

# MULTI-CLUSTER H2 HOUSEHOLD SURVEY

## August 2018

### *Preliminary Findings*

#### **Executive Summary**

**The OPT Inter-Cluster Coordination Group agreed to conduct the first inter-sector humanitarian assessment on the situation in H2 in the context of the current restrictive environment.**

**Israel exercises direct control over the 20% of Hebron City, known as H2, which is home to approximately 40,000 Palestinians and a few hundred Israeli settlers living in five settlement compounds.** In October 2015, there was a marked increase in violence in H2, and a number of increased restrictions on access were instituted, which remain in place. Policies and practices implemented by the Israeli authorities, citing security concerns, have resulted in the forcible transfer of Palestinians from their homes in Hebron city. The living conditions of those Palestinians who remain in the closed and restricted areas have been gradually undermined, including with regard to basic services and sources of livelihood.

**This assessment was designed to collect firsthand data at the household level, from a sample size of 281 Households.** The data included key indicators across all sectors/clusters, which will provide a picture of the types of needs in H2. This will be integrated into the 2019 Humanitarian Needs Overview, which is the basis on which projects are defined and selected as part of the 2019 Humanitarian Response Plan. The assessment therefore has three objectives:

- **Enable the HCT to prioritize interventions both within a specific cluster and among clusters, in a manner that reflects household needs in the particular context of H2.**
- **Inform related advocacy efforts, including to mobilize sufficient resources for response.**
- **Ensure more effective, tailored and appropriate responses for Palestinians in H2, in line with the overarching goals of the Multi-year Humanitarian Strategy for the OPT.**

#### ***Sample Methodology***

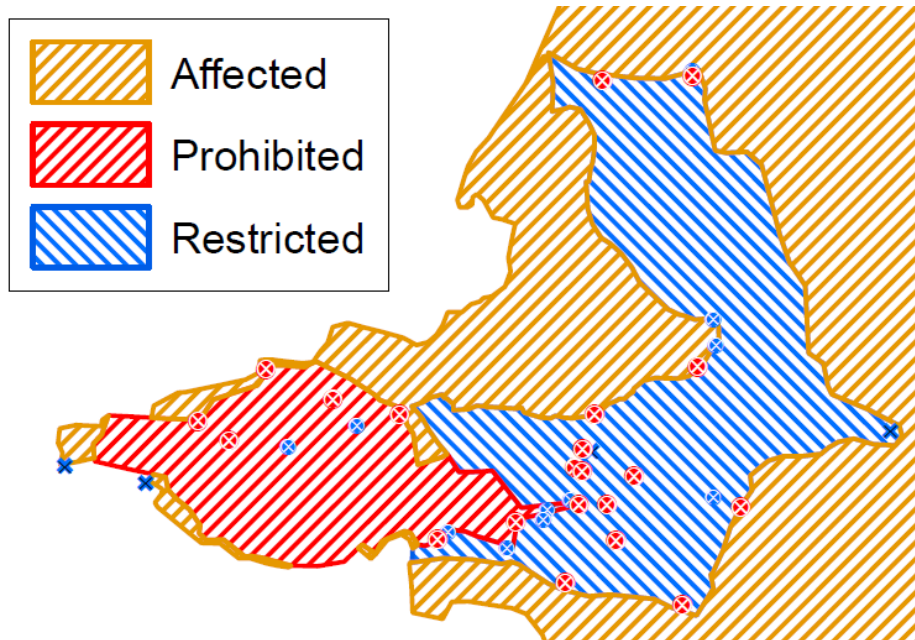
After reviewing a number of qualitative sampling approaches, a simple random sampling method was selected, which is a subset of a statistical population in which each member of the subset has an equal probability of being chosen.

Regarding the sample size, balancing between cost of the operations (sustainability) and precision of results, **a sample size of 1,384 household was defined** assuming a prevalence of 50%, a confidence level of 95%, a non-response rate of 5% and a design effect of 1.5. With these parameters, a precision of 7% was established assuming Simple Random Sampling.

An average family size of 5 was applied to generate a 1,384 households. As such, 280 households were targeted in both the closed military zone (prohibited area)<sup>1</sup>, and non-closed military areas (restricted area)<sup>2</sup>, hereby defined as strata to ensure that sample units are well-distributed throughout the H2/neighborhoods.

The allocation of the sample among the defined strata is proportional to the strata population, and separate sampling is being run for each strata to better capture needs within each. This approach will ensure that the characteristics of each strata are effectively captured which will ultimately provide better understanding of needs.

