Demolition response

Demolished structures: **362** (Jan-end July 2019) Of which **141 (39%)** are residential, which is **85%** more comparing to the same period of 2018. displaced **481** individuals, including **233** children

Donor-funded structures: **71** of which **16** are residential

88 households have received a shelter response in 2019; **7** are ongoing.

8,137 demolition orders distributed between years 2010 to 2017.

Upgrading and Rehabilitation of substandard shelters (Needs):

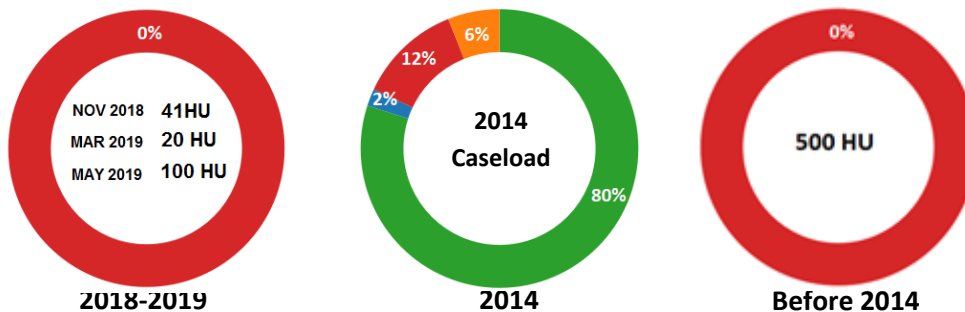
3,630 shelters in Area C, **860** Shelters in H2 area of Hebron **350** shelters in East Jerusalem Require rehabilitation or consolidation to ensure adequate protection and reduce risk of displacement.

Gaza

IDP response

Over **1,500 families (about 8,500 individuals)** remain internally displaced (IDP) since the 2014 conflict including Nov 2018, March and May 2019 escalations. An **urgent gap in assistance** exists for around **1,300** IDP families requiring shelter support.

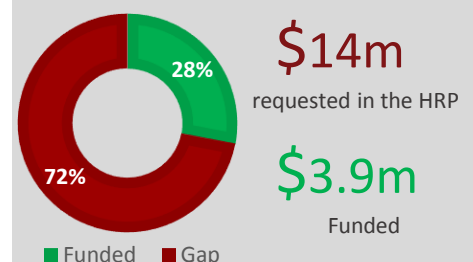
