Sittwe Update

- Proposed registration and screening of IDPs in Sittwe will be launched by state government in coordination with concerned UN agencies and I/NGOs. Schedule meeting in the next coming days to share ideas for planning and implementation.
- Relocation and Rehabilitation subcommittee Chairman suggested that DRD, CE and EE together with the relevant ministers should be copied with all the correspondence/letters directly related to shelter construction activities from concerned agencies.
- Relocation and Rehabilitation subcommittee distributed updated registered contractors list to concerned agencies.
- Rechecking and confirmation # of shelters in Sittwe settled with DRD and agencies.
- MRCS proposed construction of new 50 temporary 8 unit shelters in Sittwe.

Pauk Taw and Myebon updates

- UNHCR will send technical teams to survey Mye Bon in the coming week.
- UNHCR will tender in the coming weeks the construction of temporary shelters for IDPs in Pauk Taw and Myebon.
- Myebon land development for IDP location is progressing and likely to be completed soon.

Kyauk Phyu update

- DRD CE shared to UNHCR the sketch drawing of Kyauk Phyu IDP site location.
- AMU, LNGO which has to construct shelters will coordinate with DRD, UNHCR for technical and other relevant assistances.
- UNHCR will send survey team next week to Kyauk Phyu to assist AMU on the site planning.