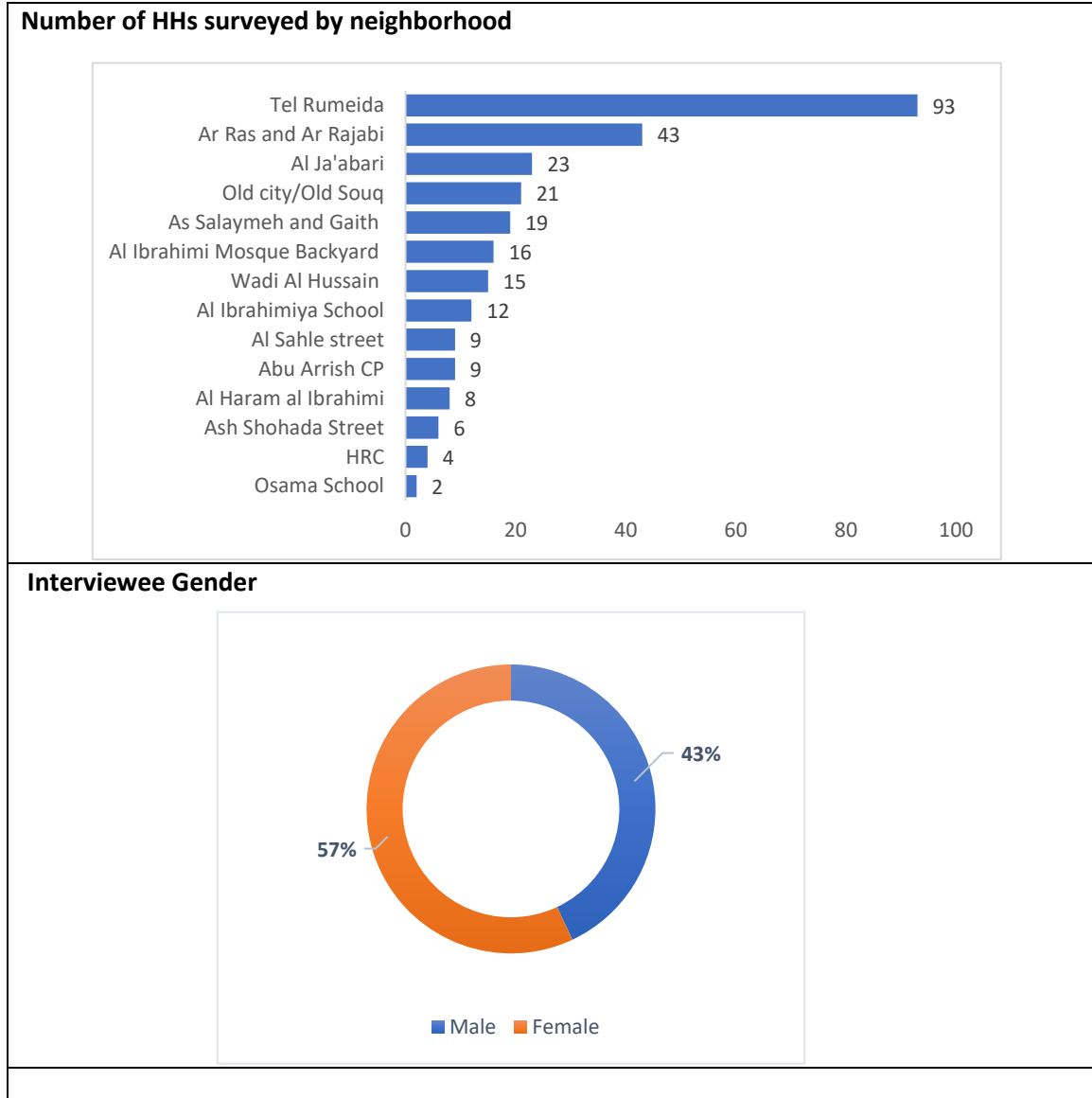
<sup>1</sup> In 2015, the settlement area of H2 was declared a 'closed military zone', residents must register with the Israeli authorities and be screened at a checkpoint to reach their homes; access is on foot only, and visitors are not allowed.

<sup>2</sup> In these areas adjacent to Israeli settlements, Palestinian vehicular movement is almost totally prohibited, and pedestrians must be screened at a checkpoint to access the restricted areas.

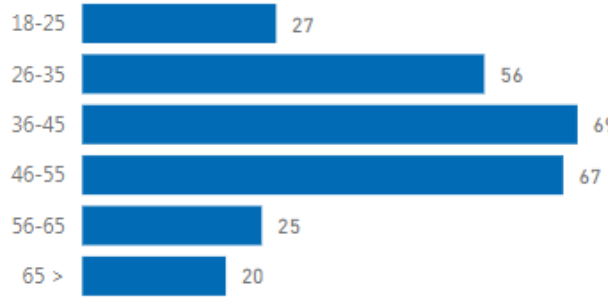
# Preliminary findings

## A- The topology of surveyed HHs

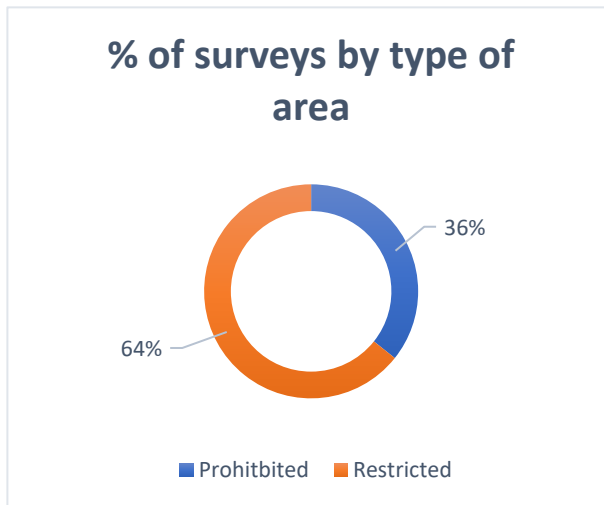
1. **280 households were surveyed, of which 52% are males and 48% females.**
2. The survey targeted 10 neighborhoods within H2, 180 HHs (**64%**) were surveyed in the restricted areas/neighborhoods) and 100 HHs (**36%**) within the prohibited areas
3. **24%** of the surveyed HHs are registered refugees and **6%** with disabilities.



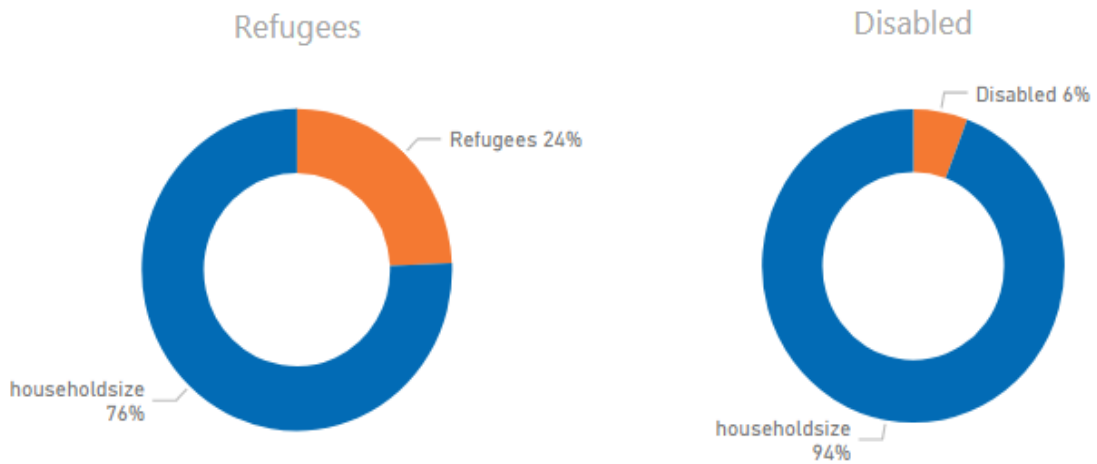
**Interviewee by age**

## How to extrapolate the results of the survey into total number of HHs and individuals in need of specific thematic area

