

Shelter/NFI Situation

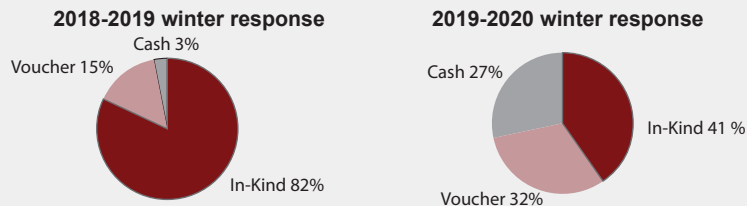
The Shelter/NFI situation remained very difficult in October, despite the fact that the number of displacements decreased compared to September. The CCCM Cluster's IDPs Tracking reported an estimate of 30,594 displacement in October. This is much less than in September (93,333).

SNFI Response

In October, more than 47,000 people were reached with shelter assistance, including 12,752 in Maaret Tamsrin and 10,413 in Dana. The shelter cluster members have been able to scale up their activities. Indeed the shelter response has been improving a lot since March. 73,543 people in need have been reached with NFI including 22,000 individuals in Dana only. The NFI response remains stable since June with almost 80,000 people reach per month.

Winterization: Targets, Funding, Gaps

SNFI Cluster members have readjusted their winterisation plan. Total # of people targeted with secured funding: 714,259 individuals. Last year, the SNFI cluster members could reach 689,209 people in need. The cluster is still advocating for additional funding and is expecting to reach 900,000 individuals, both new IDPs and protracted IDPs. The cash and voucher winter response has improved a lot since last year, thanks to the collaboration with the Cash Working Group:



Main Cluster Activities

Presentation of Shelter/NFI activities to the NGO forum and SNA.
Preparation of the 2nd Standard SCHF Allocation (Syria X-border Humanitarian Funds).
First session of the Shelter Rehabilitation Training (IOM, Mind Earth, SARD).
Coordination of 26 organisations preparing the winterization response to avoid gaps and duplication of assistance.

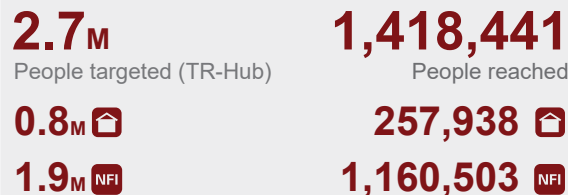

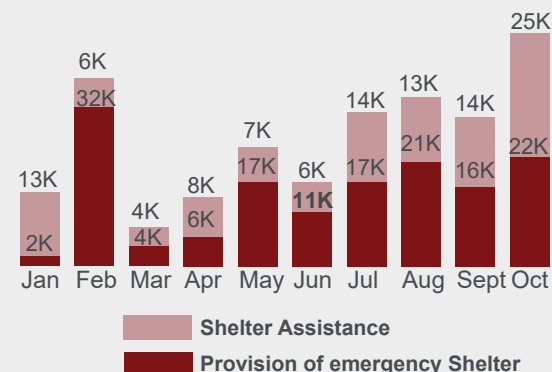
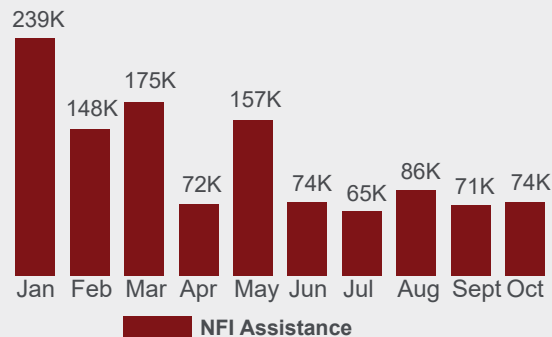

Turkey Hub - Cumulative (Jan - Oct)



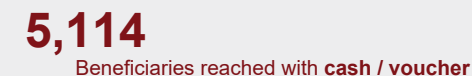
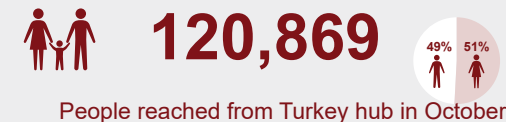
Total individuals reached per month

