Updates:

Agency	Update
Rakhine State Government	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Greeted and thanked all the participants for coming at 1st Shelter Cluster coordination meeting in Sittwe for 2014 after March 26-27 crisis. Gave update of activities and other related developments, information regarding to on-going and planned activities of RSG. RSG is planning to cover maintenance of long house shelters in Kyauk Taw, Min Byr and Mrauk Oo whilst other Shelter Cluster partners (UN/INGOs) will cover Sittwe and Pauk Taw camps. Shelter maintenance activity will discuss details in next coming meeting with stakeholders. U Hla Han, State Minister of Transport and Communication is not member of ECC but he will try to address issues faced by UN-INGOs and their activities in relevant meetings. For current time, TA applications are regarding to Minister U Mya Aung and for Shelter and WASH activities approval and progress are regarding to Minister U Hla Han. Requested explanation in brief of relation between agencies and its Implementation partners (IP) for activities and locations so thus RRSC will assist effectively. Need information of MRCS's (50) shelters proposal where about.
UNHCR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> UNHCR and its IP; DRC and LWF will start long house shelter maintenance in Sittwe and Pauk Taw camps. Priority of maintenance will be replacement of damaged roof as rainy season is approaching. UNHCR has implemented QIP (Quick Impact Project) in Mrauk Oo Thi Kyar, bridge reconstruction started after Water Festival. UNHCR is finalising its CCCM infrastructures construction in Sittwe and Pauk Taw camps except for Myebon T/ship. LWF has started renovation of schools in Sittwe urban and rural areas as parts of QIP by UNHCR. UNHCR will discuss and submit proposals of (100) individual houses constructions in Mrauk Oo and Min Byar and (72) individual houses for IDPs still remaining in Set Yone Su 1 & 2 camps.