### How to interpret the results with a margin of precision of 7%

See an example from the Protection results:

*Only 12% of the surveyed HHs has permanent access to their houses by a vehicle (car or truck); of which only 1% have permanent access to their houses in the prohibited area compared to 18% percent in the restricted areas.*

**Step 1: Use the below matrix of population per strata in your calculation**

**Step 2: Multiply 88% of the surveyed HHs who don't have access to their houses by vehicle with the total number of HHs in the area of interest (prohibited and restricted).**

$$1,384 * 88 / 100 = 1,217 \text{ HHs have no access to their houses by a vehicle}$$

**Step 3: To generate the number of individuals, multiple by the average family size of 5 individuals**

*1,217 \* 5 = 6,089 individual in the targeted area have to access to their houses by a vehicle*

*Of which, 99% (1000 individual) in the prohibited area have no access by a vehicle, while 82% (4846 individual) in the restricted area have no access by a vehicle.*

**Step 4: Apply the 7% desired precision. Which mean the answers you generate could be within a margin of -7% or +7%.**

*Thus, the answer to the number of individuals who can't access their houses by a vehicle within the area of interest is between 5,663 individuals to 6,515 individuals.*

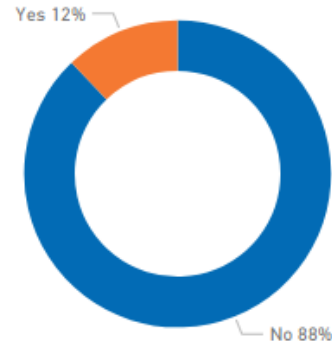
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# Protection

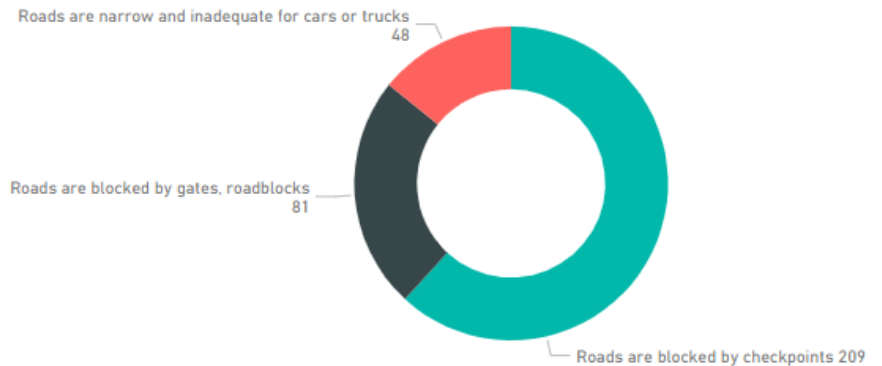
## Access

Only 12% of the surveyed HHs has permanent access to their houses by a vehicle (car or truck); of which only 1% have permanent access to their houses in the prohibited area compared to 18% percent in the restricted areas.

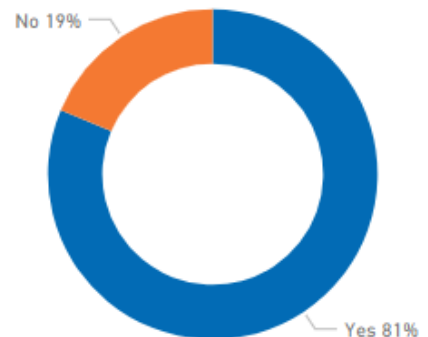
Is your house permanently accessible by a vehicle (car or truck)?



- **88% of the surveyed HHs are facing 1 or more access obstacles;**
- 75% (209 HHs) cite that roads are blocked by checkpoints,
- 28% (81HHs) cite that roads are blocked by gates,
- 17% (48 HHs) cite that roadblocks and roads are narrow and inadequate for cars or trucks (see charts below).

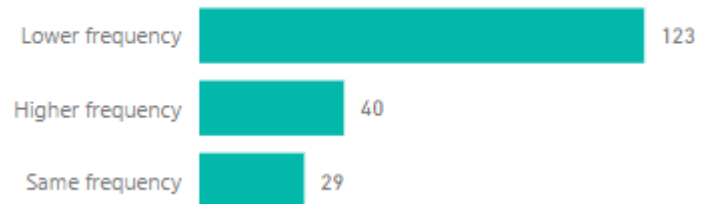


81% of the surveyed HHs need to cross a checkpoint to access their house by walking

**65%** of the surveyed HHs indicated that since Oct 2015, they received lower frequency of visitors from outside their neighborhood, while **20%** indicated higher frequency of visitors and **15%** indicated that it is the **same frequency**, they cite the following top 3 reasons:



- **Relatives and friends are afraid of crossing checkpoints (82%)**
- **Relatives and friends are afraid of settlers' harassment (70%)**
- **Visitors from other neighborhoods are prohibited from crossing the checkpoints to my house (52%)**

