

Yemen Shelter Cluster Common Pipeline Advocacy Note March 2025



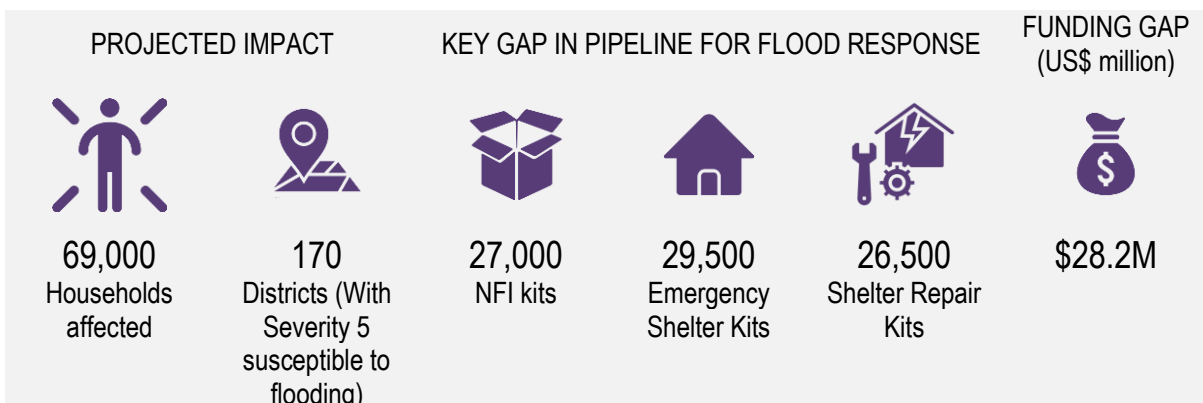
Overview

The Yemen Shelter Cluster (SCT) launched its Common Pipeline system in mid-2018 to meet the urgent needs of emergency¹-affected populations. This initiative streamlines the provision of emergency supplies to partners, ensuring uniform, standardized and maximize efficiency.

The Yemen Shelter Cluster is currently facing a critical shortage of stock levels which are nearly depleted due to reduced funding and extensive distribution during the last rainy season (in 2024) which forced many partners to close their warehouses. As Yemen confronts the impacts of climate change, particularly seasonal floods, the lack of available supplies of shelter materials and NFI's poses a significant threat to vulnerable populations who depend on these resources for safety and shelter.

Insufficient stock means that with the flood season approaching, or in case of conflicts arise (which inevitably will be leading to mass displacement) the Shelter Cluster faces serious challenges to response to the needs which while exponentially increase. Therefore, it is vital to sustain the Common Pipeline in order to ensure timely provision of emergency supplies and strengthen community resilience in the face of ongoing (and future) crises.

Shelter Cluster Contingency Stocks Dashboard - March 2025

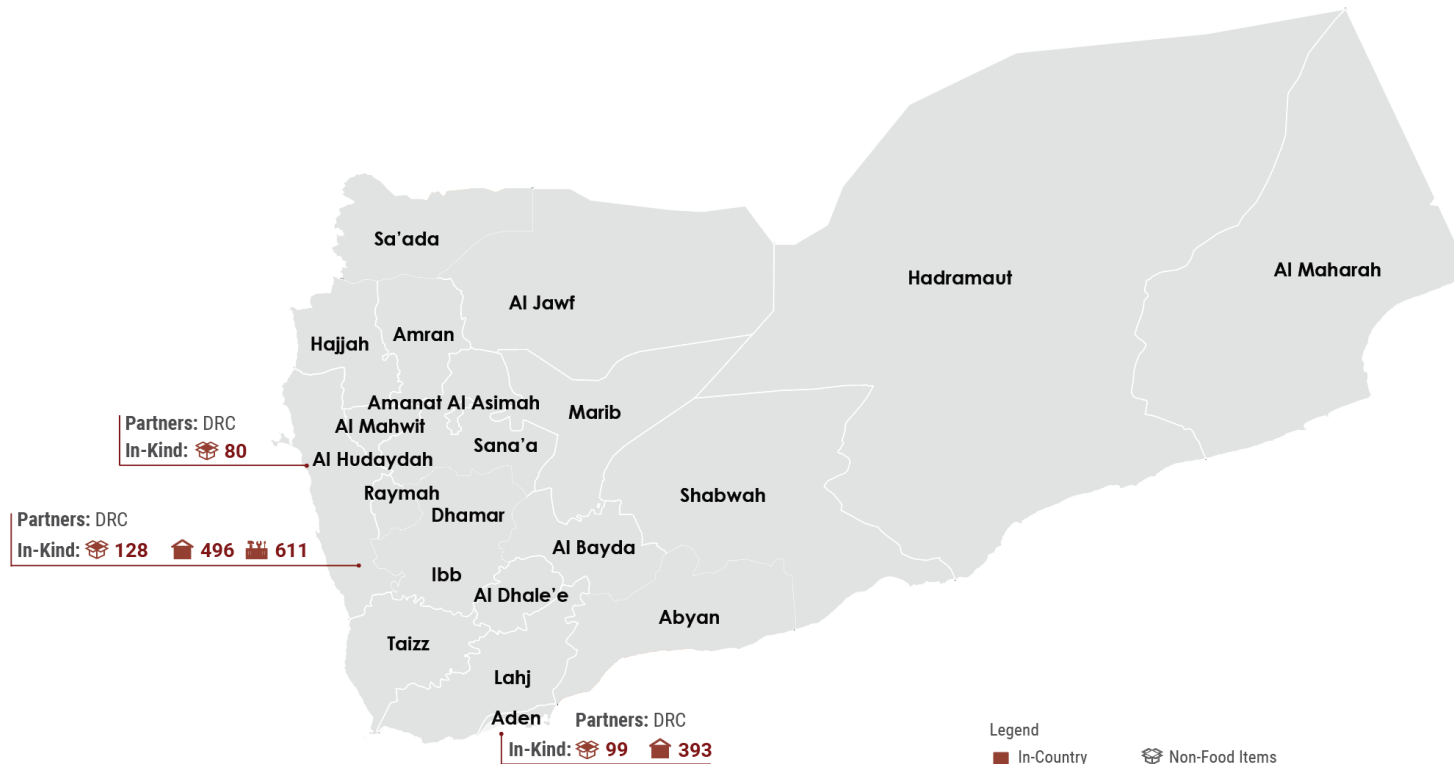
