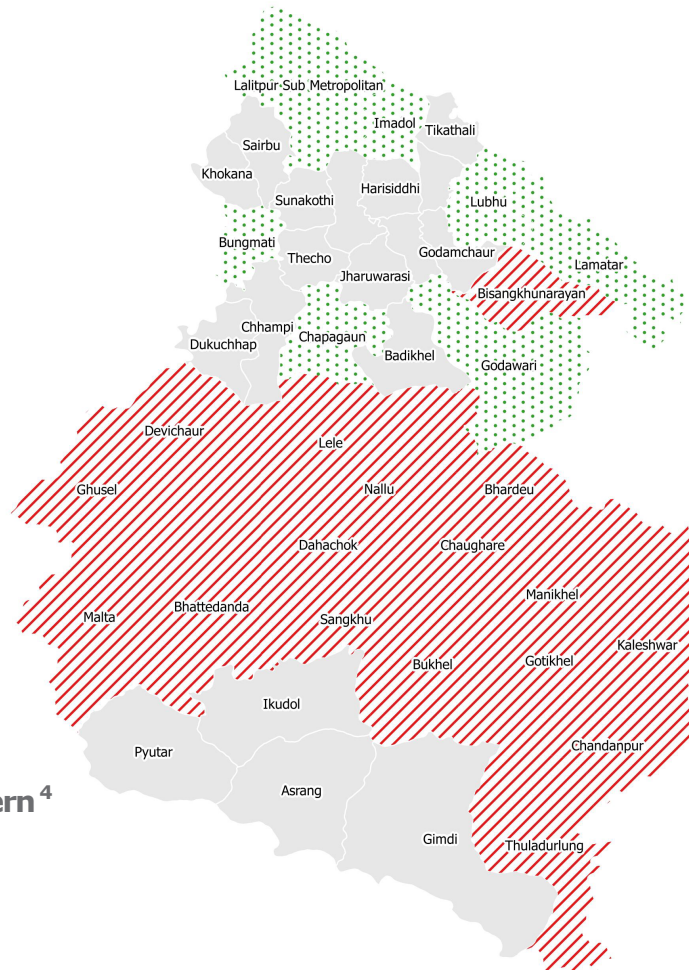

## Current Situation

- DCA has completed distribution of blanket, shawl and socks to 314 HHs in Lamatar, Imadol and Lubhu VDCs.
- Distribution of NPR 10,000 by NRCS to 5,000 HHs is in plan. Distribution will be started in the coming week.
- OXFAM is planning to distribute a full package of winter kit to 166 HHs in the coming week.

## Background

Almost 68% of damaged HHs received Cash and CGI distributions from relief agencies. In addition, the Nepali government distributed NPR 15,000 to all totally damaged HHs. Many individuals from damaged urban settlements relocated to temporary shelters after the earthquakes.