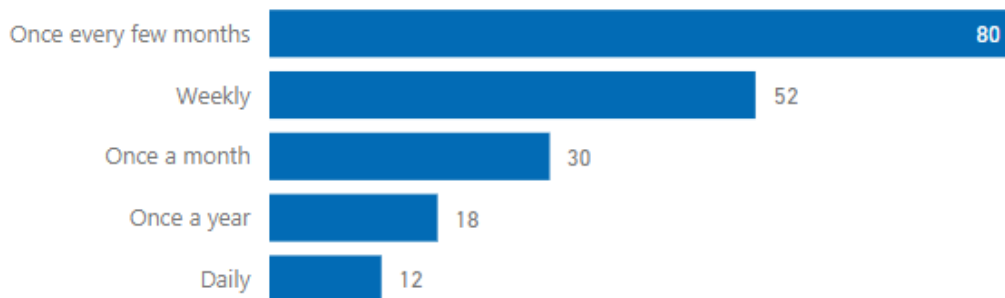

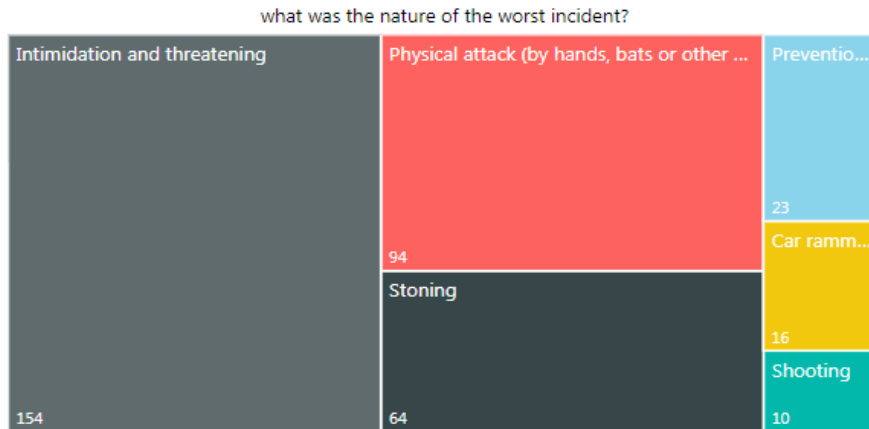

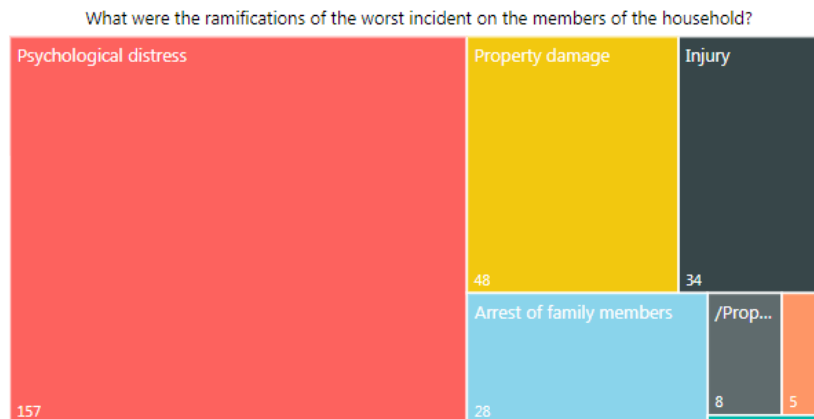

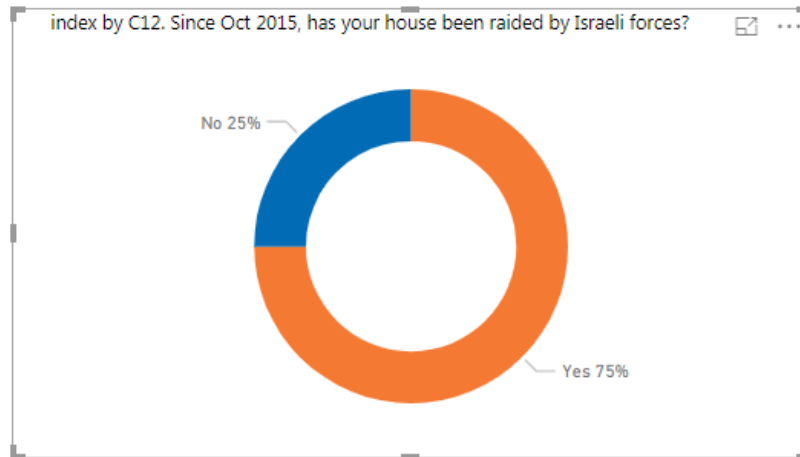

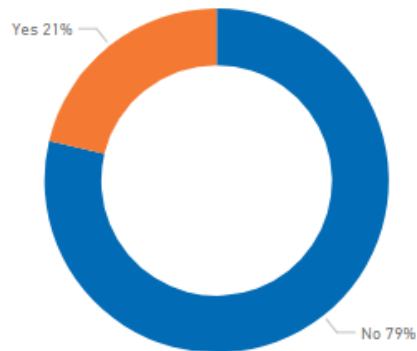

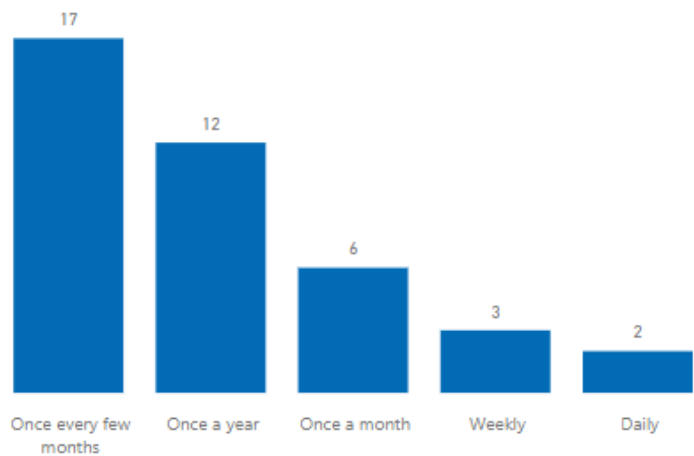

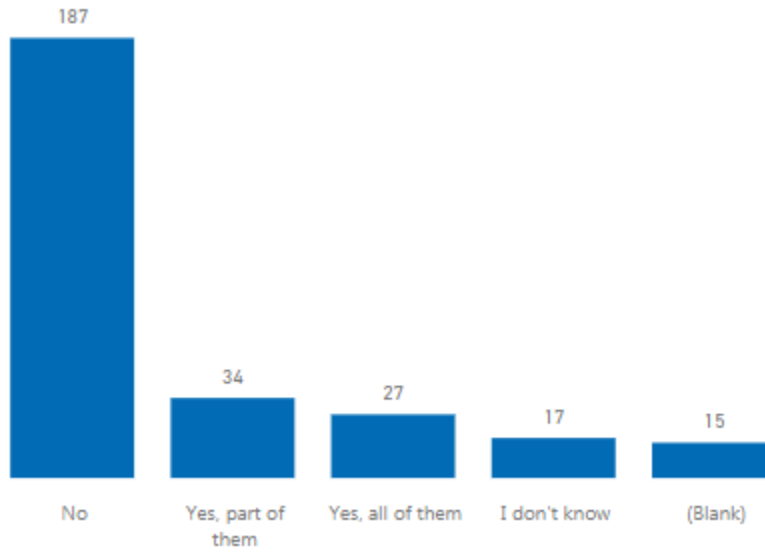

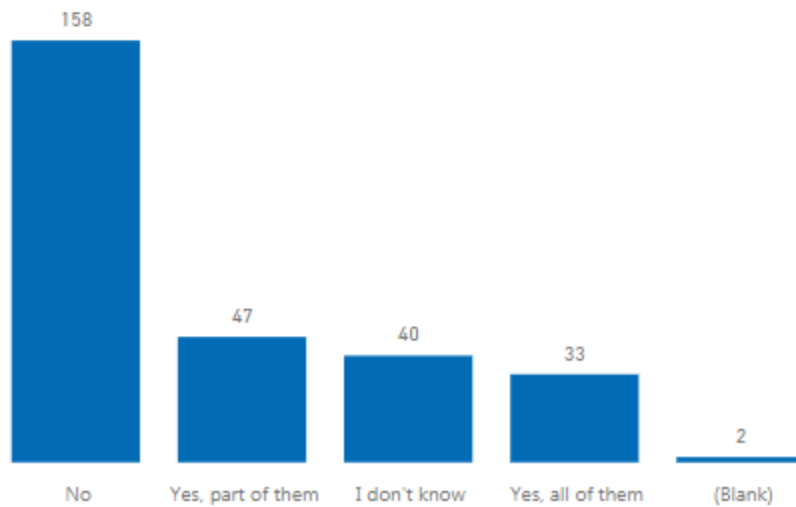

