KEY FIGURES

At the end of June **8/20** partners (1 UN, 7 INGO) and **7/33** HRP projects are partially funded, (**8%** from HRP shelter request).

West Bank/East Jerusalem

Demolition response

Demolished structures: **197** | of which **54 (27%)** are residential, displaced **174** individuals, including **70** children

Donor-funded structures: **28** | of which **12** are residential

34 households have received a shelter response in 2018; **6** cases within the response period.

Demolition or confiscations of all structures have affected **4,982** people during 2018.

The final shelter vulnerability assessment for **264** Bedouin and herding communities (**124,007** Individuals) in area C shows that **3,425** shelters need rehabilitation and upgrade to minimum standards.

Gaza

IDP response

Over **3,400** families (about **17,700** individuals) remain internally displaced (IDP) since the 2014 conflict. **1,985** IDP families (**58%**) have received TSCA for the first Quarter in 2018 (**25%**). An **urgent gap in assistance** exists for all IDP families requiring cash support (**85%**) of the requested fund

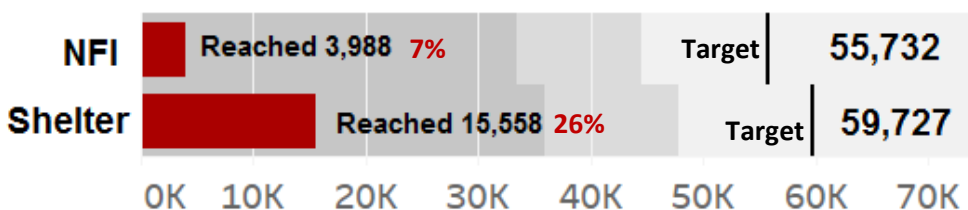

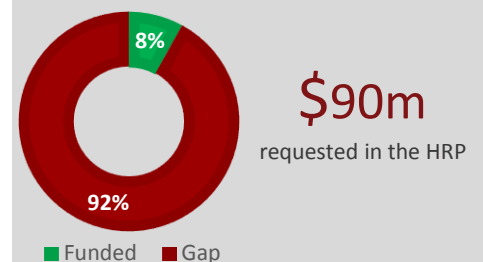

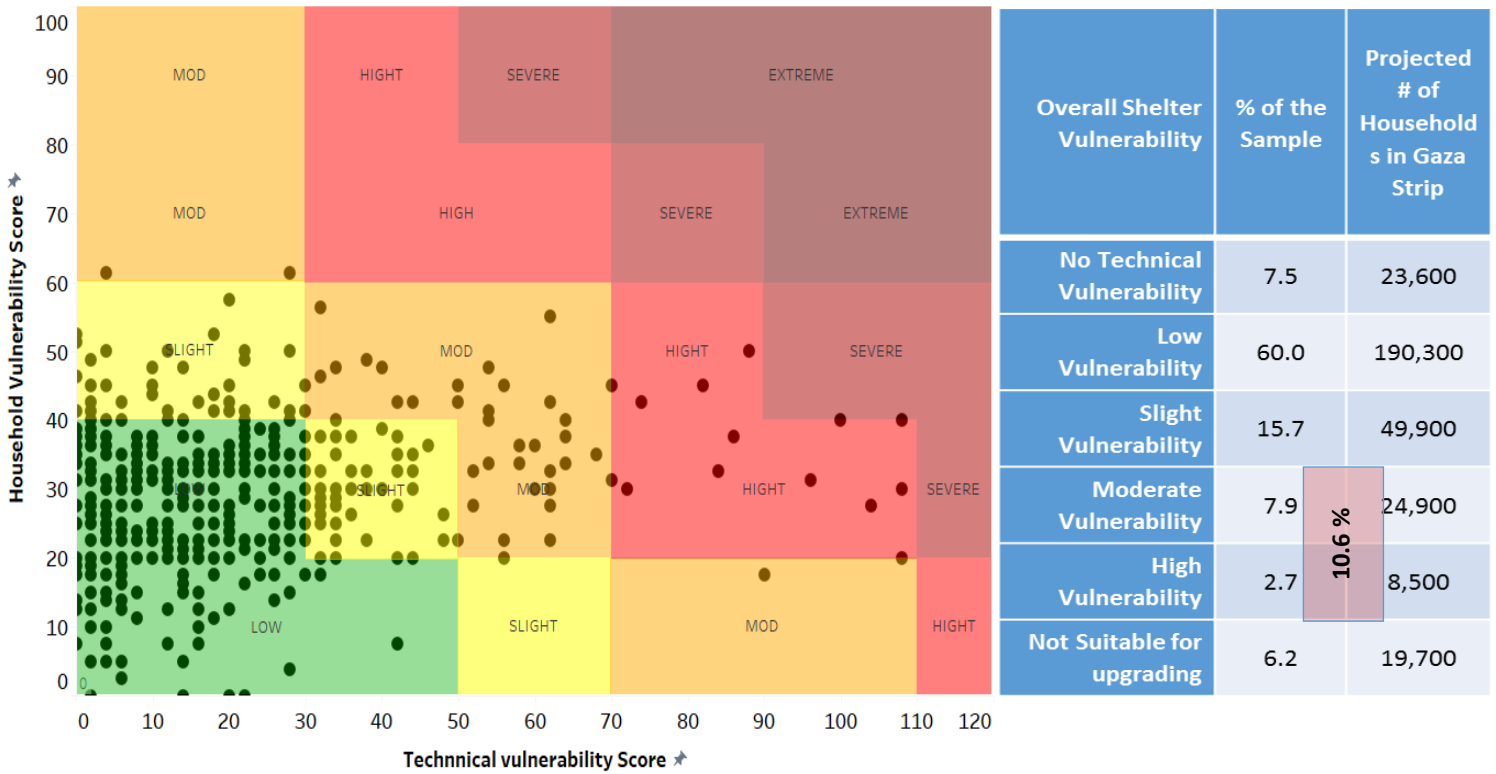

Inter-agency Shelter Survey on Substandard housing conditions in Gaza:

The majority of the substandard housing units are in the low and slight vulnerability categories, still 10.5% of the housing stock in Gaza (33,000) need shelter upgraded to the minimum standards.
