Flood 2022: Situation Overview (as of 16 July 2022)


 9 Districts impacted

 7.2 million people affected


 481,827 people evacuated/ temporary displaced

 1,605 shelter centers opened


 121 people died

 80 percent area of Sylhet div. inundated


 3,388 KM roads damaged

 106,727 Water points damaged

 283,355 Sanitation facilities damaged

 106,000 Ponds inundated

 254,251 Hectares cropland damaged

 17,000 metric ton fished washed away

 663,534 cattle affected

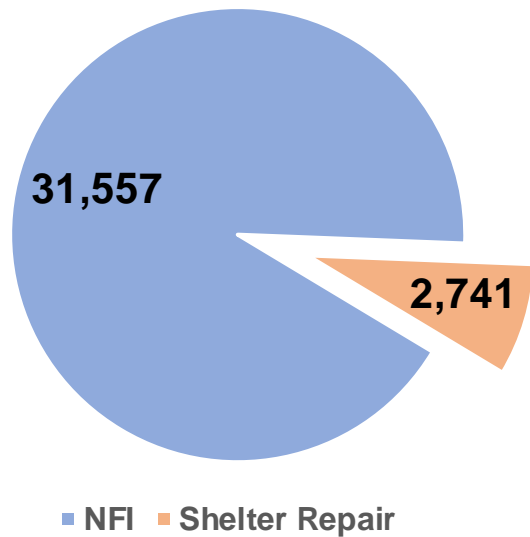

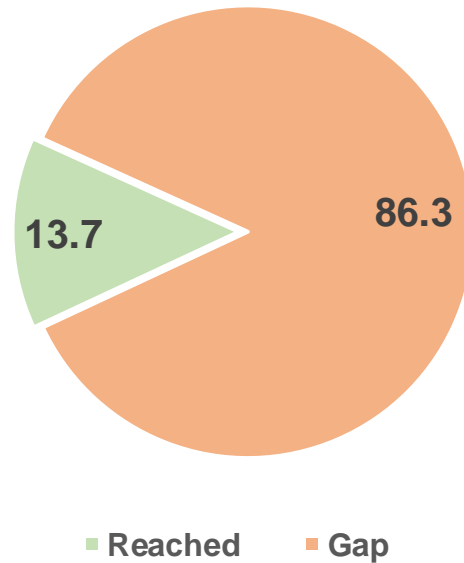
Shelter Response Update *(as of 14 July 2022)*

