KEY DATES

In the first half of 2019, the Cluster held one national and 12 subnational coordination meetings, 5 of them in the usual venues (Sloviansk and Sievierodonetsk), and the other 7 in locations close to the conflict areas. In the same period the Cluster organized 3 technical consultations (winterization). A co-ordination meeting was held also for the first time in Donetsk NGCA.

SUBNATIONAL MEETINGS - In June, the Shelter/NFI Cluster completed the first round of visits to 6 (of 7) raions along the contact line (CL) on GCA (government-controlled areas) side. The goal of these meetings was to more actively involve local authorities in the work of the Cluster, and improve communication and coordination among government and non-government actors.

40 representatives from authorities and communities participated in the discussions. 20 of them, representing 78 settlements located in the 0-5 km strip along the CL have responded to the Cluster's request and provided valuable inputs for the winterization guidelines 2019-20.

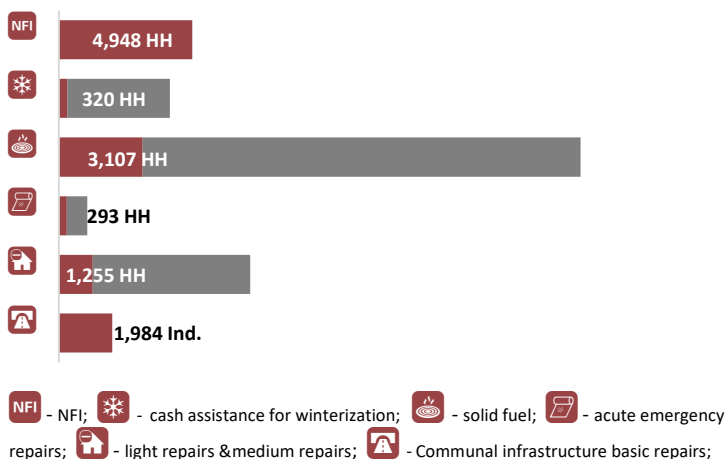
WINTERIZATION WORKSHOPS - In June, the Cluster has concluded also the round of consultations for the preparation of the 2019-20 winterization response. Meetings were attended by 9 partners in GCA and 11 in NGCA. The updated winterization guidelines will be soon available on the Cluster website.

NEWLY DAMAGED HOUSES - In the second quarter of 2019, 254 new damages to residential buildings were registered. The peak of incidents was in June, with 111 damages.

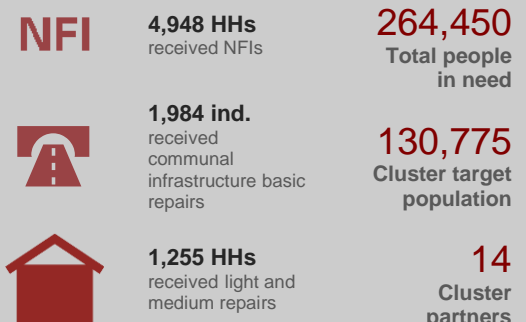
In total, in the first half of the year, the new damages are 411 (80% of the 520 in the same period of 2018; and only 13% of the estimated 3,150 in the same period of 2017). Three every four new damages occurred in Donetsk oblast, confirming a trend observed since 2018.

SHELTER ASSESSMENT - NRC has concluded the assessment of residual shelter needs in Donetsk oblast GCA. The assessment complements the one completed last year, that covered the GCA side of Luhansk oblast. The main findings will be soon presented by NRC in a dedicated event.
