- Send updates to Regional and Federal SNFI Cluster on meeting minutes and any action points raised
- Support prioritization exercises and contribute towards the sector response plan with local authorities where and when appropriate
- Coordinate with other partners the provision of shelter/NFI assistance within the regions or zones.
- Raise awareness on identified gaps within the regions or zones to the regional and/or federal cluster
- Provide feedbacks and updates to the regional and federal clusters regarding the on-going response

Update on humanitarian developments

Update on humanitarian developments and cluster response activities, stock & pipeline and geographical presence

- Response to date since January 2018 :
- Support has been mobilized to support a total of 38,959 HH
- 20,189 full ES/NFI kits have been distributed until 31st May
- 2,380 full ES/NFI are being currently distributed in flood affected areas in Somali.
- 7,490 cash grants have been distributed until 31st May
- 1,500 cash grants are currently being distributed in Somali for flood affected HH.
- 7,400 partial kits have been distributed
- 48,776 full ES/NFI kits are currently in stock in pipeline, 9,644 cash grants are planned

Update on humanitarian developments

OVERALL CLUSTER FUNDING as per HDRP \$17.5 - 18%

- ***Pillar 1- Prevention and Mitigation - 0 % funded***
- ***Pillar 2 - Response - \$17 million - 39 %***
- ***Pillar 3 - Recovery and Systems Strengthening \$600,000 - 1.5%***

Funding Situation

1st CERF Allocation - Conflict Displacement

- IOM, under the guidance of the RC/HC and HCT, to support the Federal Government and the Somali and Oromia regional governments in implementing registration and intention surveys; including in the Qoloji site and Guji / Bale / Borena
- 10,000 SNFI kits to be allocated - partners COOPI, Save, CRS, NRC
- 1,600 Shelter Repair kits - IOM

2nd CERF Allocation - GU Flooding

- 13,000 ES/NFI kits for Flood Affected HH or replenishment - partners to be identified
- Flood Recovery Activities :
 - 3000 shelter repairs to damaged houses
 - 3000 shelter rehabilitation / transitional shelter for destroyed houses

Update on humanitarian developments

New Displacements and Cluster Needs

1- Cyclone/Storm Sagar

Heavy rains and flood were affected in 6 Woreda under Sitti Zone Dambal, Ayshica, Hadhagala, Gablalu, Shinile and Erer

- 920 households reportedly displaced or affected by the floods
- 480 Houses and 10 Shops were destroyed by the heavy wind and Floods.
- UNHCRS GIKs being used to support some 200 HH
- **2 - Kiremt Flooding**
- 34,500 HH affected – ES/NFI Gap: 28,500 HH in Somali, Oromia, Afar and SNNPR

2- Afar Flooding

Recent flooding and landslides

Kilbati Zone: Dalol, 271 HH/Megale, 268 HH

Gabi Zone: Awash Fentale, 141 HH

3- Gambella Displacements

Recent conflict in Kuerlay Village due to conflict - 203 displaced HH in Lare Woreda

4 - Guji Gedeo Conflict

31,263 displaced HH in Gedeo/28,803 HH in need of shelter and NFI support

15,368 displaced HH in West-Guji/14,658 in need of shelter and NFI support

Joint Federal May Prioritisation Exercise

- As part of its bi-monthly Cluster prioritization, the shelter/NFI Cluster updated its prioritization in May

Activity	Funding	When needed	Comments
Distribution of ES/NFI support in kind and in cash for 124,000HH under Pillar 2	\$21.7M	Immediately	
Rehabilitation and transitional shelter support (including support for returnees in Gedeo-Guji IDPs), targeting 8,000HHs under Pillar 3	\$6.5M	Immediately	Recovery activities to support 14,000 HH overall (8,000 rebuild and 6,000 repair) with transitional shelter, repair activities under Pillar 3
Shelter repair activities through shelter kits, tools and technical support targeting 6,000 HH under Pillar 3	\$2.3M	Immediately	
Prevention and mitigation activities including shelter retrofit activities for 16,000 HH in disaster prone areas under Pillar 1	\$6M	Immediately	Will reduce flood-displaced humanitarian requirements from August

Joint Federal May Prioritisation Exercise

Criteria for Prioritisation Analysis for ES/NFIs

- Drivers (**conflict-induced IDPs and flood displaced IDPs are prioritized** over other climate-induced IDPs but not only those linked to the Somali Oromia conflict but throughout the country)
- **Conflict IDPs categorized based on the length of their displacement** (from September 2017 months)
- Sites prioritized that have **>10% individuals with specific vulnerabilities**, including women and children IDPs as well as the elderly and those with disabilities linked to the conflict
- Sites with **more than 50 % living in substandard shelters**
- Sites with **individuals living in the open air, collective centers**

Joint Federal May Prioritisation Exercise

Summary of Overall SNFI Needs

- 344,932 displaced HH
- 261,830 HH unassisted and in need of support of shelter and NFI support

- Total HH in Priority 1: **140,259 HH**
- Total HH in Priority 2: 38,224 HH
- Total HH in Priority 3: 83,347 HH

- Total Stocks and Pipeline for 58,420 HH - 48,776 / Total Cash Grants: 9,644 - Overall still in need - **204,000 HH**
