1. Updates on hosting family support program

- UNHCR: Government supported with 450 UHA/month per person (0.5 USD/day and person). UNHCR, NRC and National Red Cross in collaboration with government plans to support 40,000 IDPs through the hosting family support programme.
- 250,000 IDPs have been reported hosted through the program in April and an estimated 500,000 IDPs are expected in May.
- Through the programme, SC partners will implement projects directly.
- There is need to scale up coordination to ensure harmonization and to avoid duplication.
- SC partners agreement for this modality in the duration was at least 6-month programme commitment.
- Other partners considering this programme in the near future can contact the SC for more information.

2. Response overview

- 354,839 persons assisted by the Shelter and NFI cluster partners since 25 of February
- 136,491 assisted people with NFI kits in collective centers
- 174,859 assisted people with NFI kits at household level
- 68,952 assisted people with shelter kits
- 7,148 received winterization support (approx.
- 74K assisted persons/week as reported

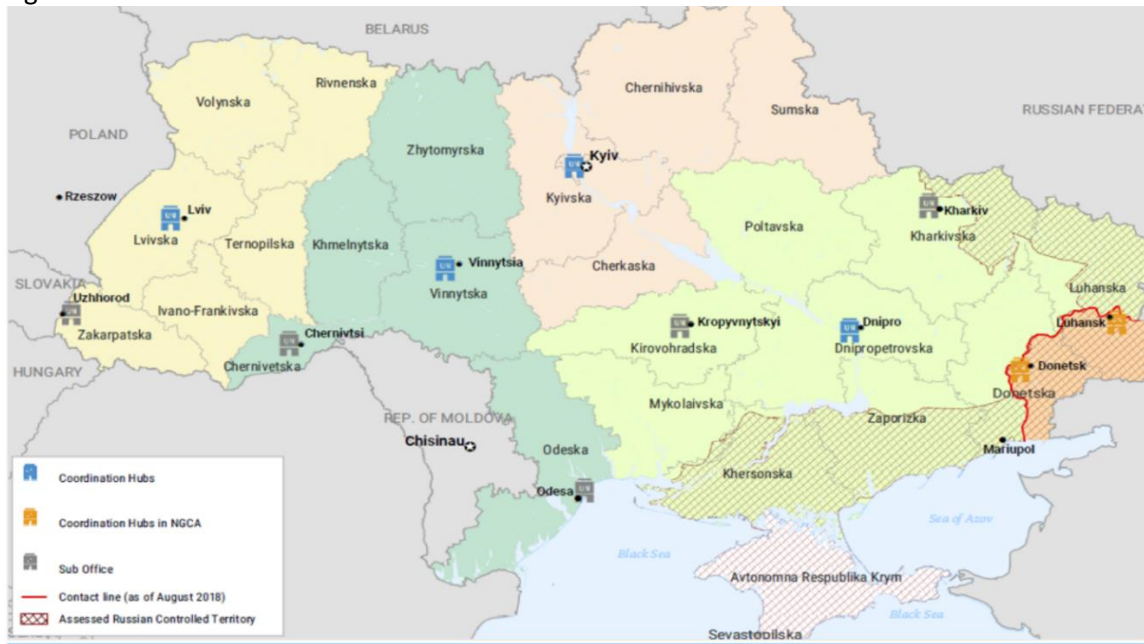
Partners were urged to continue submitting their weekly 3Ws every Wednesday and Pipeline reports on Thursdays.

3. Partners updates by region

Western Oblasts

- UNHCR has started more substantive refurbishment of Collective Centres.
- IOM: In Zakarpatya, repairs have been completed for 5 collective centres, 2 are ongoing while 30 collective centres have been assessed.

Northern Oblasts

- One priority for these oblasts is the damage building assessment. The SC is working on an assessments strategy to ensure harmonization.

Eastern Oblasts

- NRC is conducting assessments in Eastern Oblasts
- CCCM, through REACH and other partners is rolling out multi-sectoral needs assessments in Collective Centres

5. Sub-national clusters developments

- Activation of Subnational hub for central oblast Vinnytsia this week and first meeting with partners (facet to face and online) last 24th of May. Participation of 10 partners active in the central oblasts.
- 5 Oblasts are being coordinated from Vinytsya hub.
- In order to enhance the response, the current priorities of the sub-national cluster are to improve the referral mechanism and to map the partners planned activities in a more granular way.
- The activation of the second subnational hub, for easter oblasts, in Dnipro, is programmed for this week too and the first meeting with partners will be held on 26th May.
- Another hub will be activated in Lviv when the national coordination team will be transferred to Kyiv.

6. Updates from TWiGs

- Light and Medium Repairs W/G meeting held every Tuesday at 10am.
- Assessments W/G every Wednesday at 10am.
- Collective Centres W/G is held every Friday at 11am
- NRC is developing a legal guidance on regulation of the shelter sector in Ukraine-to be shared once finalized.
