Demolition response Jan-Oct 2015

Stop Working Orders (SWO): 420	of which 228 are residential, 20% increase from 2014
Demolition Orders (DO): 165	of which 107 are residential, 32% decrease from 2014
Actual Demolitions: 467	of which 151 are residential, displacing 568 structures incl. 87 donor-funded individuals and affecting 2,014 individuals
Total outstanding DOs: >11,000	affecting over 13,000 structures, incl. residential

147 households have been assisted in 2015 – there are **no gaps** in the demolition response

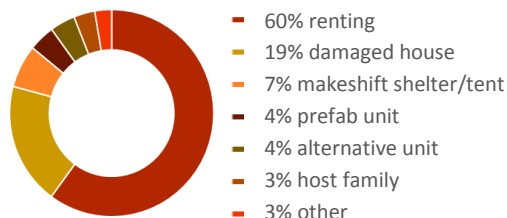
Housing/Shelter Vulnerability in Area C

61 communities are at risk of forcible transfer, **107** communities have been identified as having shelters in bad conditions that require assistance to upgrade.

In addition, there are over **1,000** vulnerable households living in inadequate or overcrowded shelter and a caseload of **3,500** housing units from previous conflicts, as well as a housing deficit of **75,000** units due to the blockade and natural growth.

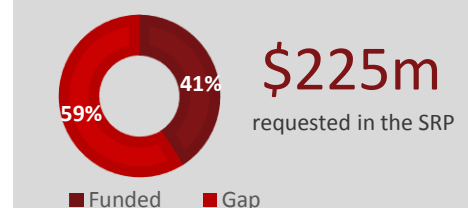

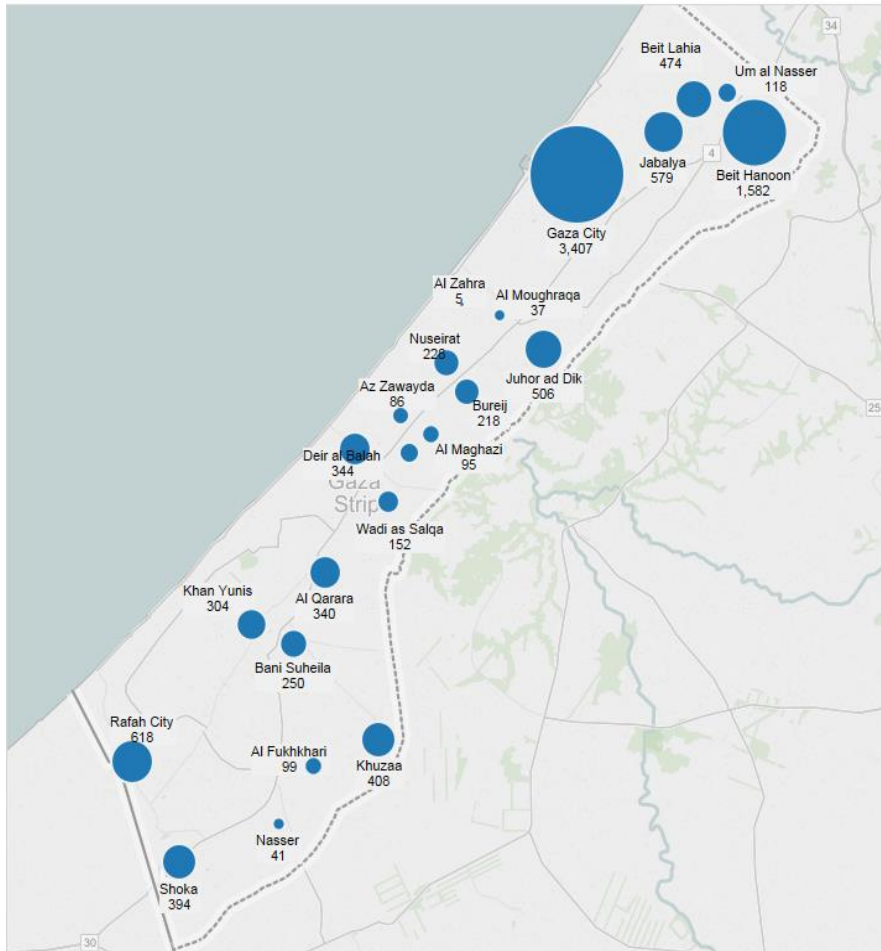

GRM update

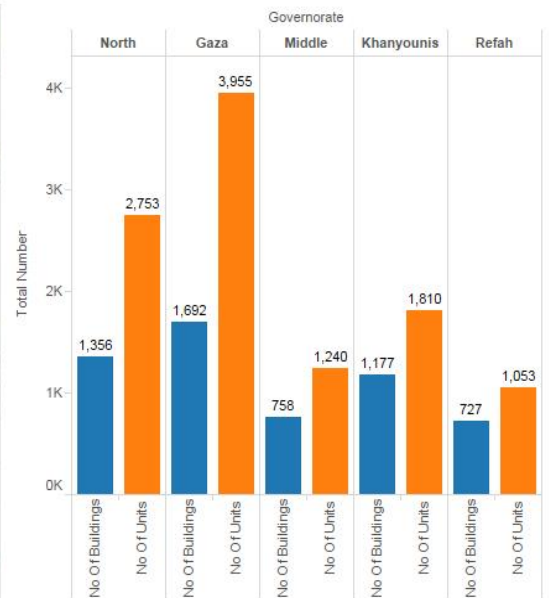
As of 27th October, over **122,029** individuals requiring ABC materials for shelter repairs have been cleared to purchase materials under the GRM. Of these, **95,711** beneficiaries (**78%**) have procured full or partial quantities of their allocated construction material under the Shelter Stream. Of the **4,764** participants in the residential stream, **4,260** individuals (**89%**) requiring ABC materials have been cleared, of which **2,523** beneficiaries (**59%**) have procured partial quantities and **22** beneficiaries have procured full quantities.