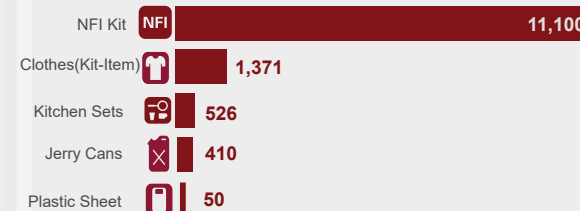

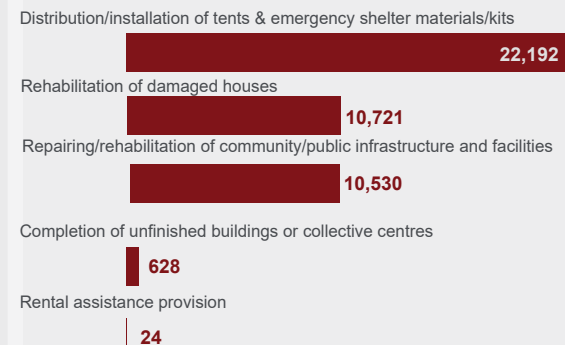

Shelter: Beneficiaries reached by Sub-Activity

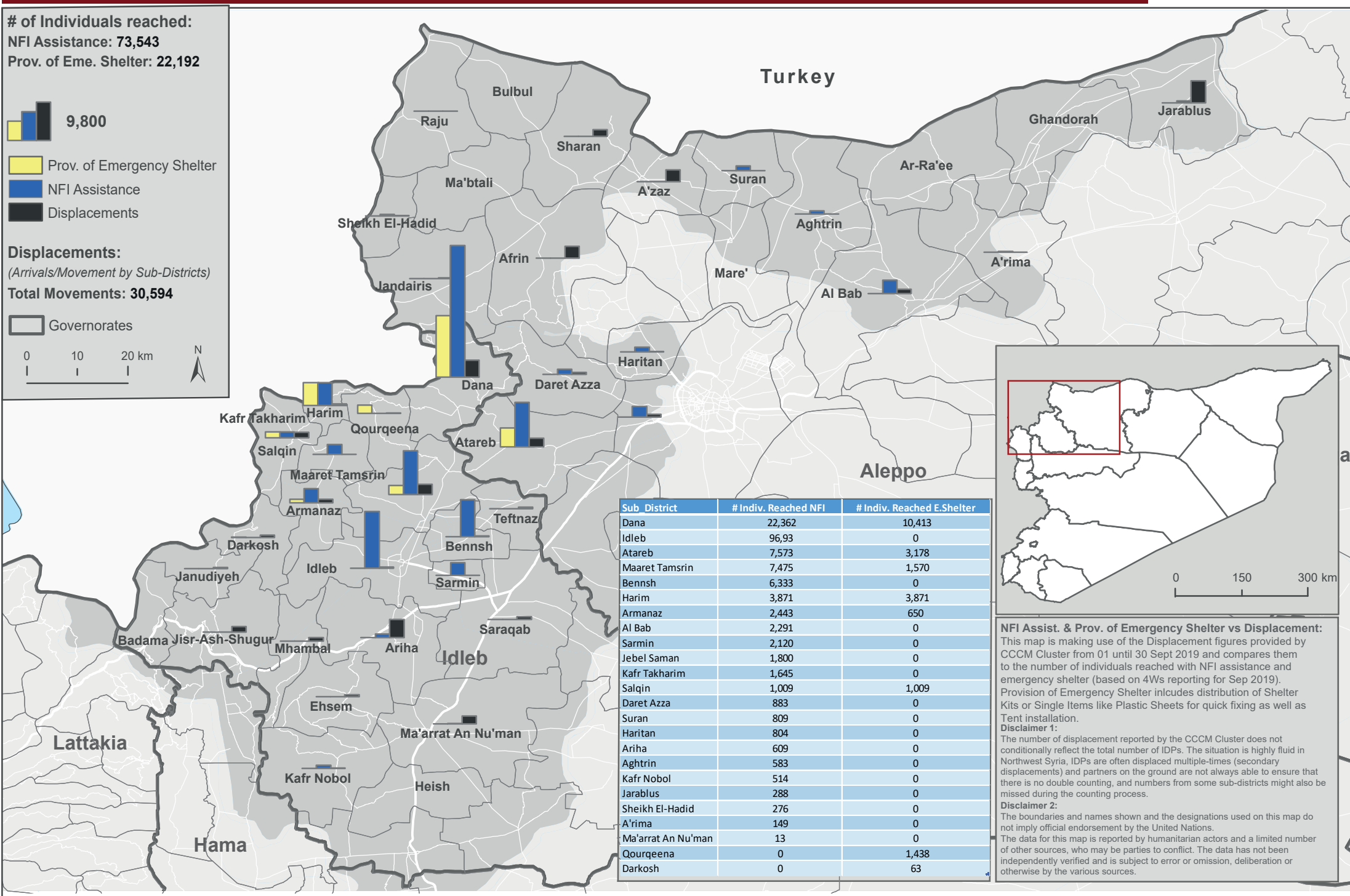
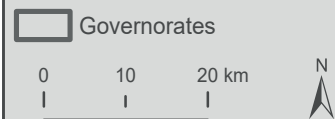

