NOTE:

1. Total camps population is 1,790 families (*Source: ExU database*) of which 527 did not show during the survey.
2. Survey conducted by IRY in collaboration with UNHCR and supported by IDP representatives.
3. First survey conducted in April and second in July 2014.
4. Highest number of families planning to return to 5 villages in Al Daher District (**Al-Menzalah, Al-Malaheet, Ghaferah, Bani Sa'ad, and Al-Marawi**) and 1 village in Haydan District (**Dhouib**).
5. Among proposed return areas, landmine problem is reported in Al Daher (**Al-Menzalah, Al-Malaheet, Ghaferah, Bani Sa'ad, Al-Hsamah, Namesah and Al-Majram**) and Haydan (**Haydan and Al-Ragah**).
6. Most inhabitants from the camps have either returned spontaneously or travelled to KSA or other places in Yemen.
