SUPPLY

Based on a population of 400,000 displaced over the next 3 months, HH size of 5, we will require 80,000 standard NFI kits to be prepared to reach all populations in need, based on assessment. We currently have approximately 40,000 in-country in the pipeline, though some prepositioning sites have been or may have been looted or are difficult to reach due to insecurity (Bor, Bentiu, Malakal) and we should assume airlift from Juba will be necessary in many cases. Stocks available in Juba and Wau amount to approximately 16,000 standard kits leaving us with a requirement of **64,000 standard NFI kits**.

For Juba UNMISS POC populations, where logistics allows given the airport and if space allows at the new site/s, family tents should be provided. To cover the existing population, and providing a stockpile for possible influx or improved access to other areas, to cover a population of 50,000 at 5 people per tent, we require **10,000 family tents**.

The immediate priorities within the coming 2 weeks are **family tents** and **plastic sheets**, followed by blankets and mosquito nets.