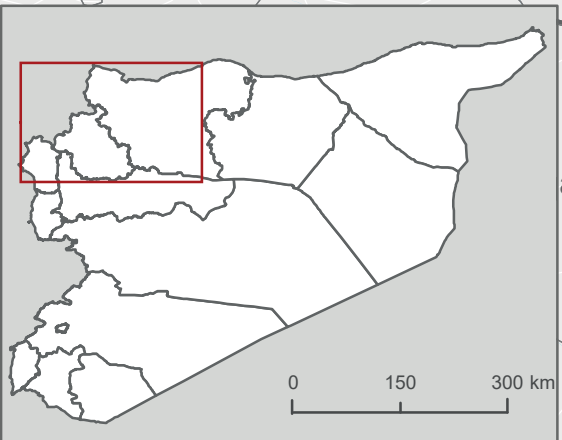

This map is making use of the Displacement figures provided by CCCM Cluster from 01 until 30 Sept 2019 and compares them to the number of individuals reached with NFI assistance and emergency shelter (based on 4Ws reporting for Sep 2019). Provision of Emergency Shelter includes distribution of Shelter Kits or Single Items like Plastic Sheets for quick fixing as well as Tent installation.
Disclaimer 1:
The number of displacement reported by the CCCM Cluster does not conditionally reflect the total number of IDPs. The situation is highly fluid in Northwest Syria, IDPs are often displaced multiple-times (secondary displacements) and partners on the ground are not always able to ensure that there is no double counting, and numbers from some sub-districts might also be missed during the counting process.

