Overview

During the reporting period July – September, the NFI Common Pipeline assisted over 10,000 families with ES/NFIs.





- In Central Darfur, a total of 2,082 households assisted included 582 households in Zalingi locality affected by flood and heavy winds, and 1,500 extremely vulnerable (PSN) households in Golo and Nertiti localities.
- In East Darfur, 294 households in Sheiria and Yaseen IDP gathering in Al Deaain locality lost their shelters due to fire. The verified households were assisted with full baskets of ES/NFIs.
- In North Darfur, a total of 1,707 households assisted including 1,246 households, newly displaced due to conflict between farmers and nomads in Al Lait locality and 461 households in Mellit, Kalemamdo, Kabkabiya, Aburibat, El Fashir, and Kutum localities, whose shelters were destroyed by fire. Verifications were done by IOM and partners.
- In West Darfur, a total of 3,955 families assisted with ES/NFIs included 2,240 households, in Sirba, Krenik, Beida and Geneina localities affected by heavy wind and flash floods; 1,521 vulnerable protracted IDP households in Beida, Selia and Jabal moon localities, 194 returnee households in Beida locality to support the return.
- In South Darfur, a total of 2,353 households assisted with ES/NFIs included 914 returnees, 1,885 South Sudanese refugees who were assisted partially with ES/NFIs from the Common pipeline and partly from UNHCR refugee stock. The distributions were carried out by partners SRCS and COR.

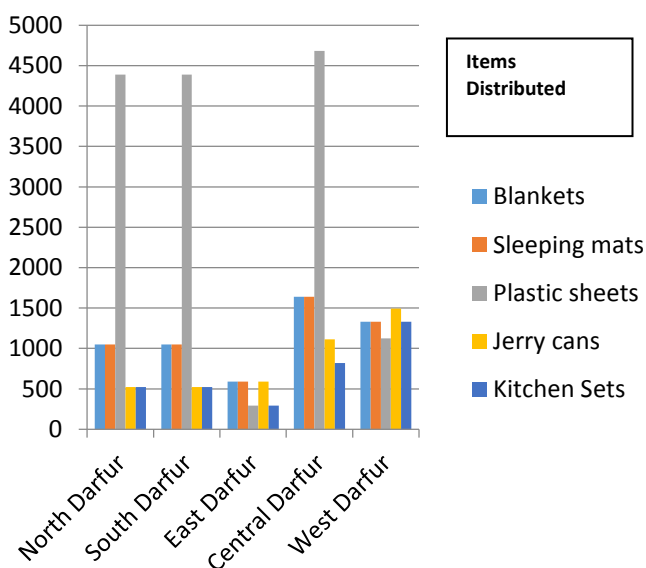
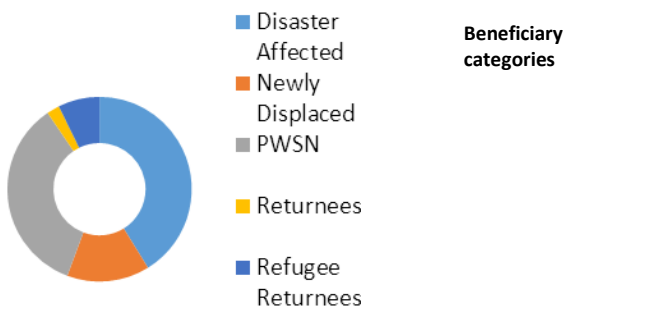