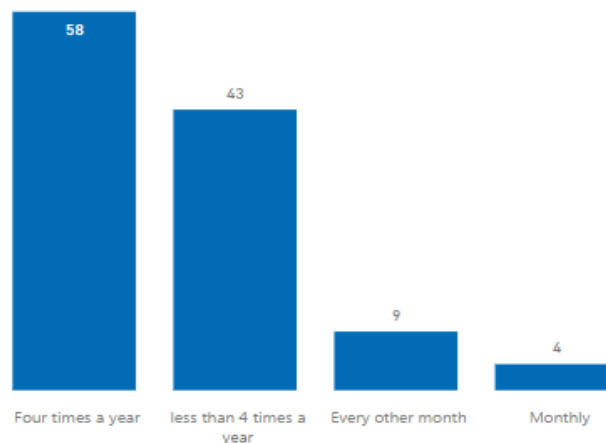

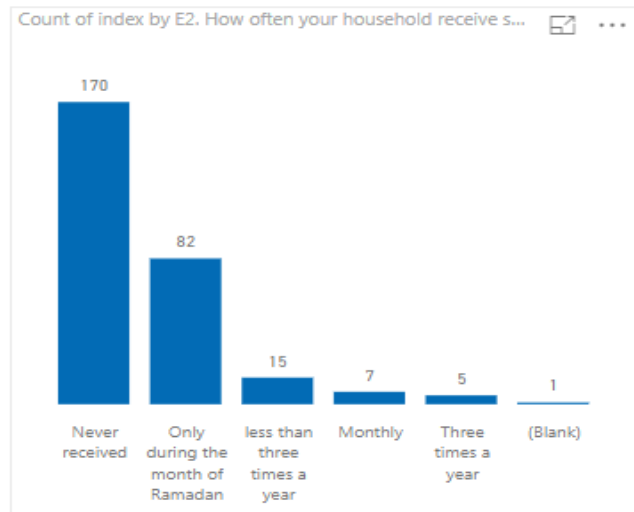

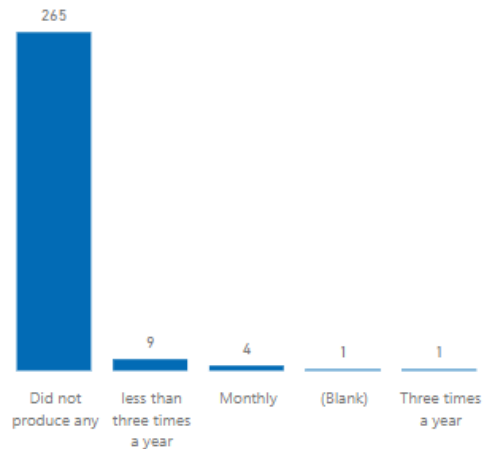

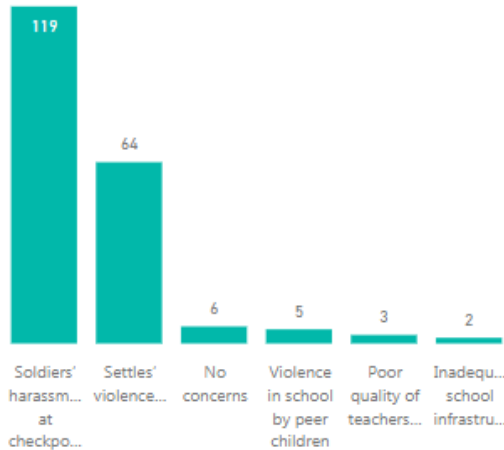

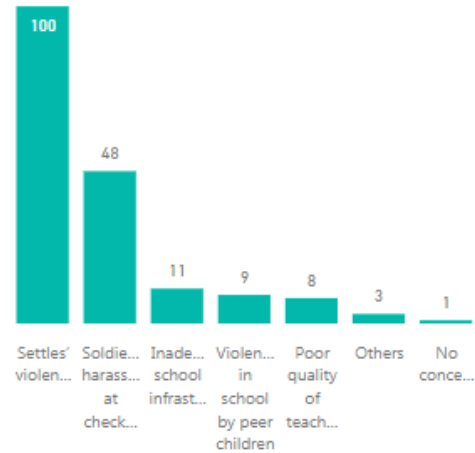

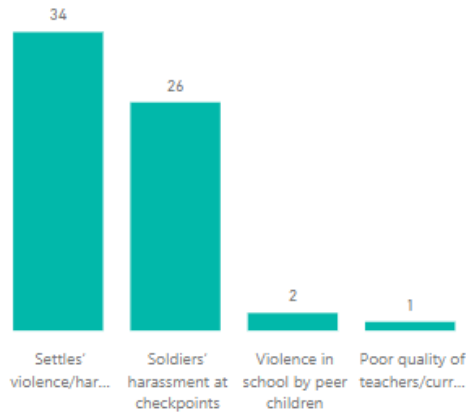

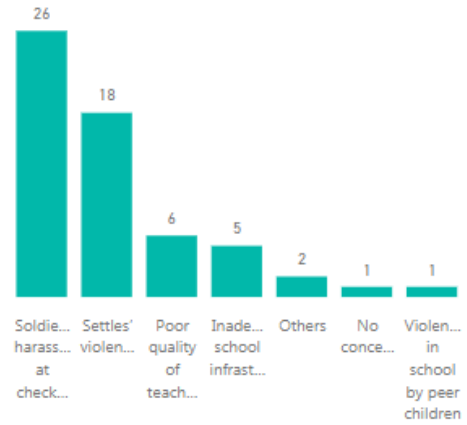

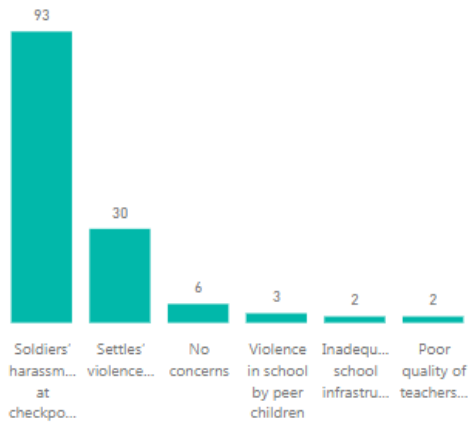

