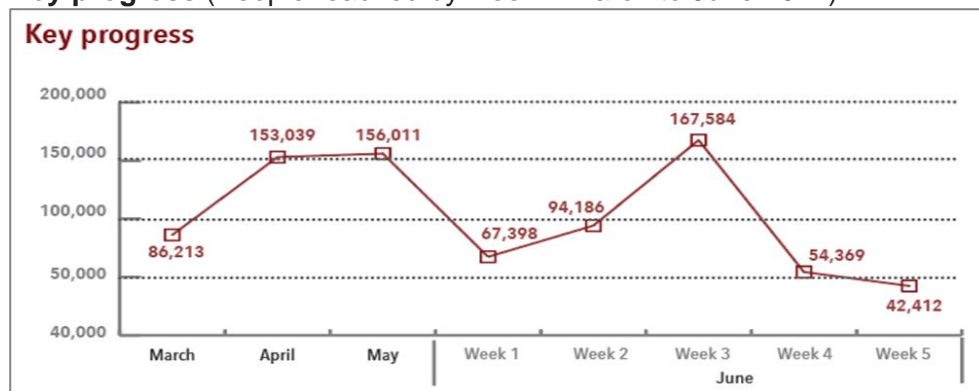
1. REACH damage assessments and overall needs for data from the HSM

- REACH provided the update for better understand the dynamics around the humanitarian situation in relation to damage activities. REACH produces the monthly Humanitarian situation monitor (dataset and factsheet) exploring inter-sectoral needs of the affected population. Round three damage assessments findings were shared. Round four data is planned to be released early next week.
- REACH noted that newly liberated areas are under-represented in the sampling plans and there are plans to improve coverage of these areas in future assessments, so that the needs severity ranking in % is better reflected. Housing is top 3 need in 40% of NGCA and non-NCCA areas.
- The importance of collaborating and sharing data with Ministry of Region Development was discussed
- DEMAC noted that it is better to work with local authorities (hromadas) on damage assessments as Ukraine is a decentralized country with local communities having their own budgets.
- HEKS/EPER asked if there are any experiences on sealing kits. UNHCR confirmed that the cluster has experience in sealing kits and the guidance are available on [this link](#).

