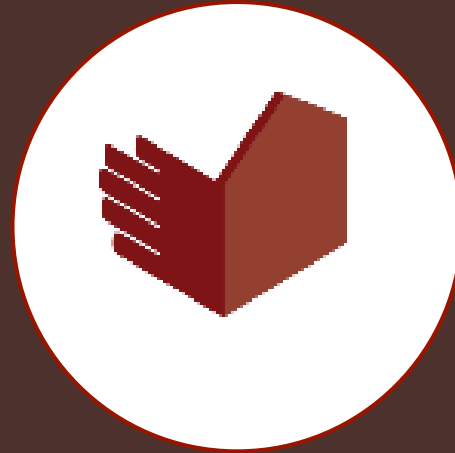

4. CEFA - PARTNER UPDATE

On March 2021 has started the CEFA's project "MORE RAM" carried out in the framework of the RDP Program for North Africa.

This project aims to improve living conditions of migrants, asylum- seekers and refugees, in Tripoli suburbs and Zawiya Municipality with specific priority on vulnerable groups such as women and children (350 beneficiaries per month/18 months), through the provision of Food Kits, Hygiene Kits and NFI Kits, by ensuring access to primary health care facilities in general and implementing minor WASH interventions.

During these first two months, project's activities have been focusing mainly on setting up of the start-up project's activities such as recruitment process of expatriate and national personnel, Partner's agreements process and development of management tools for the planned project's activities.

As soon as we start distribution activities, we will report them on ActivityInfo, ServiceMapping and we will keep updated all the relevant sectors.

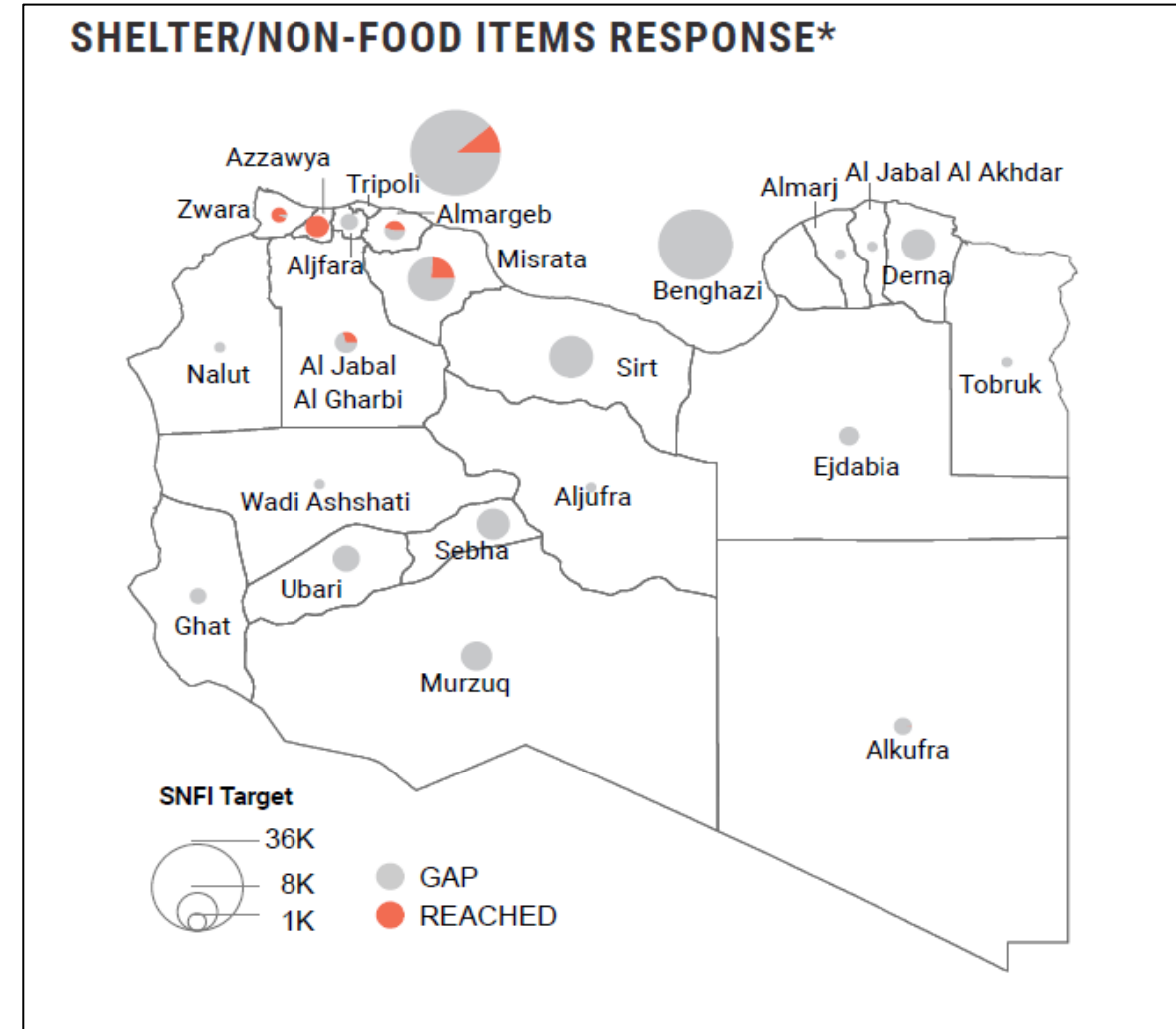


3. SECTOR UPDATE

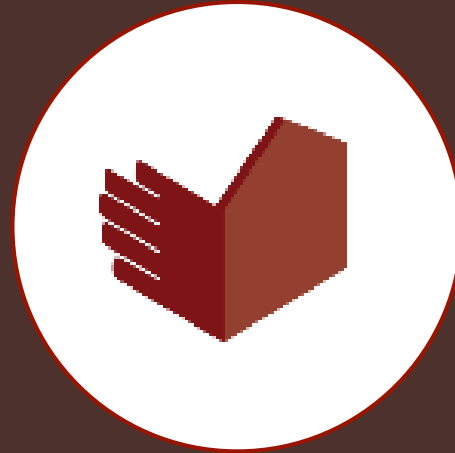