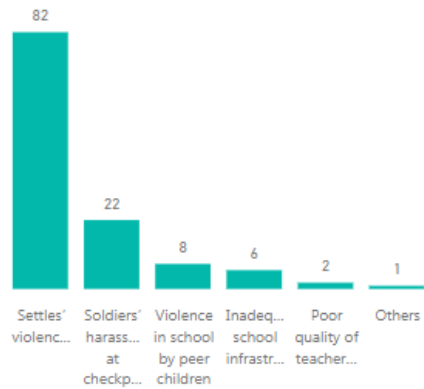

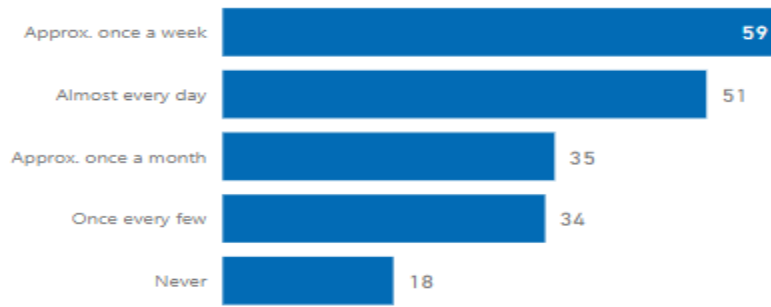

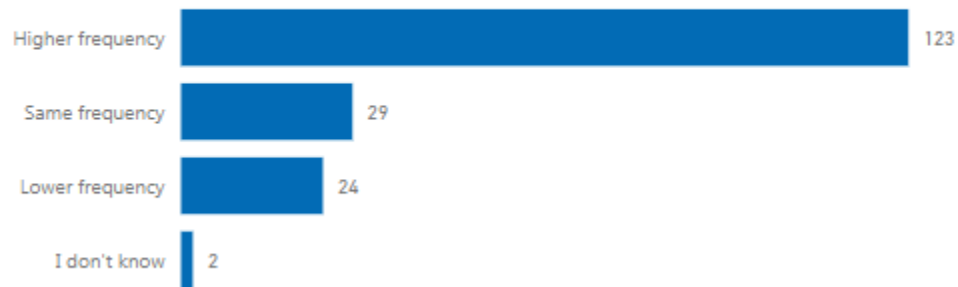

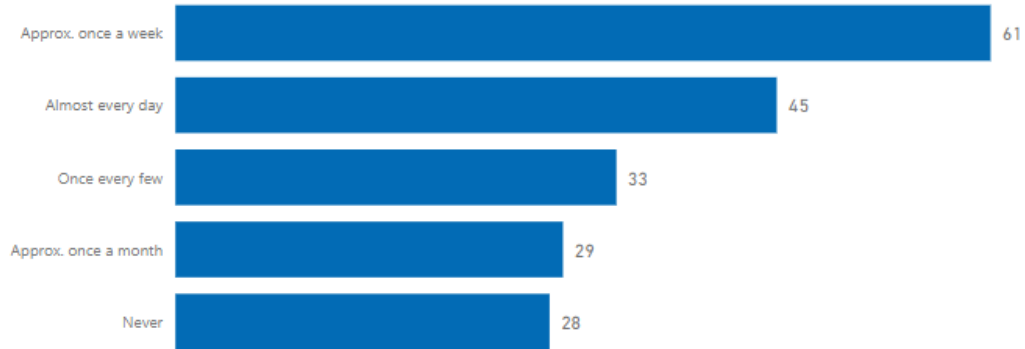

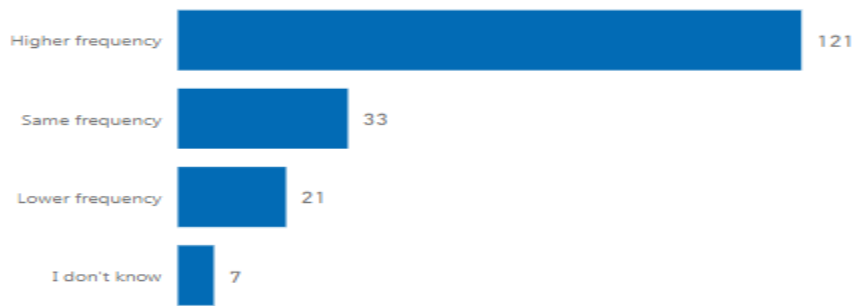

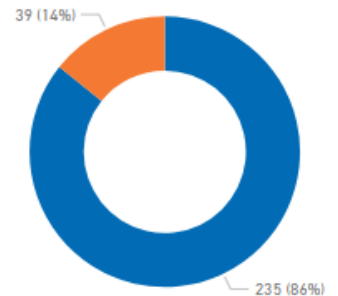

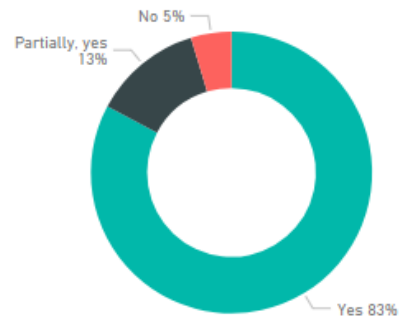

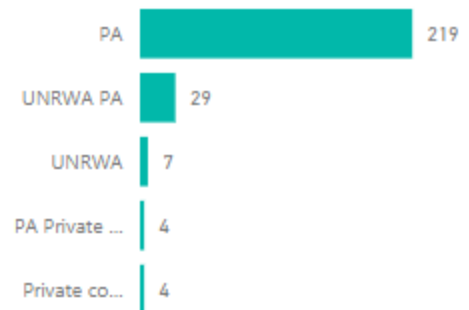

