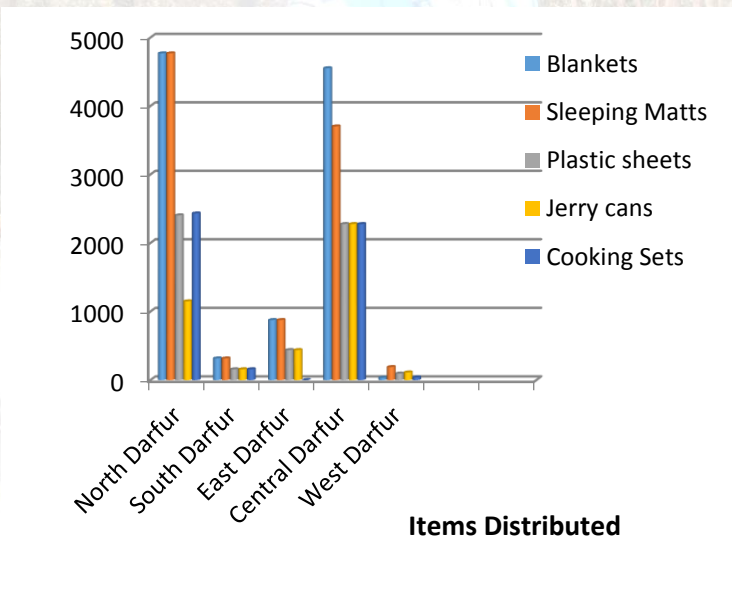
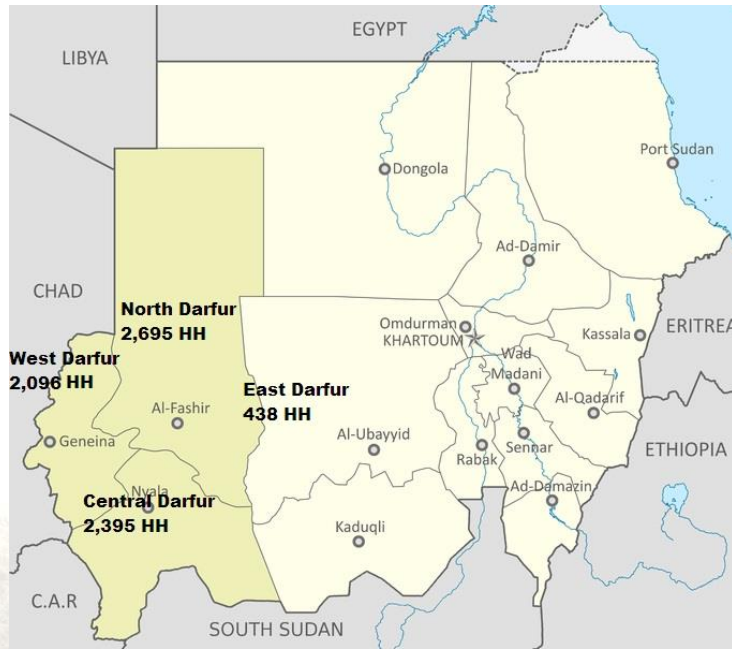
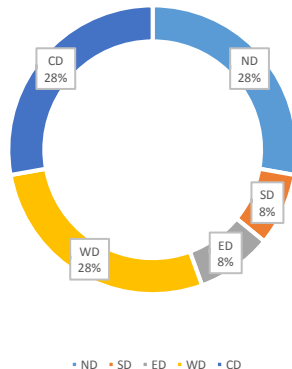


Distribution Coverage by State

Overview

- During the reporting period April to June-2017, the NFI Common Pipeline provided assistance to over 8,614 families in need
- In North Darfur, 2,395 assisted households included 1,246 households newly displaced due to tribal-conflict between farmers and nomads in Al Lait locality. The verification was done by IOM and partners. Additionally 1,149 households in Mellit, Kalemendo, Dar El Salam, El Fasher and Kutum, who lost their shelters due to fire outbreaks were assisted with a package of ES/NFIs to reconstruct a shelter and replace lost household items.
- In south Darfur, ES/NFIs were provided to 701 households: 288, newly displaced; 544 returnees to Otash village; and 316 most vulnerable protracted IDP households in Mossey camp received the necessary renewal ES/NFIs.
- In East Darfur, 732 households lost their shelters due to fire outbreak in Al Naeem Camp, Al Deaain locality and in Shearia, Yassin, Seleah localities. The verified households were assisted with full baskets of NFIs.
- In Central Darfur 2,395 households assisted with ES/NFIs included 119 IDP returnee households in Zalingi Locality, 1,142 refugee returnee households from Chad in Um Dukhon locality, and 713 newly displaced households in Zalengei, Hassa Hissa and Um Dukhon due to inter-tribal conflict.
- In West Darfur 2,391 households were assisted: 2260 PSNs and 131 flood-affected families in need.