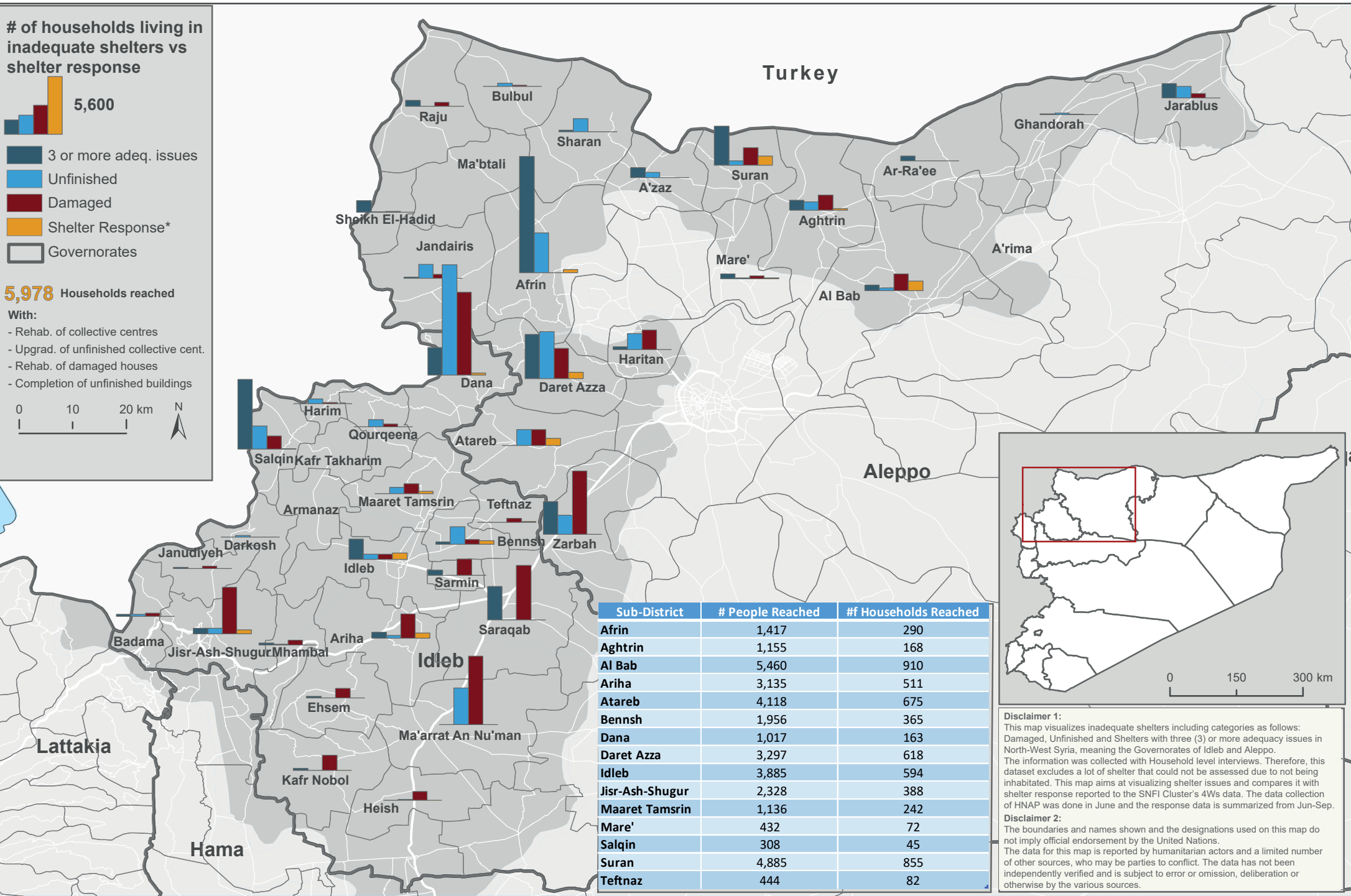
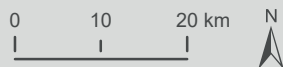
North-West Syria: # of households assessed living in inadequate shelters vs shelter response from June - To - October 2019

of households living in inadequate shelters vs shelter response

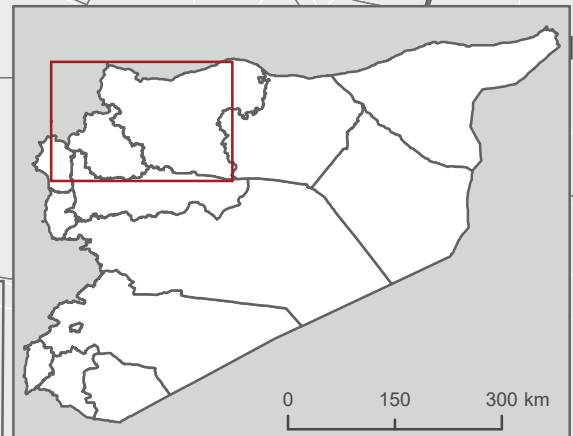

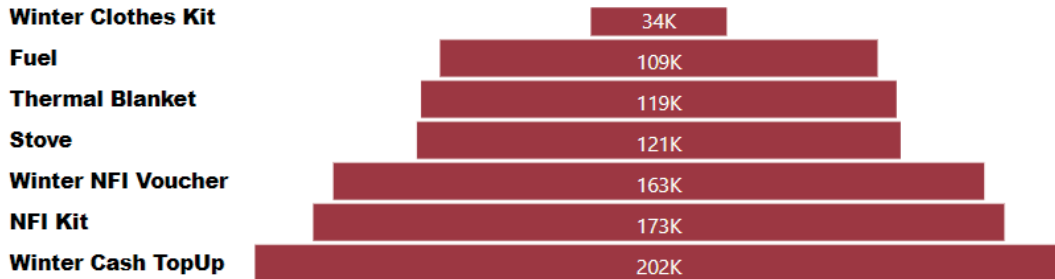

The information was collected with Household level interviews. Therefore, this dataset excludes a lot of shelter that could not be assessed due to not being inhabited. This map aims at visualizing shelter issues and compares it with shelter response reported to the SNFI Cluster's 4Ws data. The data collection of HNAP was done in June and the response data is summarized from Jun-Sep.