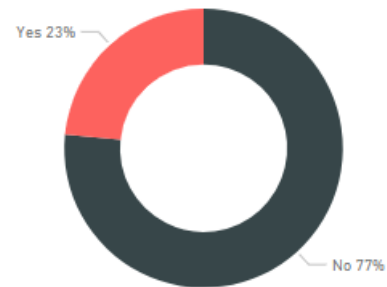

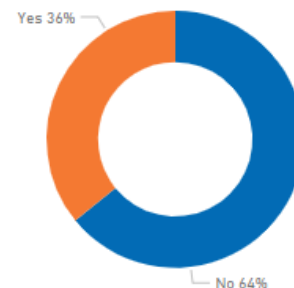

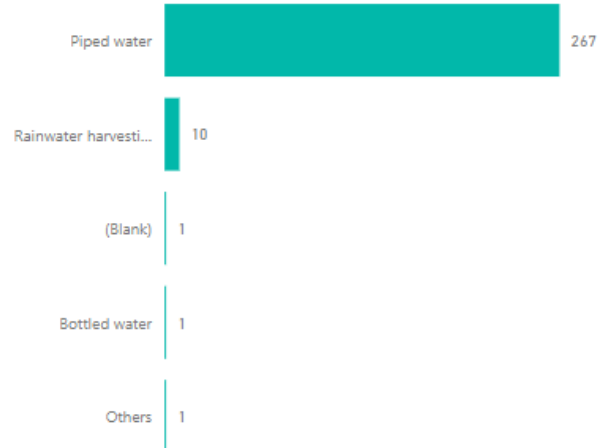

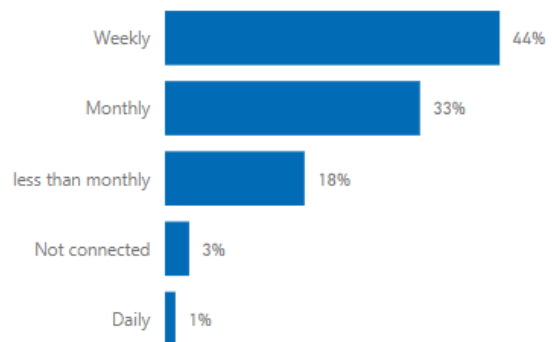

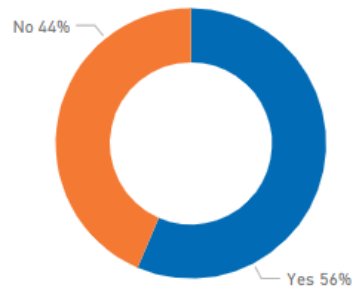

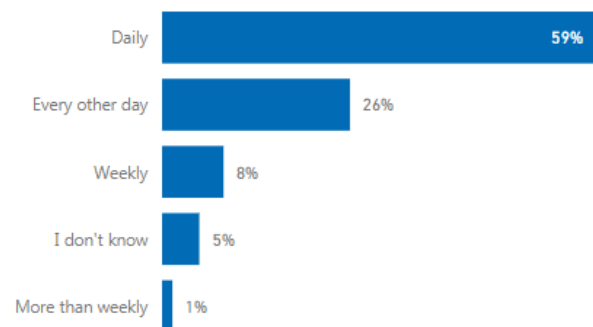

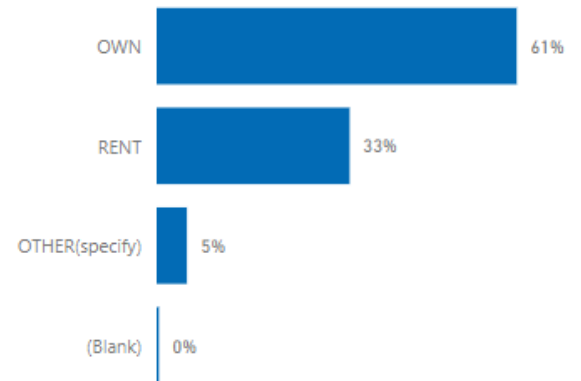

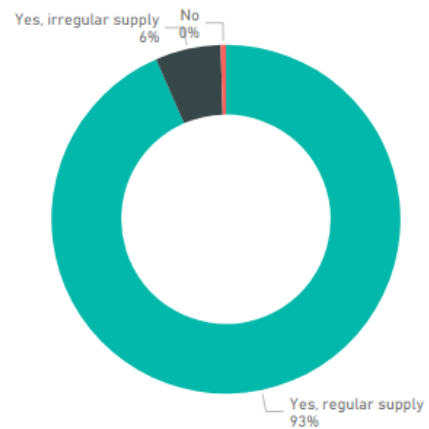

