

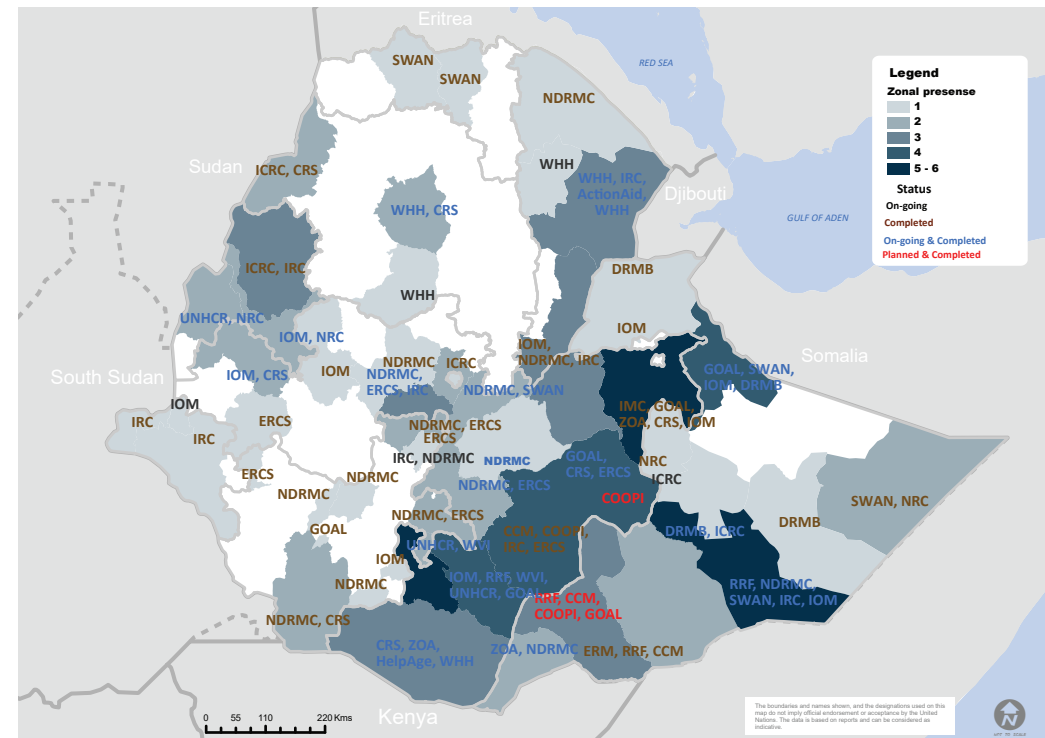
The Cluster partners respond to the Emergency Shelter and NFI needs by providing life-saving items to the IDPs, returnees, and those displaced due to the flooding during the heavy rain in the kirtmt season. The overall financial requirements to reach 2 million people are 101.1 million, and so far, the cluster is only received 30.4%.

The unexpected flood that leads to the displacement of 415,016 people and the support to the Quarantine Centers during the first four months after COVID-19 was reported in Ethiopia exhausted the cluster capacity. Currently, the country's emergency mechanisms, such as ERM/RRM, have no stocks, and the others have minimal stocks to respond to the pockets of displacement across the country and the ongoing response to HRP.