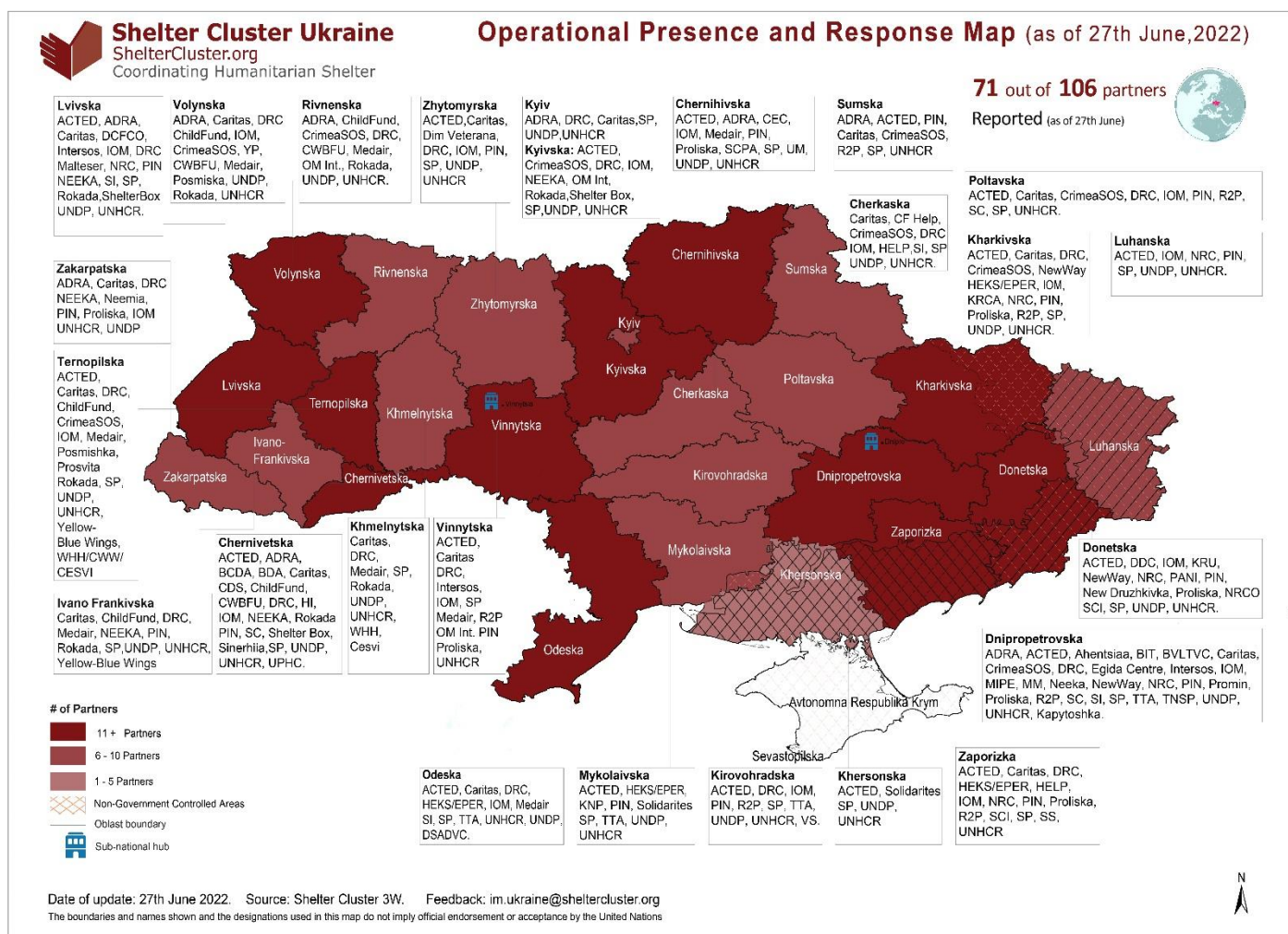
2. Response update

- **820,732** persons assisted by the SNFI cluster partners since 25 February 2022.
- **204,257** assisted people with NFI kits in collective centers
- **489,158** assisted people with NFI kits at household level
- **78,187** assisted people with shelter kits

4. Updates from sub-national clusters

- Central zone: Updated list of CCs (buildings that can be refurbished) was shared by Oblast authorities from Zarkapatska.
- A meeting to present partner commitments and gaps will be convened by OCHA on Friday 8th July.
- A list of damaged houses was received from partners in Zhytomiryska oblast. About 2,000 houses were reported as damaged, the detail update will be uploaded on Google drive folder.
- Sub-national meeting postponed to Friday 8th July.

5. SAG Results

- UNDP, DRC, Caritas Ukraine were voted as new SAG members (results in the meeting's presentation)
- SAG will soon meet to discuss Assessment's strategy and vulnerability criteria for the cluster.

6. AOB

- PIN calculation for the Flash appeal will be due in the next two weeks, Shelter Cluster targets for Flash appeal to be revised. Submission of FA revision is the 18th of July, and the overall PiN for all clusters will be calculated together, however the clusters need to define the targets of the different indicators and activities. This will be a key priority for next week's agenda.
- Service mapping training will be conducted on Friday 8th July, 35 partners already signed up.
- TWiGs: Winterization TWiG will be conducted every Monday at 2pm until the guidelines are finalized. Draft guidelines shared by UNHCR.
- Light and Medium Repairs TWiG to finalize SOPs in the next meeting, Tuesday 12th July. Guidelines on asbestos removal will also be discussed, let by UNDP FP Martin Bjerregaard.
- Damage assessments TWiG will be held on Wednesday 13th July.
- Cash for Rent TWiG will be on Thursday. Discussions with Ministry will follow up afterwards.
- Collective Centres TWiG will be on Friday 8th July at 11am.
