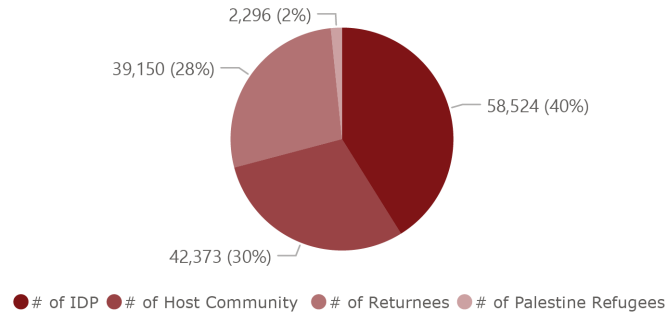

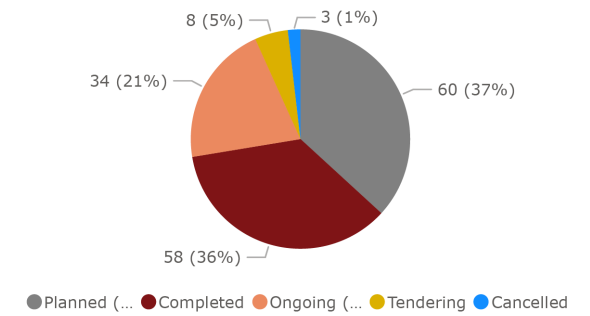
Total Individuals Reached



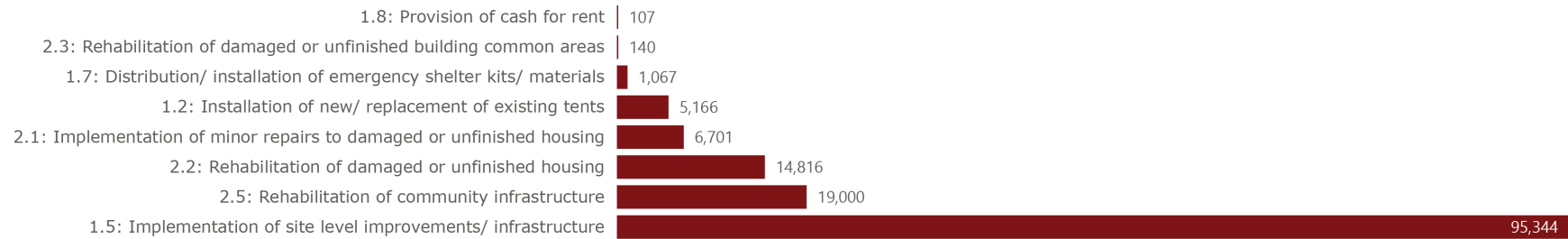
Total Individuals Reached by cohort



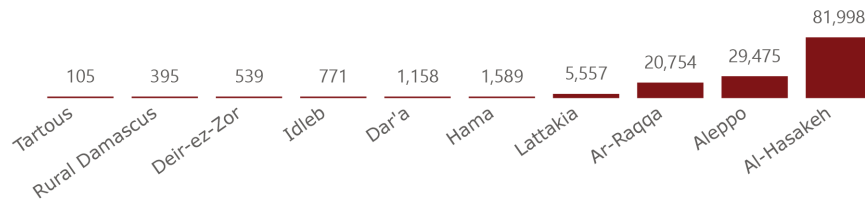
Project status



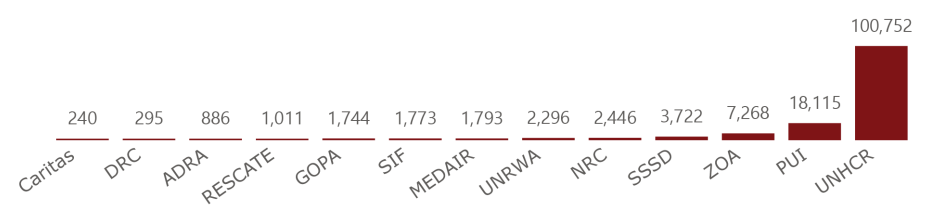
Individuals Reached Per Activity
