

Shelter Coordination Meeting Minutes

Venue: The office of Development Affairs Minister, Rakhine State Government Compound

Introduction

Minister of Development Affairs thanked everyone for coming into the meeting. Next was introduction of each participant as there are newcomers

Sittwe Update

- RRSC Chairman update about the distribution of construction of 400 government shelters in rural area
 - Phase 1 = 200 shelters
 - ✓ Baw Du Pha = 100 shelters
 - ✓ Ohn Taw Gyi 4 = 60 shelters
 - ✓ Kaung Du Kar = 40 shelters
 - Phase 2 = 200 shelters
 - ✓ Hmanzi (KOICA Tent area) = 31 shelters
 - ✓ Maw Thin Mar (West TKP KOICA Tent area) = 39 shelters
 - ✓ The Chaung = 40 shelters
 - ✓ Dar Paing = 30 shelters
 - ✓ Ohn Taw Gyi 3 = 20 shelters
- IDP verification plan by gov't is for 11 rural camps. 3,204 HHs in 7 camps to be relocated.
- Government engineers working on to try to accommodate Pauktaw and Kyaw Phyu (non-Sittwe IDPs). They will not forcibly moved the IDPs from Sittwe but will look for available land to build around 260 shelters
- WASH facilities needed for all the above planned numbers of shelters. Government to list down the required number of facilities and coordinate with WASH actors for the gaps

Other Townships Update

- UNHCR will construct (564) 8-unit temporary shelters in Pauk Taw and Myebon.
- The list of (362) 8-unit temporary shelters from Government is as follows:
 - 12 in Ramree
 - 64 in Rathedaung
 - 111 in Kyauk Taw
 - 19 in Kyauk Phyu
 - 72 in Mrauk Oo (Na Ta La will construct 72 individual houses.) and
 - 84 in Min Bya
- The Government had made agreement with construction companies.

AOB

- The Rehabilitation and Relocation Sub-Committee requested Shelter and WASH actors to provide necessary additional camp facilities for the Government's temporary shelters