Population and Geographic coverage

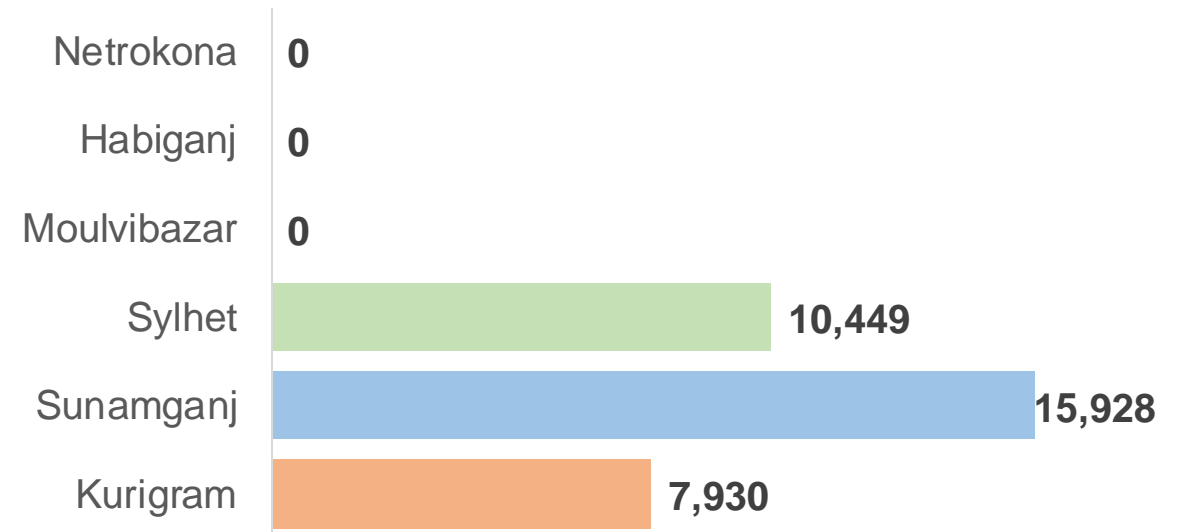
People Reached 34,298



(%) of Coverage



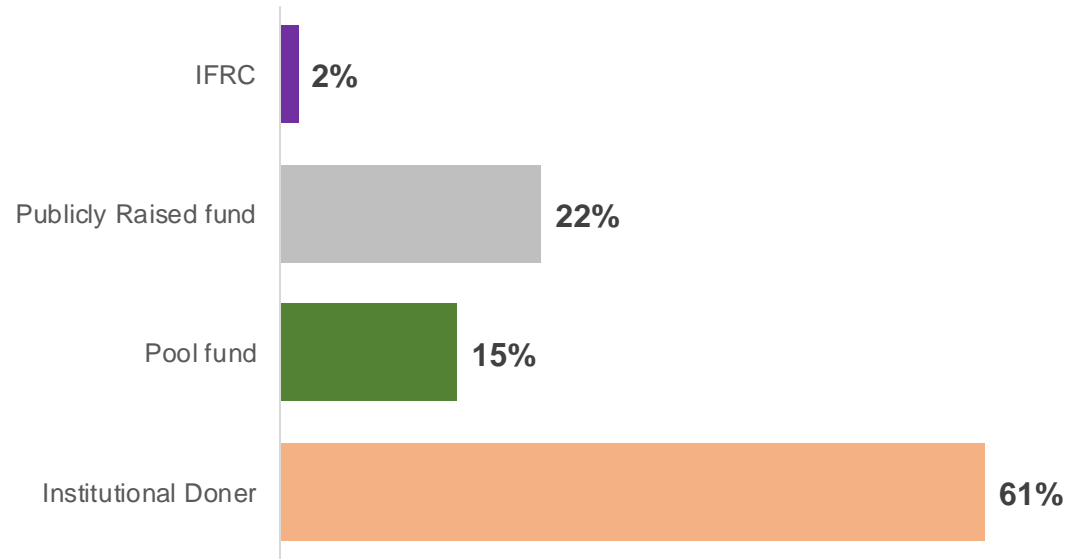
District Coverage (Population)



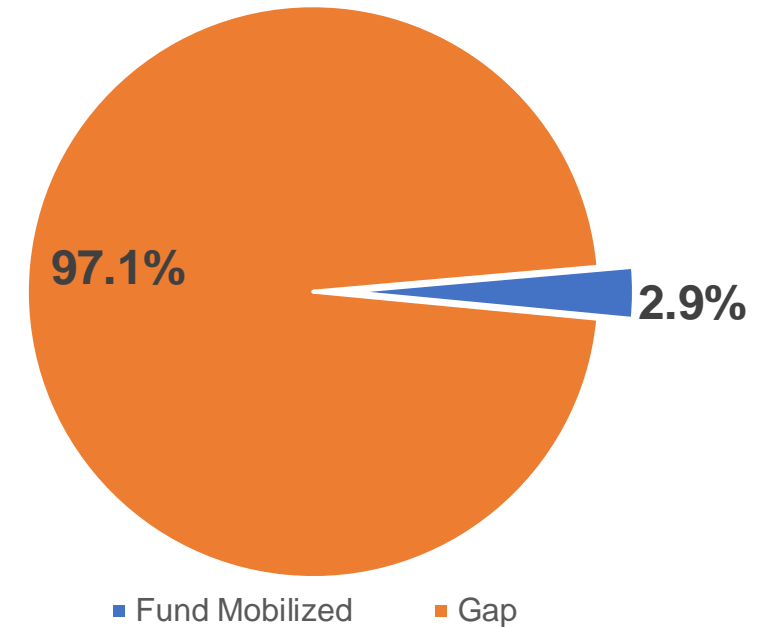
Shelter Response Update *(as of 14 July 2022)*

Funding Coverage: US\$0.5 Million has been mobilized



Funding: Requirements VS Mobilized





Target population for beneficiary selection:

- House damaged, still not reconstructed and needs other assistance and/or less capacity to re-construct without external assistance.
- Displaced and living in collective centers or relative's or other houses. Fully or partially damaged housing, loss of essential HHs items.
- Household with vulnerable groups will be given priority.



Support needs:

- Emergency Shelter and essential HHs items.
- Host family support
- Rental assistance
- Repairing assistance for partially damaged houses
- Construction of new houses for fully damaged houses.
- Cash for Work.
- The repair and maintenance of educational institutes.