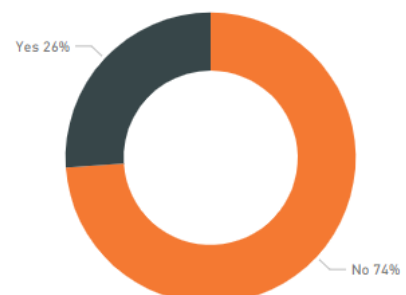

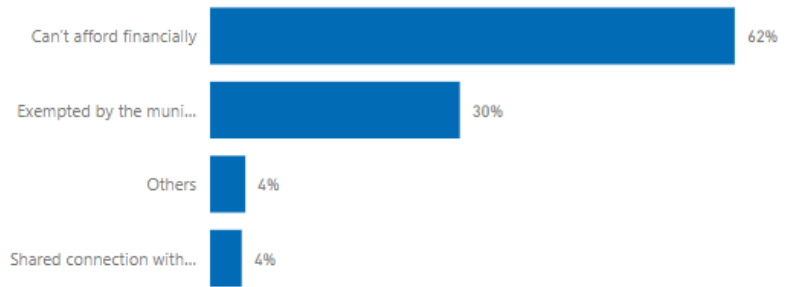

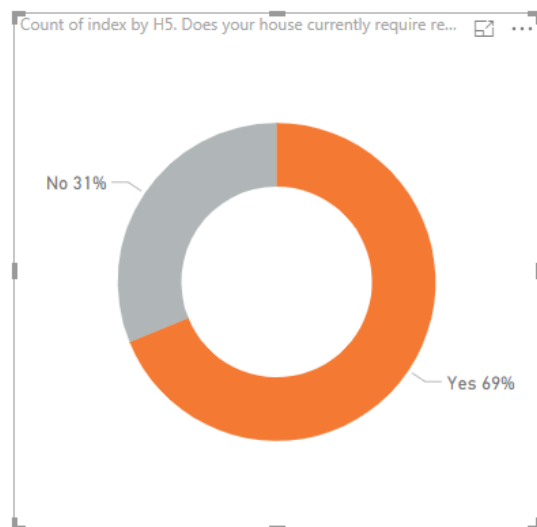

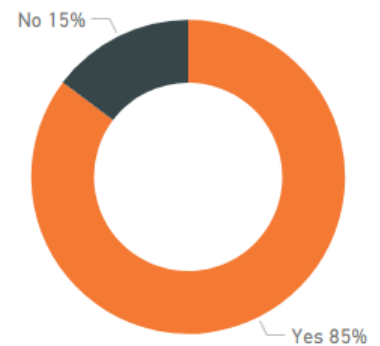

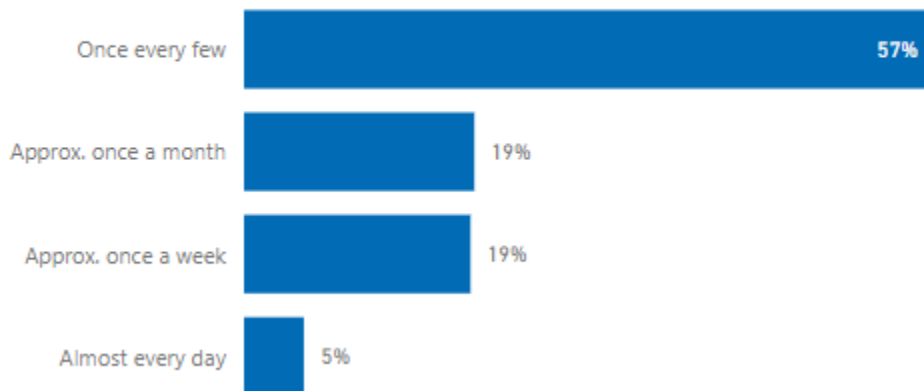

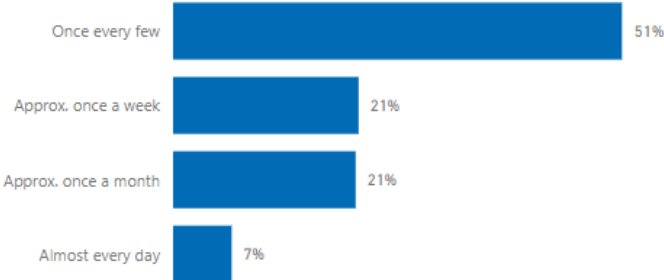

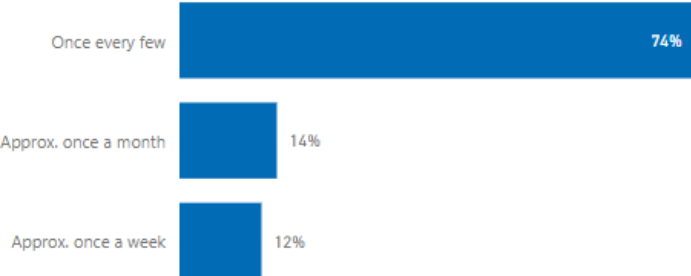

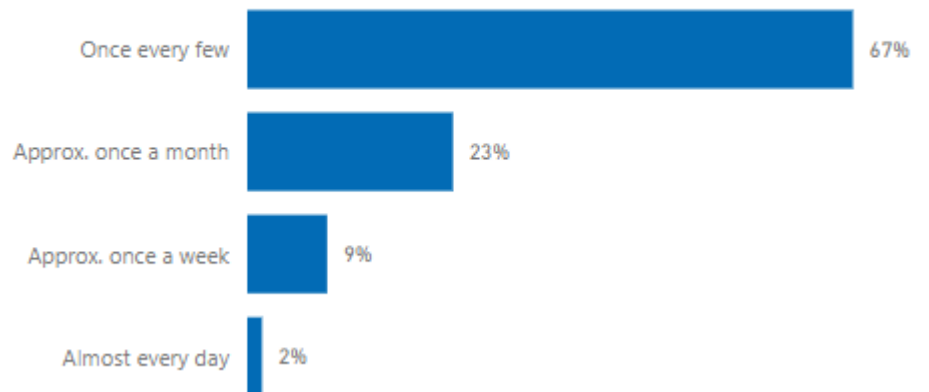
