



Prioritization of Emergency Shelter/NFI needs

Date: 21st February 2018

Life-saving Shelter and NFI Response

Shelter is a basic human need and a critical determinant for survival and coping in the majority of crises. Beyond survival, shelter is necessary to provide security and ensure personal safety and protection, and to promote resistance to ill-health and disease. The SNFI prioritization exercise has been completed to support emergency shelter and NFI response by partners, whilst recognizing that SNFI Cluster partners should direct their efforts to support more durable solutions including the re- integration, return and resettlement of IDP households.

Shelter and NFI Needs

DTM round 8 has identified 1.69 million displaced persons, 270,608 households across 861 sites in the country. As it currently stands 1,078,429 individuals of the IDP caseload (64%) are displaced due to conflict, 528,658 (34%) individuals are climate-change induced IDPs displaced by drought, floods, mudslides and flooding, and a further 82,913 (2%) are displaced due to other factors such as economic/development linked displacement, social tensions and protracted displacement due to volcanic eruptions.

The Meher assessment conducted in December identified in Somali region, a total of 126,518 IDP HH, displaced by the repeated droughts and conflicts in 319 sites in 70 IDP hosting *woredas* of 11 Zonal administrations. A total of 97,855 households were identified as need of SNFI assistance. In Oromia, this gap was identified is 104, 052 households that have not been assisted to date.

In addition partner verifications and assessments have identified that there are a total of 317,550 displaced households across the country.

From an analysis of the above assessments and the cash and in-kind distributions completed and ongoing as of 12 February, from this caseload there is need to support **238,148 households** that have not received any SNFI support over the last year.

Response Activities as of 13 February 2018 from January 2017:

- 87,116 full ES/NFI kits have been distributed until 12th February
- 3,834 full ES/NFI are being currently distributed or are planned for this month in Oromia and Somali, both distribution being for conflict affected HH.
- 14,117 cash grants have been distributed until 12th February
- 1,994 cash grants are currently being distributed in Somali for drought affected HH.
- 10,300 full ES/NFI kits are currently in stock, further 25,436 are under procurement. Additionally, 3,500 cash grants were approved by EHF. A total of 39,236.
- **TOTAL RESPONSE FROM JANUARY 2017 to FEBRUARY 2018: 107,061 HH**
- **TOTAL RESPONSE CAPACITY: 146,297 HH**



Prioritisation Criteria

As part of its bi-monthly Cluster prioritization, the shelter/NFI Cluster updated its prioritization in mid-February and agreed on 3 key areas to guide prioritization: 1) type of emergency, 2) duration of displacement, and 3) percentage of vulnerable people in IDP sites.

- Drivers (conflict-induced IDPs are prioritized over climate-induced IDPs but not only those linked to the Somali Oromia conflict but through-out the country)
- Conflict IDPs categorized based on the length of their displacement (from September 2017 months)
- Drought IDPs categorized in terms of time of displacement and increased vulnerabilities at the sites
- Sites prioritized that have individuals with specific vulnerabilities, including women and children IDPs as well as the elderly and those with disabilities linked to the conflict
- IDPs hosted in rural areas are no longer prioritized over those hosted in urban areas.
- Coordination with other clusters also taken into account as per HRD

A further breakdown of conflict displaced households that have more than 10% of HH identified have been categorized for immediate support. The breakdown is as per the table below:

Of the **238,148 households** that have been identified as in need of Shelter/NFI assistance:

Priority 1 - 106,952 households in need categorized as priority 1 in 8 regions, 121 woredas. Funding required \$18,737,990

Conflict: 98,058 displaced households - 63,329 conflict displaced households are in 57 woredas in Oromia and 31,448 displaced households are in 13 woredas in Somali region. The remaining caseload are in Tigray, Dire Dawa, Gambella and Addis Ababa.

Drought: 8,894 displaced households - 8,129 drought displaced households are in 28 woredas in Somali Region, and a smaller caseload in Amhara and Afar

Priority 2 - 45,490 households in need categorized as priority 2 in 5 regions, 66 woredas. Funding required \$7,969,848

Priority 3 - 85,706 in need categorized as priority 3 in 7 regions, 121 woredas. Funding required \$15,015,691
