



## KEY FIGURES

At the end of October **8/20** partners (1 UN, 7 INGO) and **9/33** HRP projects are partially funded, (**8%** from HRP shelter request).

## West Bank/East Jerusalem

### Demolition response

**Demolished structures:** **360** of which **128 (36%)** are residential, displaced **381** individuals, including **178** children (Jan – October 2018)

**Donor-funded structures:** **43** of which **14** are residential

**82** households have received a shelter response in 2018; **8** cases within the response period.

Demolition or confiscations of all structures have affected **6,041** people during 2018.

Different factors including new legal and planning challenges contribute to the creation of a coercive environment in Area C, **61** Bedouin and herding communities located in area C in West Bank at high risk of forcible transfer and relocation.

## Gaza

### IDP response

Over **2,600** families (about **14,660** individuals) remain internally displaced (IDP) since the 2014 conflict. **1,684** IDP families (**65%**) have received TSCA for the second Quarter in 2018.

An **urgent gap in assistance** exists for all IDP families requiring cash support.

### Substandard Housing conditions

More than **92%** of the Gaza strip households possess some kind of shelter vulnerability, including **6%** which are considered out of scope of the upgrading since it require reconstruction or relocation.

Although the majority of the substandard housing units are in the low and slight vulnerability categories, still **10.5%** of the housing stock in Gaza (33,000) need shelter upgrade with a prioritized 24,000 households to receive shelter assistance.
