1. Introduction

- Based on FAQs the SC Coordinator informed about the updated information on the Cluster's webpage, invited to register to the mailing list, and reminded about other Cluster online tools (CCs database, Response dashboard, and Winterization Response Capacity tool)

2. Response update and planning update partners

- IMO presented Response Update as of 14th of September, Stock and Pipeline update as of 21st of September.

3. Operational Presence Map

- IMO presented the Operational Presence Map updated on the 14th of September. The example of Lvivska oblast IMO explained how to read the map.
- IMO emphasized on the importance of providing 5Ws in a timely manner.
- Gap noticed of reporting of partners, especially on the winterization activities

4. IOM Common Pipeline

- IOM Common Pipeline team (Kanti and Rubiya) updated on the Common Pipeline launch.
- The presentation included information on the application process, illustrated by Common Pipeline Access Flow Chart. Cluster endorsement was mentioned as an integral part of the application.
- IOM continued to present Common Pipeline Request Form which together with Needs Assessment

Report is to be submitted for Cluster endorsement and to IOM.

- Reporting Template has to be filled within 15 working days upon completion of distribution and includes numeric and narrative parts. The figures required for the numeric part are the same as required for 5Ws reporting.
- In case of loss or damage of items during transportation or otherwise, such loss or damage shall be reported using the Loss/Damage Report Template no later than 48 hours after an incident.
- Kanti presented a map of IOM hubs and warehouses and Logistics Cluster warehouses. Partners were also informed that supplies can be prepositioned in Logistics Cluster warehouses in Odesa and Dnipro for a period of 60 days maximum.
- The list of items available in the Common Pipeline consists of items, not kits, additionally, requests for hygiene items have to be endorsed by WASH Cluster.
- Kanti answered a question from the chat regarding the availability and volume of NFIs in warehouses by saying that initially Partners will be informed by email, but later an online tool to be introduced.
- Finally, the deadline to express interest is 30 September COB. Common Pipeline pilot phase activation is 5 October.
- Tania Regan (Logistics Cluster Coordinator) asked Partners to request warehouse services of Logistics Cluster ahead of time.
- Anne Dinkelman (ZOA) asked to clarify issues regarding the availability of items in various warehouses. IOM colleagues replied by announcing an online tool that will have all the relevant information in this regard and will be updated weekly.

5. Update HNO - PiN of the SNFI Cluster

- ICCG update. The total population affected 21,3 Mio individuals. Displaced: 7.9 Mio individuals. Returnees: 6.0 Mio individuals. Non-displaced: 7.3 Mio individuals. FA Revision: PiN 11.2 Mio – new PiN 8.0 Mio, ICCG will provide inter-cluster PiN on the 27th of September and reflect on the entries of all clusters.
- Further explanation was provided on the Population weighting and Severity threshold followed by the illustration on the map.

6. UHF updates - Technical Review Committee

- The SC Coordinator presented the results of the first round of proposals of the regular funding cycle. The Fund received 37 project proposals with a combined value of \$71.8 million against the \$50 million envelope. All 37 projects passed pre-Strategic Review. Of the 37 projects, 15 are single-sector projects and the rest 22 are multi-sector projects.
- The Cluster was asked to set up a technical review committee and invited partners interested in that activity to express their interests by Friday she also introduced a proposed schedule of committee review sessions and the scoring system.

7. Winterization planning update – TWiG Winterization

- Cluster Technical expert from UNHCR, Andrea Parisi, invited the members of the TWiG to provide final comments regarding the guidelines.
- PIN asked to elaborate on cash activities for Winterization within the guidelines, which was explained as a modality instead of a separate activity, it is considered as an implementation modality for almost all the other activities within Cluster activities, applicable if there is a functioning market system in place.
- Cluster stressed the importance of coordination for better planning and identifying gaps, especially in the winterization activities.
- Cluster reminded about the winterization response capacity tool that the cluster shared some time ago and invited partners who may now have a better understanding of their winterization activities to update it.

8. Sub-national level cluster coordination highlights

- Eastern sub-national hub: 2 interagency convoys to newly accessible areas took place in Chihuv and Shevchenkov for the delivery of food and NFI items; a General coordination meeting took place in Poltava and Kharkiv – which will be from now on held every 2 weeks to keep track of the progress of the response; Sub-national coordination to take place next week on Thursday
- Center sub-national hub: most important message was the request from Zhytomyr authorities for basic NFIs for collective centers. Additionally, there is a tendency for the authorities to request the replacement of gas heaters with solid fuel heaters because the authorities foresee they will not be able to pay for the gas supply.
- The regular shelter cluster meeting is to be held Thursdays and invited partners to participate in person in Vinnytsia or online.
- West sub-national hub: an update was provided on the shelter cluster meeting in Uzhgorod Zakarpatska oblast which was called for because of a challenge of some overlap in collective centers in terms of refurbishments, which was resolved. Additionally, some bilateral meetings were set up to coordinate the response and the planning in more detail with shelter cluster partners.
- In addition, the governor's office has announced an initiative to pay a one-time payment from the oblast budget of 4000 UAH to families who host a minimum of two IDPs for a period of a minimum of 30 days. Since the oblast can allocate a budget for only 10.000 such payments, he also shared with partners the deputy governor appealed to international organizations to consider assisting in funding this program for the next four months which will provide for an additional 20 to 40 thousand new places for IDPs.

9. AOB

- The cluster announced that light and medium repairs SOPs are now uploaded on the website and are now being translated into Ukrainian.
- The cluster answered: and clarified that for the second envelope (20 Mio USD) the UHF funding partners have till the 29th of September to apply, this is focused and should support especially funding opportunities for local organizations.