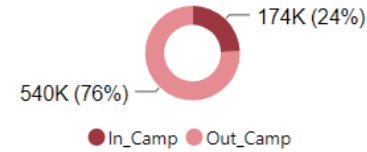
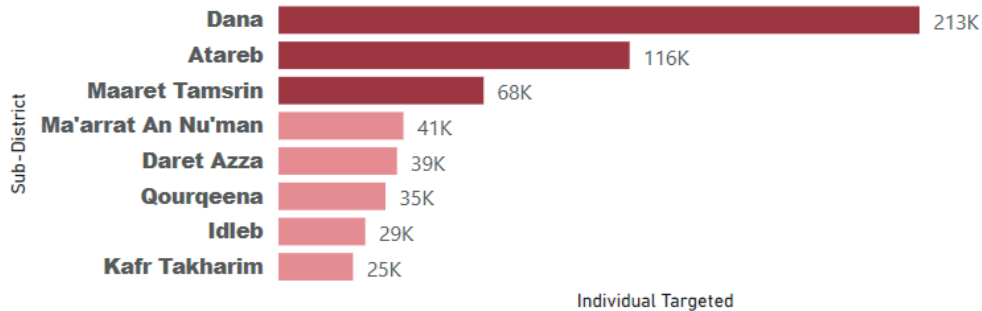
NFI Planned Response by Individual



Shelter Planned Response by Individual



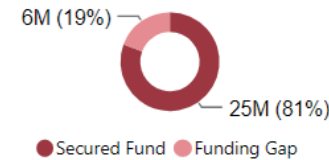
Targeted Individuals by Sub-District

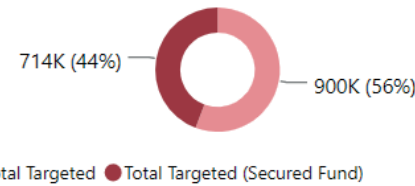

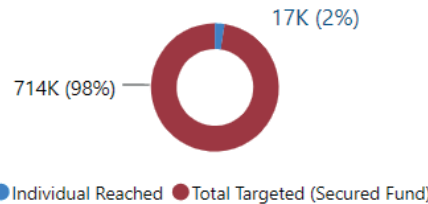

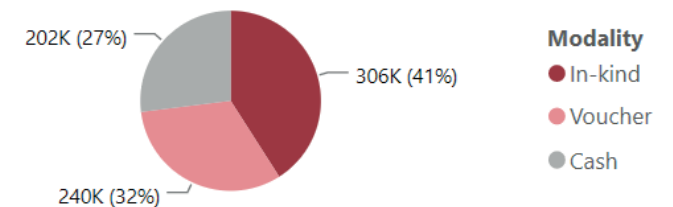

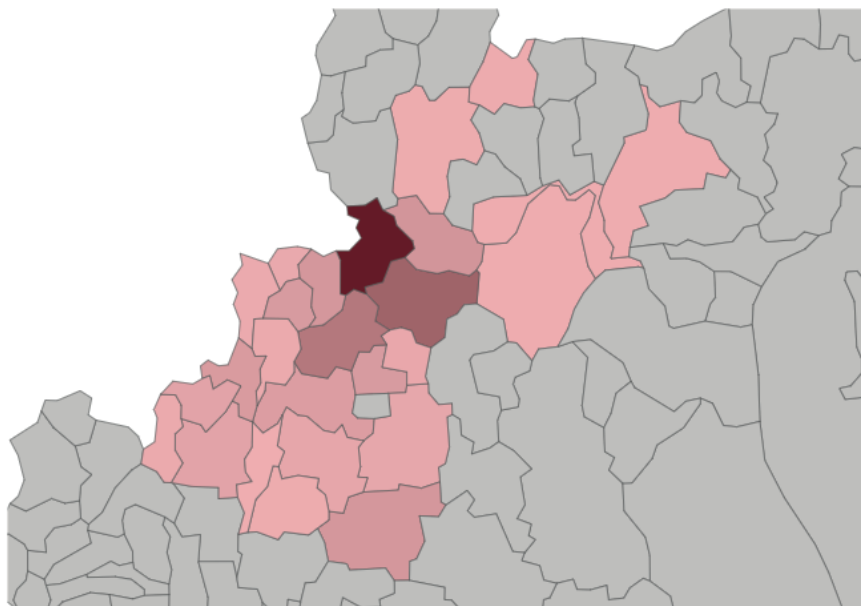
Planned response by Modality
